

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-04

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ENACTING THE
NATIONAL RESPONSE PLAN TO BE COMPLIANT WITH THE STATE
HOMELAND SECURITY OBJECTIVES FOR ALL EMERGENCY
MANAGEMENT ACTIVITIES**

WHEREAS, the Homeland Security Act of 2002, the Homeland Security Presidential Directive -5 (HSPD-5), and Management of Domestic Incidents, establish clear objectives for a concerted national effort to prevent terrorist attacks within the United States; reduce America's vulnerability to terrorism, major disasters, and other emergencies; and minimize and recover from attacks, major disasters, and other emergencies that occur; and,

WHEREAS, the National Incident Management System (NIMS), provides a nationwide template enabling Federal, State, local and tribal governments and private-sector and nongovernmental organizations to work together effectively to prevent, prepare for, respond to, and recover from domestic incidents regardless of cause, size, or complexity; and,


WHEREAS, the Incident Command System (ICS), key concepts provide systematic and coordinated incident management, including protocols for incident reporting, coordinated action, alert and notification, mobilization of Federal resources to augment existing Federal, State, local and tribal capabilities, operating under threats or threat levels, and integration of crises and consequence management functions; and,


WHEREAS, the Incident Commander (IC), the individual responsible for all incident activities, including the development of strategies and tactics and the ordering and release of resources, has overall authority and responsibility for conducting incident operations and is responsible for all incident operations at the incident site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, that the City shall enact the National Response Plan to be compliant with the State Homeland Security objectives for all Emergency Management activities.
