A regular meeting of the Payette City Council was called to order at 7:00PM by Mayor Jeff Williams in the City Council Chambers of Payette City Hall, 700 Center Avenue.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

A motion was made by Heleker and seconded by Jensen to approve the public hearing & regular meeting minutes of 03-03-2014 and work session minutes of 03-12-2014 with corrections on March 3<sup>rd</sup>, Patty Young IBL should be IDL and clarifications and March 12<sup>th</sup>, Nelson was not present.

After a unanimous voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED.

**APPROVAL OF BILLS & PAYROLL**

A motion was made by Sands and seconded by Heleker to approve the City Bills & Payroll in the amount of \$171,015.31

**SPECIAL ORDERS**

A. Fair Housing Proclamation -

Mayor Williams read the Fair Housing Proclamation to the audience, hereby proclaiming the month of April 2014 as Fair Housing Month.

- B. Arbor Day Proclamation – Mayor Williams read the Arbor Day Proclamation to the audience, hereby proclaiming the 25<sup>th</sup> of April 2014 as Arbor Day.

A motion was made by Jensen and seconded by Nelson to approve the Fair Housing Proclamation and Arbor Day Proclamation as read.

After a unanimous voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED.

### **COMMUNICATIONS**

- A. Arbor Day Foundation – Tree City USA and Growth Award – The City has received Tree City USA award for 14 years and the Growth award for 12 years.
- B. Webster Global Site Selectors Report – Councilor Dale stated that SREDA is very involved in bringing business's to our area and have been very active in doing so. The SWOT report from Webster Global shows the City's strengths weakness opportunities, and threats. She stated several new businesses are coming to our area. Fruitland has already gone through the preliminary process and wasn't involved with this report.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

- A. Sunset Rim Subdivision – Development Agreement –

A motion was made by Sands and seconded by Nelson to approve the development agreement for Sunset Rim Subdivision as presented.

Nays:

The motion CARRIED.

- B. Request for permit to Conduct Seismographic Operations on City Owned Property – The Council asked if PMDC is aware of this and was stated yes. A portion of the golf course that the city acquired, the state kept the mineral rights. That doesn't affect what we are doing tonight. Discussed the contract needs to be modified; other towns in the county have gone ahead with this. Discussed the pros and cons, and what areas we are looking at need to be protected. The length of contract needs to be modified, maybe it has been done and maybe it hasn't. The further away they are the less impact it has. Other guys are flippant and you hear stories from citizens in the county, worry that we will have to watch constantly to make sure they are doing what they say they are. The area by the old shooting range and rectangle where spread sludge, there is no city infrastructure up there, but by sewer plant we do. Citizens can do what they want to do on their own property; we can't do anything about that. But anything close to our infrastructure, we can and we are not in favor of that. Councilor

Nelson stated they said they would not be within 300' of our infrastructure. He asked if we have anything in writing, it was stated no, but we can direct staff to do the agreement. Councilor Dale state the easiest is to say no, but there are some assets to allowing this to be done. Mayor Williams doesn't want to say he doesn't want, but he is concerned with the city infrastructure. Councilor Dale stated she has battled with this, and is more concerned to send a message to our citizens saying this is okay to do. She knows the city's supervisors are not in favor of this. There is time in writing agreement; babysitting crews coming in. she has put a lot of thought to get comfortable in saying yes. Amount of getting paid to amount time in spending to write an agreement. If there is something hot in the City limits, they will come after us. Mayor Williams stated the sludge and shooting range area, he doesn't see a problem, or if they stay 300' away from city infrastructure. We can say yes or no on city property, and we can say what distance away from city infrastructure. Councilor Jensen asked about the clarifying on city property or infrastructure. Makes you copaiba and words to make us protected. It could be a revenue source that could off -set the property tax. We need to protect ourselves more by making this agreement. The Council asked Mr. McLeod if it would still be worth it for them if they have to stay greater than 300' from city infrastructure. He stated yes, they would stay 200' from any structure and the City can add whatever to permit as they see fit. We need to get this going and they are available to work out any details. Councilor Sands wants to be cautious of having them in our town. Mr. McLeod stated the City could escort them to sewer plant and then they are done and come back if there is some potential. He stated any future work would probably go north of the City. The Council asked if have most of the private owners in the City have already signed and he stated yes. If council doesn't want us by the sewer plant, then you can drop that little bit of property. He was asked if he had spoken with the PMDC and did they have any reservations, and he stated he has spoke with them last Wednesday or Thursday and they had no problems. The Council asked Mr. Osborn who decides on the golf course, and he stated we both have to. They have the surface rights, and the state has the mineral rights. Councilor Dale stated she had a meeting on Wednesday with the PMDC and they stated their attorney was going to look at the permit. Discussed what financial effect it would have on the golf course during this time of year. Mr. Osborn said they need to go through the PMDC board. Councilor Nelson stated he is okay with airport, sludge and shooting range, but not with the sewer plant. Ms. Cordova stated the department heads are not comfortable with the airport, there are soft spots on new runway and there are concerns with the irrigation. The old dump would most likely have to be cleared by EPA first. On the shooting range, there is a domestic well on the property. The County has given them rights to do their testing ready.

A motion was made by Dale and seconded by Nelson to not approve the request for permit to conduct seismographic operation on city owned property.

Discussed that the motion included no city property, our department heads do not support this. Councilor Heleker stated he doesn't see a problem with the sludge pit and doesn't know of any hesitation on that area from department heads. Discussed testing at the airport and the area around the runway. There is an irrigation line that runs south along runway, and empty trucks broke several lines during our project last year. The same system goes out through the field. Councilor Sands reflects back to the \$1,700 payment to use city property. We have a very old city and we need to protect the interest of our citizens. If they find something they could come back and ask again. Councilor Jensen stated it would be worth the chance to

take. Councilor Wickersham stated it might be a nightmare to write the rules to cover everywhere they want to be.

A motion was made by Jensen and seconded by Wickersham to approve the request for permit to conduct seismographic operation on city owned property at the shooting range off of Center Avenue only.

The motion APPROVED.

A motion was made by Jensen and seconded by Wickersham to approve the request for permit to conduct seismographic operation on city right of way, stay 300' away from any city right of way, give 72 hour notification, provide a map of where they will be conducting testing and meet all city ordinances.

If they want police escort, they need to pay for that. Ms. Cordova stated we don't want to babysit, and we do have a lot of rules on the books like obstructing, weight limits on streets, and hazards. It would be nice to have routes given to us, so we can designate which roads might be better to access, due to some of our roads being very fragile. Councilor Jensen asked about alleys, who says what can go on in alleys; he was informed that code states they can't be blocked.

Ms. Cordova asked if the council had a copy of the one given to them before. We can look at it tonight or schedule another meeting. She handed out copies of the agreement for review. Suggested \$25.00 an acre, no shocking, pay the city any damages on our property, not an exclusive permit, put back to near same condition, permit only good until they are done. Mr. Osborn can review agreement before it is signed.

A motion was made by Wickersham, and seconded by Jensen, that the permit is issued per the direction of our city attorney.

After a unanimous voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED.

C. Payette Civic League – Liz Long & Carol Bruce – They requested at last meeting for the City to sponsor a table for \$80.00 for the auction. The City would also decorate the table and provide for a centerpiece that will be auctioned. Sponsoring the table give the City two free tickets for the dinner.

A motion was made by Heleker, and seconded by Sands, to sponsor a table for \$80.00 and provide a centerpiece to be auctioned.

After a unanimous voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

A. PURA Annual Report – Councilor Heleker state the urban renewal district is coming along very well and they are well ahead of schedule. The district still owes the City \$165,256. They plan on paying back by fiscal year 2015. They are also looking at the possibility of a second district. The district is paying the City 5% interest on the money they borrowed.

B. IRVCO – Change Order #1 – Boat Ramp Improvements -

A motion was made by Heleker and seconded by Sands to approve change order #1 from IRVCO for the boat ramp improvements.

After a unanimous voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED.

**CITIZEN'S COMMENTS**

Steve Borweick 125 N. 21<sup>st</sup> Street. He works with a lot of different people, including self help groups, there are different situations with different people. He has never come to the city council without a solution, this time he doesn't have a solution. He didn't realize how bad crime was in our City until it happened to them. He talked to the chief, about his situation and was told that state statue is two years, he waited 3 weeks and called the prosecuting attorney and was told nothing could be done about the assault on his daughter. His neighbor poisoned his daughter's dog and again nothing was done. If you are ever going to do a crime, go to Payette to commit it that is what his self help groups tell him. The same guy is under allegation of doing the same thing to a child as he did with his daughter. We need to make Payette a safe place to live. He was asked if there is something specific he wants the City to look into. Mr. Osborn stated he was not going to call and discuss the case with him. Asked if this doesn't normally get handled through the police department, he state the officer told him it would be handled by Mr. Osborn. Councilor Heleker commended the police department regarding an assembly at the high school. It was on drinking and driving, and the use of seat belts. Good time to hear this message before prom. Along with people that came in and spoke, there was a strong appearance from our department. Officer Toth gave an excellent speak on seat belts. Mayor Williams stated he came back from AIC and discussed a program called Alive at 25, and this might be something we kick off this fall. Chief Clark stated he has everyone hired, but not on patrol for about 10 weeks. He hopes to get program Alive at 25 going and has two officers that want to be involved. It is designed for first time drivers between the ages of 14-24. A judge can divert the offender into the program and can dismiss the citation. Chief Clark stated that he is well aware of Mr. Borweick's issues on the dog poisoning incident and batter charges.

Thank you for hosting my father and I. I truly appreciated your presentation and having all your Department Heads at our gathering.



Joann Grasmick called 911 on March 31 at 1715 hours for her daughter with stroke symptoms. 

AGREEMENT TO MODIFY JOINT POWER AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of March, 2014 by and between the Payette County Recreation District, a recreation district organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, hereinafter referred to as the "Recreational District," the Payette School District No. 371J, a school district organized and existing under the laws of the State of Idaho, hereafter referred to as "School District," the City of Payette, a municipal corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Idaho, hereinafter referred to as the "City" and Payette County, Idaho, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Idaho, hereinafter referred to as the "County" and the Miracle League of Payette, Inc., a not for profit corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "League".

WHEREAS, on May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2007 the above named parties, excluding the League, entered into a joint powers agreement, "the original agreement" to create and maintain four ball fields located on property owned by the School District; and

WHEREAS, the parties have been approached by the League which wants to develop and maintain another field which field will be used by special needs children; and

WHEREAS, the original parties to the Joint Powers Agreement are willing to modify the original agreement to allow the League to develop and maintain a 5th ball field;

THEREFORE THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. All parties to the original agreement hereby agree that the original agreement may be modified to allow the League to develop and maintain a fifth ball field on property owned by the school district.

2. The League agrees that it will develop the field at its cost. The League agrees that it will maintain the field in a professional and workman like manner and to the same degree as the Recreational District maintains the existing four fields. The league agrees that the field will be used for sporting events only and that it shall not be used for any illegal, for profit, non-athletic events.

3. The league agrees that it will accept and be bound by the terms of the original agreement.

4. This agreement shall remain in effect in perpetuity so long as the ball field is maintained as agreed to herein. In the event of the dissolution of the League or the League ceases to maintain the field, then the agreement shall terminate and the property shall revert back to the owner thereof, the School District, with no claims against it from

any other party.

5. Modifications within the scope of this Agreement shall be made only by mutual consent of the parties, by the issuance of a written modification signed and dated by all parties, prior to any changes becoming effective.

6. Each party, through any authorized representative, may access and examine all books, papers, or documents related to this Agreement.

7. Any provision of this Agreement which shall prove to be invalid, void or illegal shall in no way affect, impair or invalidate any other provision hereof, and the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect.

8. All the terms and conditions contained in the original agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

9. This Agreement shall be binding on and shall inure to the benefit of all parties hereto and to their respective successors, assigns and legal representatives.

10. This Agreement is executed for Recreation District by its Board of Commissioners as attested by the Recreation District Secretary, executed for the School District by its Chairperson of its Board of Trustees attested to by the School District Clerk, executed for the City by the Mayor, attested

**NEW BUSINESS:**

A. Pool Update: Katrina Smith stated that swim lessons are going good. They start their second batch on Thursday. She handed the Committee the Spring break specials she did. A lifeguard training class was recently taught by Chelsie Fugate with 7 receiving new certification and 7 receiving re-certifications. Our lifeguard certification is cheaper than most people. We charge \$200.00 to take the class due to printing our own books. The pool is shut down due to boiler problems that started yesterday. We believe the heat exchanger broke and it is supposed to be in this week. The pool hours change in June. It was stated that the solar heating system starts when the outside pool opens. There has been a concern about people walking naked from the shower to the dressing rooms and will be putting a shower curtain up. There have also been concerns about the hallway being slick and asked for suggestions. If we use a floor mat they have to be changed frequently and that needs to be budgeted for. Discussed that the concrete application that was done might be warranted. Mr. Jensen stated that he has a young man that wants to do an Eagle Scout project. He would like to install doors on the men's bathroom stalls. Ms. Smith stated that Special Olympics want to rent the pool on June 7<sup>th</sup>. This would be something great for the community.

**B. Parks Update:**

1. Arbor Day – The Committee was told that Arbor Day is April 15<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 at Centennial Park and all are invited to attend.

The boat ramp project is almost completed. The gangways are being installed today and will need a little bit of asphalt to complete the project. Phase II grant has been applied for and the City will be notified in May if we received it or not.

Grass has been planted around the amphitheater.

The RV dump and bathrooms are open at the parks and will be hiring seasonal help for the parks. New rock has been placed at the wye coming into Payette.

**GENERAL DISCUSSION:**

Kim Bruce asked about the bike terrain trail. She stated that she was told the school district doesn't want to participate in the development of this. Ms. Cordova stated that the Mayor and she met with Ms. King and it is not out of the realm of possibility. The land at Westside School has to be used as a park, but there is some discussion on swapping that property out for land behind McCain School, that would make it more liquid for the school district. The bike trail on that site would not have to be permanent and not much money would have to be invested there. The City needs to go to the school district with a plan on April 14<sup>th</sup> school board meeting. Ms. Bruce stated her first choice was the brickyard property. The Committee will try for the school property first and if that doesn't work out we will go to the City Council with the proposal for the brickyard property.

Kurt Key stated that the Friends of the Pool have decided to apply for several grants. One is for the Zack Foundation for \$1,000 to put on a safety program and Deyer's ice cream grant is for \$1,000 worth of ice cream. They will be doing a yard sale this spring and have found a matching grant from Woodsman Scholarship. These grants would be used for under privileged kids to take swim lessons. He stated they would partner with the City to get the most for their money. It was stated that if they receive the grants they would need to ask the City Council for the request on swim lessons and what price would be charged.
