

RESOLUTION 223

A RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, TO PROCLAIM A GENERAL CITY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 1999, DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACE, DESIGNATING THE REGISTRAR AND DEPUTY REGISTRARS, AND ORDERING THE CITY CLERK TO GIVE NOTICE OF SUCH ELECTION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The General City Election will be held in and for the City of Payette on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November, 1999, at which time there will be elected three City Council members to serve for a term of four years, or until the election and qualification of their successors.


SECTION 2. The designated polling place for such election is the Payette Public Library at 24 South 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Payette, Idaho. The polling place will be open for voting from 8:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.

SECTION 3. The citizens of Payette may register at the Payette County Clerk's Office at 1130 Third Avenue North or the Payette City Clerk's Office at 700 Center Avenue until 5:00 P.M. on October 8, 1999. With proper documentation, Payette City residents may register at the poll on election day.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk, for and on behalf of the Mayor and City Council, shall give public notice of the time and place of holding such General City Election by publishing such notice in at least two issues of the Independent Enterprise, a newspaper printed and published in the City of Payette, Idaho, the first publication of such notice to be made not less than 45 days previous to the date of such City Election and the last publication not less than 15 days prior to the election; the notice so published shall state the polling place and the hours during which the polls shall be open for the purpose of voting; said notice to contain such information in accordance with the requirements of Section 50-436 of the Idaho Code.
