A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, PAYETTE COUNTY, IDAHO, SUPPORTING THE PROJECT IDENTIFICATION SUBMITTAL FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SOUTH 9TH STREET FROM HIGHWAY BUSINESS #95 TO THIRD AVENUE SOUTH TO THE LOCAL HIGHWAY TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE COUNCIL, (LHTAC).

WHEREAS, the City of Payette has determined that South 9th Street from Third Avenue South to Highway Business #95 is in need of upgrading due to increased traffic; and


WHEREAS, the City of Payette has determined that South 9th Street is a principle arterial in the 2005 Payette Urban Boundary and Functional Classification System as displayed on the Urban Area map approved in December of 1996; and

WHEREAS, the City of Payette has determined that the total project cost estimate is \$596,000, which will require \$47,700 of local matching funds to be available from the City of Payette.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE:

That Mayor Ann Crosby is hereby authorized and directed to sign the project identification packet and submit to LHTAC for prioritization.

**NOTICE OF HEARING TO CONSIDER A
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE
FILING OF A PETITION FOR JUDICIAL
CONFIRMATION UNDER THE IDAHO
JUDICIAL CONFIRMATION LAW**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Monday, the 5th day of June, 2000, at 6:30 o'clock P.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, at the City Council meeting room at Payette City Hall, 700 Center Avenue, Payette, Idaho, the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho (the "City"), will conduct a public hearing to consider the adoption of a resolution authorizing the filing of a petition for judicial confirmation under the Idaho Judicial Confirmation Law, Title 7, Chapter 13, Idaho Code.

The proposed petition would seek judicial confirmation of the power of the City (1) to incur an indebtedness as an "ordinary and necessary expense" of the City authorized by the general laws of the State, within the meaning of Article 8, Section 3, of the Idaho Constitution, in an amount not to exceed \$1,400,000, for wastewater treatment facility improvements; (2) to enter into a loan agreement and to issue the promissory note or other evidence of indebtedness of the City for the same, for the purpose of financing the cost of necessary improvements to the wastewater collection system of the City; and (3) to pledge the City's sewer system revenues for the payment of such indebtedness for a term of not more than twenty (20) years.

Information relating to the proposed petition and financing is available at the office of the City Clerk, Payette City Hall, 700 Center Avenue, Payette, Idaho, during normal business hours of the City. Interested persons are encouraged to attend the public hearing and to present comments. Comments may also be submitted in writing to the Mayor and Council, City of Payette, 700 Center Avenue, Payette, Idaho 83661.
