C. Donation Request – Boys & Girls State –

Dan Greig 1211 Terra Court, Fruitland, addressed the Council along with students from Payette High School. They will send nine girls and several boys this year to Boys & Girls State. Michael Stoneman addressed the Council. He stated he is going back as a junior counselor this year. Talked about his attendance at boy's state last year. He said it was the most important class he has attended. He told the council about his experience. By attending it gave him more self-confidence and helped him understand how government works. Kate Brooks talked about her experience at Girl's State, it has made her a better community leader and more confident. It was a wonderful experience and very empowering. Irelan Yokom stated she had an outstanding experience and it went past government and was able to pursue a possible future career. They make it so much fun for you to be there and learning at the same time and very educational. Dan Greig stated the cost for students to attend is \$400 for each boy and \$375 for each girl, they receive all their meals and a shirt. There is no paid staff all volunteer. Mayor Williams asked what he is looking for. He stated a boy and girl sponsorship would be great. Mayor Williams disclosed that a daughter of a city employee will be attending.

### **DEPARTMENTAL REPORT**

A. Police Department – January 2016 – Chief Clark addressed the Council. He stated January they had 668 calls of service. Informed the Council about police car crash, good news is no one hurt and it was the other person's fault. New drug K-9 Lilly as of today has had about \$4,000 worth of drug seizures and Yates has bonded with dog well. He stated they have joined the Three Rivers Crime Stoppers. They have received leads all ready and excited about getting going. He has been working with his management team and where the major part of calls are during the day to staff properly. This will be implemented March 1<sup>st</sup>. Friday and Saturday evenings are where the biggest number are. He expects to have new cars in service soon. He has two officers at post and they will graduate March 11<sup>th</sup>. Thursday he is hosting the regional chief's luncheon.

B. Fire Department – January 2016 – Castenada stated they are staying busy on medical calls. He has put the new rescue rig in service. He has applied for grants for more equipment through EMS.

F. Parks & Rec Committee – February 8<sup>th</sup> - Massey wanted to give kudos to Matea on the minutes, they were exceptional. The committee discussed bike lanes, pool update. He stated Kim Bruce wanted to challenge Katrina on getting word out that we have a pool in Payette.

G. Library Commission – February 11<sup>th</sup> – Dale stated Ms. Haley has had been out. Discussed closing library on Saturday and moving hours to Monday. This will make scheduling so much easier.

H. Historical Commission – February 16<sup>th</sup> - Dale stated Pete O'range, State Historic Preservation spoke to group. He stated we are 99% complete on certified local government, just need paperwork. They elected new chairman and co-chairman.

Ed Franek stated he has been working on cop cars, equipment at sewer plant and street department.

Jake Hust, stated they put a 6" check valve last weekend at Seneca, this was paid through Urban Renewal.

Jamie Couch stated street sweeper is out with a dump truck. The water truck wets it down so it doesn't create dust. At the next Public Works meeting he will have books for downtown light decorations to look at. All sidewalks are cleaned and swept.

Fales stated equipment at Padgett Park is completed. He has been working on pool furnace and they have cleaned up flower beds

DeCroo stated they have been televising with new camera and will be an asset. They have also been doing routine maintenance. They are concentrating on newer sewer lines, older lines will be more time consuming. Nelson asked about when they run into a tree root, what they do then. DeCroo stated they put chemicals in line that are flushed down the line and then go back and make sure tree root is gone.

### **MAYOR'S COMMENTS**

Mayor Williams stated there was a proposal that the local land use for gas and oil be taken away from local government. He thinks that got straightened out and is going in right direction. He also stated a bill floated through to take away their control of breeds of dogs allowed. He sent a letter to Seth Grigg, at AIC. ## *FAIR HOUSING MONTH PROCLAMATION*

*WHEREAS, housing is a critical component of family and community health and stability and*

*WHEREAS, housing choice impacts our children's access to education, our ability to seek and retain employment options, the cultural benefits we enjoy, the extent of our exposure to crime and drugs, and the quality of health care we receive in emergencies; and*

*WHEREAS, the laws of this nation and our state seek to ensure such equality of choice for all transactions involving housing; and*

*WHEREAS, ongoing education, outreach and monitoring are key to raising awareness of fair housing principles, practices, rights and responsibilities; and*

*WHEREAS, only through continued cooperation, commitment and support of all Idahoans can barriers to fair housing be removed;*

*NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jeffrey Williams, Mayor of City of Payette, Idaho, Payette County, do hereby proclaim April 2016 to be*

To the Mayor and City Council,

My ultimate goal in this conversation is to simply establish the proper time-line and to establish the channel through which the library's bills should flow. With checks being cut only twice a month (or as it seems currently only once a month), it is crucial that we work any potential delays out of the system to avoid late-payments, or garner the ill-will of our vendors.

My understanding of how the payment process is intended to work is as thus:

- ∴ First week of the month: Bills arrive at the library from vendors.
- ∴ Second week of the month: Bills are approved by Library Board.
- ∴ Third week of the month: Checks are cut (by the City Clerk) to pay bills approved by Library Board.

The Library Board approves payment of bills during their board meeting (second Thursday of the month). The invoices are delivered to the City Clerk for payment the next day (Friday). The City Clerk cuts checks the following Tuesday (the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of the month). I understand that the library was responsible for the late deliver of the invoices to the City Clerk in January, and for that I apologize – it was this unintentional mistake that seems to have brought to light a longer delay than I was expecting. In an email from Ms. Black, it was stated that the bills delivered to the City Clerk at the end of the first week of February, would not go before the City Council for approval for payment until the first week of March, and not be paid until the third week of March.

The ability for a City Clerk to timely pay a Library's bills is ensured by Idaho Code, Chapter 33-2609.

33-2609. ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS -- CONTROL OF EXPENDITURES. The board shall prepare and adopt an annual budget, stating anticipated revenues and expenditures, indicating what support and maintenance of the library will be required for review and approval by the city council for the ensuing year.

All funds for the library shall be in the custody of the city treasurer unless otherwise provided by city ordinance, and shall be used only for library purposes. The board shall have control of library expenditures. Money shall be paid for library purposes, only upon properly authenticated vouchers of the board of trustees. The board shall not make expenditures or incur indebtedness in any year in excess of the amount of money appropriated for library purposes. The board may hold a separate checking account to be used to pay petty expenses of the library. This account shall be audited along with other library funds.

The second paragraph explicitly states that the board shall have control of library expenditures. There is no need for City Council approval. The City Council does not maintain control of library expenditures after the initial budget approval – and therefore *has* no right to vote on the expenditures.

City Attorney Bert Osborn, in his review of the matter at the request of the mayor, writes: "I didn't review the city policy on payment of library expenses because Idaho code appears to have preempted any attempt to reserve the right [of the City] to oversee daily expenditures of the board." He continues with, "33-2607(4) lists the items the board needs city approval to do. Paying monthly bills is not on the list. So what has to happen is that the board has to approve the monthly library bills, much like the city council does every month, and transmit them to the city treasurer's office for payment. If the city council wants to be kept in the loop, it can request a monthly report as permitted by I. C. 50-210."

There seems to be discussion in the City regarding if Idaho Code, Title 50 preempts Title 33. It does not, and is specifically addressed in the introduction of Title 33:

TITLE 33  
EDUCATION

CHAPTER 26  
PUBLIC LIBRARIES


33-2607. POWERS AND DUTIES OF TRUSTEES. In addition to the powers elsewhere contained in this chapter and notwithstanding the provisions of title 50, Idaho Code, the board of trustees of each city library shall have the following powers and duties:

The key phrase is "[...] and notwithstanding the provisions of title 50 [...]". In this context, "notwithstanding" is defined as "in spite of" or "despite the existence of". Title 33 trumps Title 50.

There was also concern that the Library's Policy on file with the city includes a section which states that the Library Board will submit the bills to the City Council for approval. As this conflicts with Title 33, it will be removed from the Library policies at their next revision. It appears the last time the City received a complete Library Policy manual was almost 20 years ago. This will be resolved in the upcoming months.

My apologies for "rocking the boat", so to speak. Again, my only concern is to avoid any delays in bills getting paid. Nobody likes to pay late payments, and we want to see our vendors paid in a timely manner. This philosophy is in line with the City Council, and is apparent in their passing of Resolution 2015-13 during their September 21<sup>st</sup>, 2016 meeting. This resolution gives the City Clerk the authority to pay bills to certain vendors prior to City Council approval, in an effort to avoid late-fees.

- III. COMMUNICATIONS  
None heard.

- IV. PUBLIC HEARING  
A. Amending Chapter 17.34.070 of the Payette Zoning Code to allow expansion of the C-1 Commercial Downtown District. - Ms. Cordova addressed the Commission stating that the City has received a submitted request for a rezone, of the parcel where the Chase House resides. The request is to rezone from Commercial to C1 Commercial Downtown District, C-1 zoning is directly across the street. Current code spells out the specific boundaries of the C-1 commercial Zone that would have to be changed as well as having to amend the current Comprehensive Plan Map. The current map has it classified as a Commercial zone. Mr. Franklin asked is the C1 commercial Downtown boundary in the middle of the street at 3rd Ave North. Ms. Cordova stated yes it is. Mr. Choate asked if we change the Chase lot will the surrounding parcels remain commercial or will they be changed as well. Ms. Cordova stated that parcel will remain commercial. Mr. Franklin asked if both of these items have to be recommended to the City Council. Ms. Cordova stated yes both do. Ms. Cordova stated the special meeting scheduled on March 10, 2016 if for an application for a Rezone as well as a Conditional Use Permit for residential and business use, making it a mixed use zone which is permitted in a C-1 Commercial Downtown District. This type of use is not allowed in Commercial District unless it is security housing or some type of residential housing associated with the business that is also on the parcel. C-1 Commercial is your downtown zone, which has a lot of businesses with apartments and residential use above and has no lot size minimum requirements. Ms. Cordova stated right now the lot exists as a non-conforming use in a Commercial Zone, due to the lot size and the mixed use. Ms. Cordova said in order to move forward and make zoning decisions you

have to base it upon what's in the Comprehensive Plan, so you have to make an amendment in the Comprehensive Plan first. Mr. Choate stated the Commission isn't amending the Comprehensive Plan just the Comprehensive Plan Map to reflect the changes to that parcel. Mr. Franklin asked about the proposed boundaries that is listed on the new ordinance, and that he understands including lots 1-5 and BLK 2 of the Chase House Addition to the City of Payette C-1 zone correct? Ms. Cordova replied yes. Mr. Keith Thompson, 75 No Iowa Ave Payette, ID 83661, addressed the commission. He wasn't clear on what the public hearing was about so Ms. Cordova explained to him what was occurring in this meeting. Ms. Cordova explained to Mr. Thompson that the Chase House lot would like to change zoning to C-1 Commercial from Commercial to allow mix use, and this is the first step to amend the code as well as the Comprehensive Plan Map. The request is to have the bungalows remain and turn the house into a restaurant, and in rezoning they are allowed to have both those uses. Mr. Thompson stated if they want to have a restaurant then where do they plan to have people park. Ms. Cordova stated that there may be people who want to comment on that very topic, and that is why attending the special meeting on March 10, 2016 at 6pm is important to address that issue. Mr. Thompson stated then there is no need for him to be here at this time. There was no one else to address the Commission

B. Amendment of the Comprehensive Plan Map. - See discussion above.

V. AGENDA ITEMS

A. Amending Chapter 17.34.070 of the Payette Zoning Code to allow expansion of the C-1 Commercial Downtown District.

A motion was made by Franklin to recommend to the City Council to modify ordinance 17.34.70 extend the boundaries lines to include BLK 2 Lots 1-5 of Chase Addition. The motion was seconded by Henderson.

The motion CARRIED by unanimous voice vote.

A motion was made by Franklin to recommend to the City Council to amend the Comprehensive Plan Map to extend the boundaries lines to include BLK 2 Lots 1-5 of Chase Addition to the C1 Commercial Downtown District. The motion was seconded by Henderson.







**MINUTES:**

A motion was made by Amason and seconded by Nelson to approve the meeting minutes of 10-05-2015 as written.

After a unanimous voice vote, the motion CARRIED.

**AGENDA ITEMS:**

1. Election of Chairman and Co- Chairman

A motion was made by Dodson and seconded by Nelson to elect Liz Amason as Chairman.

After a unanimous voice vote, the motion CARRIED.

A motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Amason to elect Chuck Dodson as Co- Chairman.

After a unanimous voice vote, the motion CARRIED.

2. Meter Installation Fee/ Tap Fees – Ms. Amason asked Ms. Gabiola to brief her on what the committee was trying to accomplish with this agenda item. Ms. Gabiola stated that Jake Hust, Water Supervisor wanted to go over the cost of the meter installation fee, and how the price of the meter has risen. Mr. Hust explained that a 5/8 meter, the most common in town, has now jumped to \$269.50 with a radio on it. Mr. Hust stated currently we charge \$125 to install the meter. The \$125 used to cover the cost of the meter and the labor to install, but now that has changed. Now that this issue has come to our attention, we need to decide to just absorb that cost due to being able to charge for water for many years to come or raise the cost to cover the expense. Mr. Dodson asked Mr. Hust about the cost of the labor to install. Mr. Hust stated that the rate for labor is \$26.17 per hour per guy and it only takes 15 minutes to install which is why labor is minimal, really the bigger cost is the meter itself. Ms. Amason stated in previous meetings she remembers looking at the cost of meter prices, and asked Mr. Hust if they were that high then. Mr. Hust stated yes this is the same cost since 3/23/2015, but they are due for a rate increase the first of next year. Mr. Nelson asked about the \$1500 tap fee. Mr. Hust stated that is a different fee. That fee is in regards to actually tapping in to the line. Mr. Jensen asked Mr. Hust on how he thinks were doing with the \$1500 tap fee, because he hates to see the rate increase to people who are building new. Mr. Hust stated it depends on the lot in town and if does or doesn't have service already constructed. Example: most new subdivisions in town already have the services there. Mr. Nelson always thought if there building a new house they will always have to pay the \$1500. Ms. Gabiola stated there are two sets of \$1500 fees. 1 being the permit fees, \$750 for Water and \$750 for Sewer, these permits

are with homes that already have the tap in place. The 2<sup>nd</sup> \$1500 fee is the tap fee, which is on top of the permit fees if the lot does not have city services in place, due to having to construct them. Mr. Hust asked Ms. Cordova if the water meter installation fee is included in the tap fee. Ms. Cordova stated that cost is incorporated. Ms. Amason stated in the next meeting wanting to see the breakdown of what the tap fee entails, due to the raised cost of the meter, the amount of the tap fee would go up \$150.

3. Ground Water Protection Overlay District- Ms. Cordova addressed the committee stating this is a new ordinance that will go with the zoning codes regarding what the City wants to have and not have within our source water protection zones and areas. Those areas are currently around our City wells and our wells are very valuable to the City as well as its citizens. So what this ordinance will create is a zone or overlay protection around each well. There are 3 delineations on the map provided that is loosely based off of the EPA delineations zones for our well heads. Ms. Cordova stated the committee needs to keep in mind that anything that goes in to the ground or is located within the six to ten year zone can affect the aquifer. Each of the delineations have a time frame of how long it could take to effect a well. Mr. Jensen asked if the map provided showed where the city limits ended, and it seems him the City wouldn't have jurisdiction. Ms. Cordova stated even though the map does not have the city limits or have jurisdiction, it doesn't stop the City from putting this ordinance into place because it is part of the impact area. The City would be very strenuous to ask the county to help if this was in our impact area. Mr. Jensen asked if this is something that was put into place would the state come in and say no. Ms. Cordova stated unfortunately the state will come in and do what they want to do, but we as a City still have some recourse through our zoning code regulations due to the state giving local cities the authority to protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens. Ms. Amason stated that she believes this is something the City needs to have in place to protect our citizens. Mr. Jensen asked if the draft ordinance address those boundaries as written or does this committee have to determine which areas we want that to be in effect. Ms. Cordova stated it does, but we would like the committee to look this over and think about what is important to the citizens of our city.
4. Department Reports-
  - a. **Sewer:** Mr. Schwartz gave a report on operations at the WWTP.
  - b. **Street:** Mr. Couch gave a report on operations in the Street Department.
    1. Christmas Décor- Mr. Couch presented to the committee that the Street department wants to get new decorations for the holiday season. So if the committee would like to pick their favorites then he could get quotes on them to bring back. Mr. Couch said that he believes that these decorations should be no less than 6 feet tall, due to them being on the pole, the smaller they are the more they will fade into the background. Mr. Couch stated that there are 32 poles on Main Street. Mr. Couch stated he has spoken with several vendors, but isn't sure if this is in his budget. Mr. Couch stated that when speaking with one vendor they may potentially carry a discount of 25% through March. Ms. Wilson and Ms. Dale spoke on behalf of the current decorations and they were bought in 1981 and given to the City from the Chamber of Commerce. Ms. Dale stated that possibly go with something more neutral so they can be up longer through the holidays. Mr. Jensen stated since Ms. Wilson and Ms. Dale are already involved would they like to continue to be. Both stated yes. Ms. Amason stated maybe possibly have every other pole with a Christmas decoration and a banner in between.

2. **City Flower Pots-** Mr. Couch stated that every year the Street department maintains the Flower pots. They in previous years have bought flowers through the Payette School District. Barb Wilson: 307 North 9<sup>th</sup> Street Payette, ID 83661; presented possibly adding more flowerpots to the city. Ms. Wilson stated that she has spoken with Andrews Seed in Ontario, OR about a total of adding flower pots within the City. The only thing that the Street Department would be doing is placing the pot in front of these businesses, and from there on out each business would maintain the flowers. Ms. Wilson said her friend Mike Partin; 1803 North Alan Ave Fruitland, ID 83619; would help in the maintaining of the flowers. Mr. Partin stated he will arrange to have the flowers watered every morning. Ms. Wilson presented the committee with an estimated cost of all 34 pots and maintenance which came to the amount of \$21,757.99. Ms. Wilson stated that in the City of Ontario once the pot is in place then the business it is in front of pays \$300 a year for all maintenance. Mr. Nelson asked how would the City make sure the businesses pay. Ms. Wilson stated you have them sign a contract. Ms. Wilson stated possibly getting a darker color pot to match the poles; she wants black. The City would own the pots due to purchasing them, and then the businesses would be in charge of maintaining them every year. Mr. Partin stated that there is a Master Gardener program being taught in the Library and one of their requirements is having 30 hours of volunteer service to complete their certification. This project has been presented to them as a possibility to accomplish their hours. Ms. Wilson stated that everything would be bought from Andrew's because they guarantee it. Mr. Nelson asked Ms. Wilson if she has spoken with the Chamber of Commerce or businesses in general to see if there is any interest. Ms. Wilson stated yes, she's spoke with several business owners and half are currently promised already if this goes through. Ms. Amason stated she doesn't want to make a recommendation to the Council if the committee doesn't know where the money is coming from to purchase these pots. Ms. Dale stated there is \$41,000 sitting in Capital Outlay for Administrative miscellaneous that's not defined.
- c. **Water:** Mr. Hust gave a report on operations in the Water Department.
1. **Discuss City Backflow Ordinance-** Mr. Hust stated this was put into place July of 1980, and it hasn't been enforced. What this ordinance is in place for is to protect our underground water system. These backflows are to be placed and checked yearly by a certified backflow tester, then have a copy of the results sent to the City. Mr. Hust stated that he has been working with the parks department in getting backflows installed for services, so the City is following the ordinance as well. Mr. Hust stated what the City is wanting to do is begin "slowly" enforcing this ordinance. Mr. Hust stated to have these backflows installed can run around \$200 plus labor, a list of certified installers and testers is in the packet. Mr. Nelson asked Mr. Hust if once this backflow is placed, does it have to be checked every year? Mr. Hust stated yes it runs roughly \$30 a year to have them inspected. Mr. Hust stated not every business needs one, just the businesses with drainage that can affect the water system. Mr. Jensen stated is this only for business or for residential too. Mr. Hust stated if the resident has an underground sprinkler system, then yes they will need this too. Ms. Amason asked how are you going to raise awareness about this ordinance and that you will be enforcing it. Mr. Hust stated that we will be sending out letters to the citizens that we know that have them and begin to work with them to get this accomplished. Mr. Jensen stated does the City require this or the State. Ms. Cordova stated this is a State law; DEQ requires this as well.
