**7:00 PM – Regular Meeting**

A regular meeting of the Payette City Council was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Williams in the City Council Chambers of Payette City Hall, 700 Center Avenue.

**A. Payette County Disaster Coordinator ~ Bob Barowsky**

Bob Barowsky, stood before the Council and reported on his duties and responsibilities as the Disaster Coordinator for Payette County. He applies for grant funding to provide the three cities within the County and County emergency services departments with equipment and aid. He indicated this year's funding will be significantly less than in previous years.

**B. Public Drainage Swale Easement**

Mussell moved and Dodson seconded a motion to approve the Public Drainage Swale Easement between the City of Payette and Western Core at 580 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue South.

**D. Information at Street Banners**

Mayor Williams said this item is a continuation of Council discussion from a couple of months ago. Clerk Cordova stated that the City may place a banner or flag within the highway right-of-way, but advertising is not allowed per the Idaho Department of Transportation. The cost of flags or banners to be placed on phone or power poles is \$150 - \$200 apiece. The Council had discussed placing at the 4 entrances to town.

**E. Beer License ~ Florentino Garcia**

Police Chief Clark informed the Council Mr. Garcia has been convicted of a felony and a beer wine license may not be issued to a convicted felon per City Code.

Heleker moved and Mussell seconded a motion to deny a beer license for Florentino Garcia.
