AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, REPEALING SECTION 10.45.010 AND CREATING A NEW SECTION 10.45.010 OF THE PAYETTE CITY CODE PROHIBITING THE USE OF ELECTRONIC WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS DEVICES FOR TEXTING AND GAMING WHILE OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 10.45.010 of the Payette Municipal code is hereby repealed and there is hereby created a new Section 10.45.010 which section shall read as follows:

10.45.010 USE OF WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS DEVICES

(A) No person shall operate a motor vehicle while using a hand held electronic wireless communications device while playing games thereon, or to write, send, or read a text based communication.

(B) "Hand held electronic communications device" includes wireless or cellular phones, PDAs, Blackberries, smart phones, laptop and notebook computers utilizing VOIP (voice over internet protocol) technology, wireless and cellular phones utilizing push-to-talk technology and any other mobile communication device that uses short-wave analog or digital radio transmissions between the device and a transmitter to permit wireless communications to and from the user of the device.

(C) As used in this section "write, send, or read a text based communication" means using an electronic wireless communications device to manually communicate with any person using a text based communication, including, but not limited to, communications referred to as a text message, instant message, or electronic mail.

(D) For purposes of this section, a person shall not be deemed to be writing, reading, or sending a text based communication if the person reads, selects, or enters a telephone number or name in an electronic wireless communications device for the purpose of making or receiving a telephone call.

(E) A violation of this section is an infraction punishable by a fine of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form as permitted by Idaho Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.

**ORDINANCE \_\_\_\_\_**

AN ORDINANCE OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, DEFINING AND CREATING STANDARDS FOR THE ADJUSTMENT OF PROPERTY LINES BETWEEN LOTS BY AMENDING TITLE SIXTEEN AND TITLE SEVENTEEN OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of Payette, Idaho:

**SECTION 1: Section 16.04.010 is hereby amended to read as follows:**

**16.04.010: PURPOSE:**

~~In order to promote the public health, safety and general welfare of present and future residents, and to bring about a coordinated and efficient development of the city, the following regulations for the subdividing of land within the city are adopted.~~

The purpose of a Lot Line Adjustment is to accommodate a transfer of land between adjacent separate lots in order to correct property line or setback encroachment or create better lot design without creating non-conforming lots or setback requirements. Lot line adjustments do not create additional building lots. The decision on a lot line adjustment application is made by City in an administrative procedure.

**SECTION 2: Section 16.04.020 is hereby amended to read as follows:**

**16.04.020: APPLICABILITY:**

A. The regulations codified in this title shall apply to all subdivisions and to all development within the corporate limits of the city, or within the area of city impact as established by ordinance, including the following:

1. The dividing of any lot, tract or parcel of land into two (2) or more tracts, lots or parcels for transfer of ownership or building development;

2. The dedication of any street or alley through or along any tract of land;

3. Any division or resubdivision of a lot or parcel into sublots except as provided in subsection B of this section.

B. The regulations codified in this title shall not apply to any of the following:

~~1. A readjustment of lot lines as shown on a recorded plat which does not reduce the area, frontage, width or depth of each building site below the minimum prescribed by any city ordinance or any covenant pertaining to said plat nor create any new lots.~~

~~A duly recorded or filed record of survey that conforms to Idaho Code title 55, chapter 19 shall be required for any lot line adjustment or adjustment of property boundaries between two (2) adjacent parcels. Such record of survey shall be filed both with the Payette County recorder and the city of Payette. In addition to the requirements of Idaho Code 55-1906, the certificate of surveyor shall be included on the record of survey. The survey shall also contain the original lot line(s), the adjusted parcel lines, the square footage of the adjusted parcels, correct street names, footprint(s) of all existing building(s) (with dimensions shown from the adjusted line), a note giving the zone standard in effect for the area or as specifically approved and a certification and signature of the city engineer verifying that the record of survey complies with state law, title 55 of the Idaho Code and with this title.~~

~~The adjustment of the property boundaries shall not reduce either parcel below the minimum prescribed by any applicable city ordinance or as specifically approved, nor violate setback requirements. The record of survey shall so contain all existing easements of record. Accompanying the record of survey shall be a new property description of each adjusted parcel. The adjusted property boundary between the parcels shall be marked at each endpoint, angle point, and where the adjusted boundary changes direction, with monuments that conform to the provisions of Idaho Code 54-1227. The city engineer shall verify compliance with this section prior to the record of survey being filed with the Payette County recorder.~~

~~12. A division of land into parcels of five (5) acres or more designated to be used solely for agricultural purposes, and which does not involve any new street dedication other than dedications widening existing streets.~~

~~23. An allocation of land in the settlement of an estate of a decedent or a court decree for the distribution of property thereunder. Provided however, that any development of any lands divided as a result of the settlement of an estate of a decedent or a court decree for the distribution of property shall conform to all requirements of this code.~~

~~34. The exceptions contained in subsections B1, B2 and B3 of this section are from the review and approval requirements of~~

this code only. Surveys must still be prepared in accordance with these regulations and filed with the county recorder. A copy of any plat, amended plat or correction or survey plat must also be provided to the city engineer, city clerk.

**SECTION 3: There is hereby created a new Section 16.04.030 -  
LOT LINE ADJUSTMENTS**

A. Limitations on and conditions of lot line adjustments:

1. Lot line adjustments shall not result in the creation of any additional building sites.
2. A parcel of land that is not buildable because it does not conform to Municipal Code regulations, was created improperly, or did not qualify for a building permit for any reason, cannot be converted to a buildable parcel through a lot line adjustment.
3. Lot line adjustments require review and approval by the City.
4. Lot line Adjustments are accomplished by recording a deed describing the property that will be transferred, recording a deed describing the receiving parcel, then recording a deed describing the exterior boundaries of the combined properties.
5. A deed describing the new boundaries of the parcel from which the property was transferred shall also be recorded.
6. To insure that an unanticipated or additional parcel of land is not inadvertently created, deeds shall be submitted to the City for review and approval prior to recording.

B. The following shall require a record of survey and shall not be considered a lot line adjustment:

1. A change in a lot line that results in a change in the location of an approach, utilities, easements or a septic tank or a drainfield.
2. A decrease in any lot size of more than 20%.
3. Any adjustments which alter the boundaries of an existing subdivision.

4. An increase in the number of lots within a subdivision.

C. The following information shall be submitted with an application for a lot line adjustment:

1. Cover letter addressed to the City describing the applicant's intent.

2. Description of the receiving property, sending property, property being transferred and descriptions of all resulting parcels.

3. Dimensioned and scaled site plan representing the following (existing and proposed):

property lines;

adjacent streets and alleys;

curb cuts, driveways, and parking areas;

easements;

site drainage;

all structures; and

North arrow and scale.

4. Lot Line Adjustment fee as established by resolution of the City Council.

**SECTION 4: There is hereby created a new Section 17.12.040**

**17.12.040: SURVEY AND ESTABLISHMENT OF PROPERTY CORNERS:**

Before any person may apply for, or receive, a building permit, variance, a conditional use permit or any other zoning or use permit which involves the locating, varying, changing, moving or altering of lot lines or corners, or for new construction or for major exterior changes which alter the outside dimensions of a structure, the person seeking the permit shall provide a survey by a licensed surveyor in which the lot lines or boundaries and corners have been established and pinned and recorded as a matter of record. By the time of application and inspection, the surveyor shall have visibly staked the lot lines and pinned the corners.

**SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY**

Should any section, clause, or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 6: CONFLICTING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS**

If any conflict occurs between this Ordinance and provisions of the other City Ordinances, the more restrictive Ordinance shall take precedence.

**SECTION 7: EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage, approval, and publication in one (1) issue of the local newspaper.

**SECTION 8: PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY**

This Ordinance may be published in summary form as allowed by Idaho Code.

- A. **Highway 52 Heritage By-Way Committee:** Anne Curtis from the Payette County Museum stated that she did not have any updated information, but stated that she will be back at a later date to ask for funding.
- B. **Budget Discussion:** Mary Cordova presented the Council with the preliminary budget. Ms. Cordova and the Council discussed the budget and the Council had no significant changes to the budget as presented.
- C. **Employee Handbook:** Jennifer Kelley presented the council with a change to the employee handbook regarding Paid Time off (PTO). The Council decided to strike the following from the second paragraph "at least one week".
- D. **Porta Potty at Greenway –** Ivan Mussell stated that he is on the Parks and Recreation Committee and there has been an issue with human feces at the Greenway and the Committee would like to see a porta potty at the Greenway. The Council directed staff to order a porta potty and have it placed in the parking lot of the Greenway behind the fence and make sure it is secured so it doesn't end up in the river.

**OLD BUSINESS**

- A. ORDINANCE #1349 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ADDING A NEW SECTION 17.80 TO THE PAYETTE CITY CODE WHICH SECTION REQUIRES DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEES; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER – 3<sup>rd</sup> Reading

A motion was made by Heleker and seconded by Mussell to introduce Ordinance #1349 by title only.

At the roll call:

Ayes: Hanigan, Dodson, Cochran, Heleker and Mussell

Nays:

The motion CARRIED.

Mayor Williams stated that this is the final reading for this ordinance and that it affects the budget. Mayor Williams stated that we do not have to pass all of them, we have currently been collecting development fees in the amount \$850 and the impact fees would be \$2900 for residential.

Councilor Mussell stated that he has a hard time to see the fees going up so much. Councilor Mussell stated that he is all for seeing new growth in the area, but doesn't want to stop building due to these fees. Councilor Mussell stated that the street fees are new and he would like to see it passed without the street fees and might be easier for people to build without that fee. Mayor Williams asked how often the fees can be revisited. Clerk Cordova stated that it needs to be looked at annually to see how you are working towards your projects that were listed on the capital improvement plan. If we exclude one of the categories now, we have to go through the whole process again. Mayor Williams asked if it can be done internally. Clerk Cordova stated yes, anything can be done internally with time.

Councilor Dodson stated that she kind of felt obligated since we gave the money to have the study done. Mayor Williams stated that if we were to do anything with the Ordinance we need to pass it in its entirety or take out some items.

Councilor Hanigan stated that it is much better to collect impact fees by ordinance then to collect development fees on a kiss and a promise. Councilor Hanigan stated that she does tend to agree with Ivan that maybe the street fees need to be removed. Mayor Williams stated that this city has more parks than any other city around and we have a lot of land that we already own. I know that the big number is the streets but I personally don't see the need to collect a bunch of money for the parks.

Councilor Cochran stated that this brings back a lot of heartburn with council of past and present with ductile iron and the additional cost and now we are back doing something else to them that is going to cost them more money. I have not personally called or talked to anyone to see if they know or how they feel about this. Clerk Cordova stated that on your impact fee committee we did include developers and contractors locally and they were in favor of adopting it as a whole. Mayor Williams stated that one of the developers Stan Clements did not have a problem with it. In the interest of cost I hate to see us give up streets, but it is the biggest dollar amount. If we take away street and park it would bring us down to \$812. We have a new fire station going up and a new domestic violence shelter and I think public safety is a huge thing.

Doug Argo stated that at the last meeting there was some information requested from the City of Middleton. Their total impact fee for streets and parks was \$4.84 per square foot, \$1.64 for industrial and residential was \$1547 for a dwelling unit. Ridleys got their permit before these fees were implemented. Councilor Mussell stated that it might have kept them from building because of the high fees, but it is a catch 22. Councilor Heleker asked if the whole residential fee was \$1547. Mr. Argo stated yes.

A motion was made by Mussell and seconded by Cochran to pass Ordinance 1349 on its 3<sup>rd</sup> reading including police and fire fees in the amount of \$820 for residential and \$.50 per square foot for a non-residential.

The motion CARRIED.

Councilor Heleker stated that he wants people to come in, but I don't want to put the burden on the citizens of Payette that are already here. I am leaning towards something in the middle. Do we have to do all or nothing in the street fees? Clerk Cordova stated yes, but it does give the council the opportunity to do the exaction method, providing credit for infrastructure that they put in.

A motion was made by Heleker and seconded by Nelson to pass Ordinance 1349 as amended.

ORDINANCE #1348 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, CREATING A NEW CHAPTER 5.38 IN TITLE 5 TO LICENSE AND REGULATE USED CAR SALES AND USED CAR LOTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SALES; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER; PROVIDING A PENALTY-2<sup>nd</sup> READING

A motion was made by Heleker and seconded by Hanigan to introduce Ordinance 1348 by title only.

After a unanimous voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED.

Councilor Hanigan stated that she has a problem with franchised used car lots under this ordinance. Franchised companies have to have continuing education and so on. I don't think there is a reason to put new car dealers under this. Mayor Williams asked if this came from a committee. Clerk Cordova stated it came from Planning & Zoning. Councilor Hanigan stated that Commissioner Hanigan was not present when this ordinance was sent through planning & zoning. Clerk Cordova stated that there have been changes and the council does not have them in front of them tonight.

A motion was made by Mussell and seconded by Heleker to move Ordinance 1348 to its 3<sup>rd</sup> reading.

After a unanimous voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

- A. Larry & Nancy Kelley – 726 North 4<sup>th</sup> Street

Mayor Williams stated that he will be excusing himself from the meeting to represent Mr. Kelley. Mayor Williams stated that the Kelley's bought 12 feet of property from the church 10 years ago and at that time they were never told they needed to do a lot line adjustment. Mayor Williams stated that they just learned they needed to have their property surveyed because it is one of the requirements of the lot line adjustment when they applied for a conditional use permit for a garage they are building. Mayor Williams stated that he believes the Kelley's should get an exception due to the fact that they were never notified that they needed to do a lot line. Clerk

Cordova stated that the Council changed the lot line adjustment requirements in the code about 6 months ago to make it easier on our citizens. Clerk Cordova stated this is something that other people that are building in town are doing, and one of them happens to be in the audience tonight, Mr. Josh Jackson. Clerk Cordova stated that most of the time when someone sells another person property they just go down to the title company and have them draw up the papers and have it recorded and we are never notified until they pull a building permit. Clerk Cordova stated that she has talked to the county and when they see items like this come across they have started giving the City a courtesy call to let them know.

A motion was made by Heleker and seconded by Dodson to table this agenda item to the next agenda.

The motion CARRIED.

B. Curb Cut Request – Josh Jackson – 1005 Center Ave –

Mr. Jackson stated that since his curb cut is not 21 foot away from the current curb, he needs the council's approval. Mr. Jackson stated that since he had to reduce the size of his garage he has to park it in the driveway and needs a curb cut so he's not jumping the curb every time.

A motion was made by Mussell and seconded by Heleker to approve the curb cut request by Josh Jackson at 1005 Center Avenue.

The motion CARRIED.

C. Adoption of Employee Handbook

A motion was made by Heleker and seconded by Mussell to approve the employee handbook as amended with the "at least one week" omitted.

The motion CARRIED.

D. Appeal Hearing of Abatement of Dangerous Building – Tim McGourty – 121 N Main St

The council recessed into an Appeal Hearing at 8:04 pm.

Mr. McGourty – 3736 East Zaldaia Lane; Meridian, Idaho 83642

Mr. McGourty stated that he has owned the building for 25 years, and moved away from Payette 17 years ago. Mr. McGourty handed out a copy of the letter that the city wrote to Mr. McGourty and the response letter from Mr. McGourty as well as some pictures of the building. Mr. McGourty stated that the letter that was sent to him told him he needed to remove the west wall. This is a non-bearing load wall, and it has been a number of years since I have seen this wall and it is disappointing. My letter addresses grading and leveling the lot, putting in a new door and repairing the brickwork. Mr. McGourty was told that he needed to come in front of this board for approved. Mr. McGourty stated that as some of the council may or may not know he has been a commercial masonry contractor for over 30 years and does restoration of buildings. I haven't had much interest in this building over the years and the market hasn't looked good. I have had

people make offers but nothing to spark my interest. I think most of this damage had come over the last year and this is the first letter I have received from the city about the masonry work.

Councilor Mussell stated that Mr. McGourty is planning on doing the work and cleaning the place up what is the direction of staff. Doug Argo stated that he needs clarification on what Mr. McGourty wants to do. Mr. McGourty stated that if we are going to bring guys out we are going to fix the exterior of the wall and replace the bricks that have come loose, replace the door that is covered with plywood and the areas that have been damaged. I suggested removing the chimney at the end of the building. We would like to remove the debris at the back of the building and grade that area. Mr. Argo asked what he meant by restoring. Mr. McGourty stated that they would be restoring all the loose brick. Mr. McGourty stated that he was inside the building today and there is some sluffing at the base of one wall, so there is probably 7 or 8 days with 2 or 3 guys. Mr. Argo stated that he was part of the team that looked at this building. They got a warrant to go inside the building and check it out and other than this back wall there didn't seem to be any significant danger to citizens. We don't want a kid or person walking back there and a brick fall on them and get hurt. There could be several bricks that come down at once especially around the door, my perspective sounds like what his proposing will work. He would take down the portions of the wall that are unstable and rebuild it and put a gutter up and taking down the chimney, with that work I think he would mitigate this dangerous situation. Mr. Argo stated that is assuming he doesn't find anything that changes that. I apologize I didn't know you were a masonry contractor and that would have simplified some things. Mr. McGourty stated that he lived in this community for years and when he arrived and saw what it looked like he will get it taken care of.

Councilor Hanigan stated that she can vouch for Mr. McGourty's masonry background. Councilor Cochran stated that he can also vouch for Mr. McGourty's background. Councilor Cochran stated that he is one of the most irresponsible landlords we have, he has issued Mr. McGourty one ticket and possible two for this building we are talking about. Mr. McGourty stated that yes he has received a few violations for the weeds. Councilor Cochran stated that he has received citations for hazards and he would just assume him sell or tear down his building and not have any association with the downtown area.

Mayor Williams asked if there was a basement under this building. Mr. McGourty stated no, when he bought this building the floor joist were rotted out and no support system. When he bought the building he spent \$12,000 and poured new concrete floors and brought it up to a rental status and it was rented for 2 or 3 years.

Mayor Williams asked Attorney Osborn if they say ok goes ahead with the work what recourse do we have if he doesn't do what he says he's going to do. Attorney Osborn stated we grant his appeal saying he will do what he says and if he doesn't we do what we say we are going to do in the letter and do the work ourselves and assess it to the property.

Mayor Williams asked Mr. McGourty if he is going to bring this up to a rental status. Mr. McGourty stated that he wouldn't go that far. Mr. McGourty stated that he wants to do this repair and that the building needs to be cleaned up and to put it into a rental status would cost him at least \$10,000 to redo the store front, electrical and I'm not sure the current market allows. Mayor Williams stated that since you haven't been here for 7 or 8 years you might notice that our downtown is not as vacant as it once was. Mr. McGourty stated yes, he did notice that when he was driving into town and I would say this to the council that I certainly intend over the next 6 or 8 months to do repairs to the front of the building and that is not part of my purpose here today and

give thought that there are less vacant buildings. Mayor Williams stated that as a realtor that might be a way to generate some income.

A motion was made by Mussell and seconded by Hanigan to allow Mr. McGourty to commence with what he says he's going to do and revisit it upon complaints and to complete the work within 30 days.

## ORDINANCE 1348

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, CREATING A NEW CHAPTER 5.38 IN TITLE 5 TO LICENSE AND REGULATE USED CAR SALES AND USED CAR LOTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SALES; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER; PROVIDING A PENALTY:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. The Payette Municipal Code is amended by the addition of a new Chapter 5.38, entitled "USED CAR SALES AND USED CAR LOTS," which chapter shall read as follows:

### Chapter 5.38

#### USED CAR SALES AND USED CAR LOTS

##### Sections:

- 5.38.010 Definitions
- 5.38.020 Established Used Car Lots
- 5.38.030 License Requirements and Procedures for Obtaining License
- 5.38.040 Regulations
- 5.38.050 Revocation
- 5.38.060 Penalty

##### **5.38.010 Definitions**

1. "Used car," as used in this chapter, means any used, pre-owned or second-hand motor vehicle to which a certificate of title or license plates have been issued and which motor vehicle has been registered for use on the highways by a purchaser, consumer or by a dealer, and includes any used or second-hand vehicle, defined as any vehicle required to be titled, trailer coaches or trailers weighing over 1,000 pounds.
2. "Used car dealer" means a person who brokers, deals or engages in the purchase, sale, lease, consignment sale or exchange of five (5) or more used cars within a 12-month period.
3. "Used car business" means the purchase, sale, lease, consignment sale or exchange by any person, firm or corporation of five (5) or more used cars within a 12-month period.
4. "Used car lot" means any place where used cars are displayed and offered for purchase, sale, lease, consignment sale or exchange in the open by a used car dealer or used car business.
5. "Established used car lot" means any land in the City of Payette maintained or used

for conducting a used car business which business was in existence at the time this chapter was created.

#### **5.38.020: Established Used Car Lots**

Any established used car lot must have:

A. A permanent structure containing not less than one hundred twenty (120) square feet of interior floor space to be used as business or sales office. Any new structure to be built shall conform to the Payette Municipal Code and the International Building Code, 2009 edition. Any existing structure shall substantially conform to standards established in the Payette Municipal Code, in regard to matters connected with public health and safety. The City Building Inspector shall cause an inspection to be made to determine such compliance.

B. Improved grounds complying with the following minimum requirements upon that portion of the land to be used for display and/or offering for sale of used cars:

1. Parking space for inventory shall be not less than ten (10) feet by twenty (20) feet for each used car.

2. Improved ground shall contain a gravel base of not less than four (4) inches covered by a minimum of two (2) inches of pavement or concrete that conforms to Idaho Department of Transportation Standards of Specifications.

3. The finished grade of such improved grounds shall be not less than twelve (12) inches or more than thirty six (36) inches above the grade of the street adjoining said premises.

4. Two driveways, one for ingress and one for egress, or one driveway adequate to permit simultaneous ingress and egress.

C. Must be in compliance with all standards of the Payette Municipal Code, including but not limited to, section 17.72.020.

#### **5.38.030: License Requirements and Procedure for Obtaining License**

No person, firm, corporation or other entity shall operate as a used car dealer or engage in a used car business within the City of Payette without a City Used Car Sales License as herein provided. A separate City Used Car Sales License shall be required for each established used car lot.

The City Clerk is hereby authorized to issue a City Used Car Sales License upon submission by the applicant of a written application on forms to be provided by the City Clerk and upon compliance by the applicant with the following requirements:

A. The application shall be accompanied by written detailed plans showing the layout of land to be used, the portion thereof to be improved as required herein, method proposed for improvement, drainage, driveways for ingress and egress, and buildings to be built or existing buildings to be used in the operation of the established used car lot.

The application shall also be accompanied by evidence that he/she has obtained all applicable zoning, use, or site plan approvals/permits required to be obtained prior to operating a used car lot or business in the proposed location in the City. The granting of a City Used Car Sales License is contingent on obtaining all applicable zoning, use, or site plan approvals/permits. The City Clerk shall submit all such plans to the City Engineer for his/her approval prior to granting of the City Used Car Sales License.

B. Applicant must furnish evidence that he/she possesses a valid State of Idaho Used Vehicle Dealer's License.

C. There shall be a one-time City Used Car Sales License fee in the amount of \$100 paid when an application is filed. There shall be no other license fees as long as in the lot remains in compliance with City Codes. In the event the City Clerk determines that the Used Car Sales lot is out of compliance with City Codes, the license shall become null and void, and before an applicant may re-commence business, there shall be a renewal application filed. There shall be a \$100.00 renewal fee paid with the application for a renewal.

No City Used Car Sales License issued under this ordinance may be transferred except upon written application by the licensee and the proposed transferee on forms to be provided by the City Clerk and the payment of a transfer fee in the amount of \$25. Provided however, the transferee shall be required to furnish any and all information as may be contained in an initial application for a City Used Car Sales License. Prior to transferring any City Used Car Sales License, the City Clerk shall determine that the established used car lot for which the City Used Car Sales License has been issued is complying with all of the provisions of this ordinance.

#### **5.38.040: Regulations**

Each licensee under this ordinance shall comply with the following regulations:

1. Keep the premises in a neat and clean condition. Dealer shall not allow any used motor vehicles that are part of its inventory to encroach upon the streets, alleys, sidewalks or other publicly maintained areas of the City.
2. Not allow any loud or boisterous noises to emanate from its place of business, either by persons congregating there or by the playing of recording instruments, radios and/or television sets or other sound-reproducing equipment.
3. At all times keep each motor vehicle used in connection with its said business or maintained as part of the inventory thereof insured with public liability and property damage insurance in an amount not less than \$10,000 per person and \$20,000 per accident, personal injury or death liability insurance and \$5,000 property damage insurance.

#### **5.38.050: Revocation**

Any City Used Car Sales License issued under this ordinance shall be automatically revoked upon termination, suspension, revocation or failure to renew the licensee's State of Idaho Used Vehicle Dealer's License or upon proof by competent legal evidence that the licensee made a false statement in any application for City Used Car Sales License filed upon this ordinance. Any such City Used Car Sales License may be revoked by the City Council in their discretion upon proof of conviction of the licensee for a violation of this ordinance.

#### **5.38.060: Penalty**

Any violation of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor punishable by fine, imprisonment or both, up to but not exceeding the maximum penalties set forth in Idaho Code § 50-302, as amended.

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.



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
