August 3, 2015

ROLL CALL

Members Present: Mayor Jeff Williams, Mark Heleker, Ray Wickersham, Craig Jensen, Jeff Sands, Lee Nelson and Nancy Dale

Staff Present: Mary Cordova, City Coordinator; Steve Castenada, Fire Chief; Jake Hust, Water Superintendent ; Matea Gabiola, Admin Assistant; Bert Osborn, City Attorney ;Mark Clark , Chief of Police; Doug Argo, City Engineer.

6:45 PM – Continuation of Public Hearing

A. Chapter 17.72 Off Street Parking and Loading Facilities: Bert Osborn asked Ms. Cordova for a current report of Chapter 17.72. Ms. Cordova addressed the Mayor and the council and stated that she believed this was a suggestion by the City Council to create an ordinance which allows for off street parking in the downtown commercial zone, and allows for exceptions in the off street parking downtown commercial zone. Ms. Cordova stated this came about when Mr. Irvin was having to apply for a variance to code because he did not have adequate space for a loading zone or off street parking, and he had determined that most of the businesses in our C1 zone do not have adequate off street loading zones or parking areas. This was sent to the Planning & Zoning Commission then the Planning & Zoning Commission said yes we like that idea, it was going to save a step for our downtown business owners. However, their suggestion was if they do have room for parking they should use it. Ms. Cordova stated this is how this was modeled and recommended for approval by the Planning & Zoning Commission to the council. Ms. Cordova stated that they may have seen this before. Mr. Osborn asked if there were any questions for Ms. Cordova. Ms. Cordova brought the councils attention on Page 19 of the meeting packet. Williams addressed Mr. Osborn, leaving it if its available use it, that doesn't sound like it's going to fit in an ordinance real well, any suggestions on how to word that, or modify our ordinance. Ms. Cordova brought the councils attention to LINE C on page 19 in the ordinance. Ms. Cordova stated if somebody changes use, intensify the use and they can't meet the number of off street parking requirements or a loading zone as required in our zoning code , then they would be exempt from the requirement of providing off street parking. However, exemption is applied to the land use on the lot requiring you use a number of spaces. Ms. Cordova brought the council to LINE D. in the ordinance page. Ms. Cordova asked if that answered Williams's question and if he has any other suggestions. Heleker stated he wasn't clear on the in lieu parking space construction fee. Heleker asked Ms. Cordova if she could address that more Ms. Cordova stated that that line was from an ordinance from another city, which has city owned parking lots in their downtown core area, and the business owners use these parking lots for either their business or residential use. This is how they enacted a mechanism to provide some funding to create more downtown parking spaces. Ms. Cordova stated they can take that part of the ordinance out. Ms. Cordova also pointed out in the last paragraph says if you don't have enough parking the city council is going to set an amount, maybe you require 20 spaces, but you can only provide 10. Ms. Cordova stated now you're going to have to provide a fee to the city, \$100 a lot, city takes that money and maintains and builds a parking lot. Ms. Cordova stated that this is not enacted the very last sentence says, that this fee is set by resolution of the council only when you enact it, or we can strike the whole thing. Wickersham thought LINE D was confusing at this point in the discussion, unless we are actually going to put a fee in there, and he wasn't sure where we could give them off street parking at this time anyway. Ms. Cordova stated at one point there was talk about having a parking area that's all landscaped down by the old train depot. Sands asked Ms. Cordova if this is

what the council wanted to introduce as the ordinance. Sands stated that maybe they should get some input from the Chamber of Commerce and downtown businesses. Sands brought attention that he sees UPS, Moving trucks and various other delivery trucks using this type of parking, and their only there a limited amount of time. Sands pointed out there would be no way to compute a square footage for delivery trucks due to the wide span of sizes . Sands thought of having a time allotment instead. Nelson stated that he saw this in an opposite way than Sands, Nelson stated that this does make it so that if there is no back alley parking available, loading zone available, that we can get around requiring. Sands stated that we don't require it now. Ms. Cordova stated that we are supposed to and that is the reason as to why we are doing this, and when they don't do it they have to come get a variance. Jensen wanted to see if we were making it easier for the downtown businesses, and it was a recommendation to have the Planning & Zoning come up with the ordinance. Dale stated that in her memory this came to light when Mr. Irving planning to do the restaurant and that this was put into place because of what was already happening, to allow the offloading, if the spots not there the spots not there. Williams wanted to add to that stating he thinks it started with Irvin, then when the courthouse was converted into residential units this came up again, and somebody said is there a way we can stream line this so they maybe don't have to do that. Heleker stated this may be encumbrance to new business owners and may not be user friendly is this in lieu fee, and whether that needs to be further explored. Heleker stated that maybe there is some value to that, but at this moment he feels like hearing from everyone else prior to making any decisions. Heleker only hesitation is that in lieu fee. Nelson stated to pass this as on the agenda as is, they can move this to a second hearing, so that the public and Chamber has a chance to come in and state how they feel about it, whether to follow through with it. Heleker stated to pass this as is and see what the input is from the public. Wickersham is in agreement, and this really hasn't been an issue until now, he had the idea of having a timeline in place for this issue. Jensen interjected that before our present ordinance that they would need to come and get a variance, to park a truck outside.

Ms. Cordova stated that he hears the council talking about off street loading, but this is also covering the off street parking. Ms. Cordova pointed the council to **LINE C in the black**, stating that is the current code. Also, in the black font where is says the effective number of off street parking areas were required in chapter 17.72, depending on what you are having whether its residential use, if it's a 3 bedroom home there supposed to have two off street parking spaces if it's a one bedroom they are allowed one. So it's all set out in this ordinance, but the parking guidelines are in there as well. Williams addressed Mr. Osborn stating that we have already approved what they have done at the courthouse, but asked how do they change this, if Ms. Cordova hadn't come to them would the council had any discussion about off street parking. Ms. Cordova stated that has not been approved, and they only thing that has been approved is phase one. They have allowed street parking because they don't have any approved parking spaces at this time. The council stated this is dealing with non-residential and parking in the downtown core in the C1 commercial zone. Mr. Osborn asked the audience if they wanted to comment on this proposal. Public Hearing closed at 7:08 pm.

COMMUNICATIONS

- A. Idaho Commissions of Hispanic Affairs: Williams brought up on page 15 the Idaho Commission of Hispanic Affairs, that there were some recommendations. Williams met with the leaders and attended a community gathering, and wanted to work toward a youth advisory council. Williams stated that Hispanics are a better portion of our community and we need to take notice of that.

AGENDA ITEMS

A. Ordinance #1393- Downtown off Street Parking and loading Facilities (1st Reading) :

A motion was made by Heleker moved to introduce Ordinance #1393 by title only Nelson seconded the motion.

After a voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED

Heleker main focus on this ordinance was the unloading and loading as well as the parking, there is still a lot to be considered. Dale stated that the planning and zoning has already looked over this ordinance and gather that they are not taking over this ordinance. Heleker brought the attention of the in lieu fee and this is needs to be considered as well, and that he would like to get community input on this ordinance. Dale stated that in looking over the Planning & Zoning minutes that they have already taken this to a public hearing and that they have given the recommendation. Their only question was the matter of fee, it says we may enact, not that we will which leaves it open to charge for development. Dale stated that she can't any negative in this ordinance and if we're going to send it back to go ahead and approve it. Heleker stated to move this to a second reading. Nelson wanted to see if downtown business would want to chip in for extra spot to help the parking flow.

A motion was made by Heleker to move this Ordinance # 1393 to a second reading motion seconded Jensen.

After a voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED

B. Ordinance #1392- Allow Residential Use in a Commercial Zone without CUP (2nd Reading):

A motion was made by Heleker moved to introduce Ordinance #1392 by title only. Nelson seconded the motion.

After a voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED

Nelson asked if this is the second reading on this ordinance. Heleker asked if there was urgency to get this done, or could we wait another two weeks for community input.

A motion was made by Heleker to move Ordinance #1392 to its third reading and seconded by Sands.

After a voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED.

C. SWAT Policy: Chief Clark stated this is the same policy presented before, but we have placed a dollar amount instead of a percentage.

A motion was made by Sands and seconded by Nelson to approve the SWAT Policy with the following changes made by Heleker to the paragraph under policy to be grammatically correct, could it please say ; shall receive an incentive pay.

After a voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED.

D. Hardin Sanitation – CPI Increase Request: Johnny Cochran, from Hardin Sanitation addressed the council. He is asking for a 2% price increase due to fuel prices and the cost of living expenses. Nelson wanted to know what that was going to do for the base rate. Not added to the cart expense but the service expense. Jensen appreciated that he brought this information down to the council's attention. Mr. Cochran says this is something he has to be proactive on due with the cost of maintaining equipment. Williams stated that with Payette having mandatory garbage cart at each home it gives a great presentation. Sands suggested having his start on October 1, 2015 Ms. Cordova stated we have the water and sewer increase on October 1, 2015 so we will just do it then.

A motion was made by Heleker to have 2% CPI increases for Hardin Sanitation effective as of October 1, 2015 the motion was seconded by Jensen.

At the roll call:

Ayes: Wickersham, Sands, Heleker, Nelson, Jensen, and Dale.

The motion CARRIED.

E. Approve FY2016 Tentative Budget: Nelson stated that one of the hang ups was the Library. Williams stated there were some modifications made, in talking with Ms. Cordova there probably are several lose ends, but this is our tentative budget to start with. Mrs. Haley addressed the council and stated that she met with her board, and they cut anything and everything that they could. Ms. Haley stated that the capital outlay book budget \$21,000, but the Library board left it at \$26,000. With Mrs. Haley's numbers crunching this numbers it now stands at \$24,000 not \$40,000. Dale stated that in the board meeting that the council would possible start at \$31,000, but the council was going to expect \$21,000. Dale's concern was the movies & books that weren't coming back (roughly \$5,100). She stated that she'll support your numbers here if they support their attentiveness there. Ms. Haley stated that libraries are a delicate balance and that this reason they are asking for more capital outlay. Erin has notes of what she has accomplished since coming here. Jensen came back to that that salaries increase \$24,000 to make one more Full Time employee. Ms. Haley stated that they currently have 3 Full Time (counting herself) employees and 2 part times. So this would make 4 Full Time Employee and 1 part time. Ms. Haley is asking about his to making it more productive in running the library. Nelson would ask Ms. Haley that is there anything else they could cut or is there anything other way to get the \$5,000. Williams directed the council to page #9 on the revenue there is \$70,000 and maybe the council could use some of those funds for the library. Williams also stated there possibly could be a creative way to get the Library their funding Ms. Cordova stated that this FY the Library has maxed itself out.

A motion was made by Heleker to approve the FY 2016 Tentative Budget of \$8,372,793.00 Dale seconded this motion with the following changes. Ms. Cordova moved to add \$5,000 more to make the amount \$8,377,793.00 for the sanitation budget and this doesn't affect the tax levy.

Ms. Cordova stated including your Library bond our property tax is \$2,380,637.00, which based upon the estimated taxed property value, to put the levy rate at .0110184. Jensen stated this puts us up 4% than last year. Sands stated your taking the forgone with the 3%, and the new tax rate. Ms. Cordova stated you're taking the 3% annexation and new construction and \$52,197.00 of forgone. Ms. Cordova also stated the non-exempt levy rate with not including the

bond is .01083495. Jensen had a question about unencumbered funds and if they were being used and how would he know they were being used. Williams also asked Ms. Cordova this question and wanting to know if they were increasing or decreasing, and came to the conclusion that's something that can be done in a work session. Ms. Cordova stated that she has already done that and they are diminishing. Heleker stated to possibly bring the levy rate back to what it used to be, and he calls for the question.

At the roll call:

Ayes: Wickersham, Sands, Heleker, Nelson, Jensen, and Dale.

The motion CARRIED.

- F. Community Yard Sale Request- Liz Amason: 490 North 20th St. Williams is stated that this is in front of the Council due to having an ordinance of having only three yard sales a year. Ms. Amason stated she spoke Chief Clark and he referred her to the Council. Ms. Amason stated wanting to do this community wide yard sale for all the people coming to town for Cruise Night weekend. Ms. Amason didn't want this to prohibit avid yard saler's to have yard sale during that weekend. Wickersham stated that this is regulated to keep some people from doing yard sales commercially. Ms. Amason stated this was brought to the council's attention a year ago, but wasn't followed through on Ms. Amason's part.

A motion was made by Jensen to not count yard sales on the weekend of Cruise Night as the 3 during the year motion was seconded by Nelson.

Dale stated that this is an ordinance that is already in place, and was changing the ordinance something that the Council able to do. Heleker stated are we granted a variance to the ordinance. Chief Clark stated that if someone wants to participate in this event they will put them on the list to keep track. Ms. Amason stated that to promote this during Cruise night there would be handouts and advertising. Williams stated that there are people who abuse having yard sales and that is why they have tracked the permits. Ms. Amason asked the council if they can put this on the next water bill.

At the roll call:

Ayes: Wickersham, Sands, Heleker, Nelson, Jensen, and Dale.

The motion CARRIED.

G: Donation Request: Dads of Life Kid's camp: Children's pastor, Connie Wheeler, from the Ontario Nazarene Church, has a program with the Snake River Correction Institute for the Inmates that are in a strenuous program to spend time with their children. This program is to host families, so the children are able to spend time with their dads. There are 12 children in this program and there are asking for passes or group rate for this program for the kids to spend time with their dads at the Payette Pool. Williams asked if any of the children or families are from Payette County. Ms. Wheeler stated that currently none are from the Payette County are, most are from Washington, Oregon and Nevada. Sands stated that the off set of this is that the Prison does employee a lot of Payette County residents. Jensen asked if they have gone to the City Ontario to have for program funding and they have aided, but Payette is the only one with a pool. Heleker asked are the other communities getting involved. Kiwi Loco is giving passes for one night.

A motion was made by Sands to approve donating 12 pool passes to the Ontario Church of the Nazarene for the Dads for Life Kids Camp the date being August 11, 2015 and each pass being \$3 apiece motion seconded by Heleker.

At the roll call:

Ayes: Wickersham, Sands, Heleker, Nelson, Jensen, Nelson and Dale.

The motion CARRIED

MAYORS COMMENTS:

Williams stated that all are doing a great job on the budget.

CITIZEN'S COMMENTS

Liz Amason stated the Idaho State Hispanic Commission contacted Margie Gonzalez, but hasn't heard back from her at this time. Ms. Amason is trying to contact her giving information about HTC as well as the Vista Americore working on food security, and that they are both project that they have been trying to get Hispanic members in there because it focuses a lot on lower income families. Heleker pointed out on page 14 that Hispanics make up 25.4 % of the total population equaling 1,994 residents.

CRAPO PLANS NEW TOWN MEETINGS *Will travel across southern Idaho during August, September*

Public Notice

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act and guidance from the US Department of Labor require Idaho to develop a policy that addresses local area designation issues in consultation with the State Workforce Development Council and chief local elected officials, after the consideration of public comments. A draft policy for the designation of local workforce development areas under the federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act is available for public comment.

Link #1 – Proposed Idaho Policy for Designation of Local Workforce Development Areas under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)

Although Idaho currently has no local workforce boards other than the State Council, the state must still comply with the U.S. Department of Labor's guidance to develop a policy for the appointment of local board members. Link #2 is a WIOA-updated version of the state's previous policy for certification of local boards.

Link #2 – Proposed Idaho Policy for Appointment/Certification of Local Workforce Development Boards

These documents are available for public review and comments until September 20, 2015. Upon conclusion of the public comment period, comments will be submitted to the Workforce Development Council. At the October 19, 2015 Workforce Development Council meeting, the Council will be asked to formally adopt or modify the policies. The Council will also be asked to recommend the two existing local areas for initial designation through June 30, 2017.

Idaho Policy for Appointment/Certification of Local Workforce Development Boards

For Public Comment - August 10, 2015 to September 30, 2015

Introduction

Section 107 of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) authorizes Local Elected Officials in designated Workforce Investment Areas to appoint local workforce investment boards, in accordance with criteria established by the Governor of each state. The primary function of these boards will be to set policy for the local workforce investment system.

The material that follows describes certification criteria established by the Governor, through the Idaho Workforce Development Council, and is divided into the following sections:

- I. Roles and responsibilities of Local Idaho Works Boards
- II. Composition requirements for local boards
- III. The certification process
- IV. Certification timelines
- V. Recertification/Decertification of local boards

I. Roles and Responsibilities

The local workforce development board is responsible for the functions outlined in WIOA Sec. 107(d). Among these functions are:

- A. Analyses of regional conditions;
- B. Leading efforts to engage employers;
- C. Leading efforts to develop and implement career pathways;
- D. Identifying and promoting proven and promising practices;
- E. Establishing standing committees to more effectively accomplish the work of the local boards;
- F. Better utilizing technology to facilitate connections among the intake and case management information systems of one-stop partners, to access services provided through the one-stop system (including remote areas), to meet the needs of individuals with barriers to employment, and to leverage resources and capacity;
- G. Promoting consumer choice of participants among providers;
- H. Enhancing coordination with education providers; and
- I. Assessing the physical and programmatic accessibility of one-stop centers annually in accordance with applicable nondiscrimination provisions under Title I of the WIOA and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

II. Composition

- A. Each Local Board must comply with the composition requirements listed at WIOA Section 107(b)(2).
- B. Local Elected Officials may appoint other individuals or representatives of other appropriate entities, including entities representing individuals with multiple barriers to employment and other special populations, as deemed appropriate.
- C. Members that represent organizations, agencies or other entities shall be individuals with optimum policy-making authority within the entities they represent.
- D. Statutorily-required Local Board members (Letter A above) must be appointed as full voting members.

III. Certification Process

A. Applications

Applications for certification of Local Boards (how often) must contain the following information:

- (1) Name, address, title, organizational affiliation/place of business, membership category, and term of appointment of proposed Local Board appointees. For those business sector representatives that are not chief executive officers or chief operating officers, the application must describe the "optimum policy-making or hiring authority" of the proposed appointee(s).

- (2) Documentation that the proposed business sector appointments represent businesses with employment opportunities that reflect the employment trends of the local area;
- (3) Assurances that the Local Board will:
 - a. select a Chair from among the business sector representatives on the local board;
 - b. adopt bylaws which comply with conflict of interest provisions described in Section 107(h) of WIOA as well as any conflict of interest policies established by the State.
 - c. conduct business in an open manner, in accordance with Section 107(e) of WIOA, by making available to the public, on a regular basis through open meetings, information about the activities of the local board, including information about the local plan before submission of the plan, about membership, the designation of One Stop operators, and the award of grants or contracts to eligible providers of youth activities, and on request, minutes of formal meetings of the local board.
- (4) Signature(s) of Chief Elected Official(s) authorized to act on behalf of the Local Elected Officials requesting certification.

IV. Timelines

Local Elected Officials may submit certification applications December 1-31 and should allow 45 days for review/approval of applications by the Governor.

V. Recertification/Decertification

A. Recertification

Recertification of Local Boards will be based upon compliance with membership and nomination requirements (in filling board vacancies), the extent to which the local board has ensured that workforce investment activities have enabled the local area to meet local performance measures, and fiscal integrity.

Failure of a local board to meet recertification requirements will result in dissolution of the board.

B. Decertification

Local boards may be decertified by the Governor at any time (after notice has been provided, along with an opportunity for comment) for fraud or abuse, failure to carry out the roles and responsibilities described above, or failure to meet local performance measures for two consecutive program years (in accordance with WIOA Section 116(c)).

If a local board is decertified, the Governor may require that a new local board be appointed and certified for the local area pursuant to a reorganization plan developed by the Governor, in consultation with Local Elected Officials in the local area.

Idaho Policy for Designation of Local Workforce Development Areas Under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) For Public Comment – August 10, 2015 to September 20, 2015

Purpose: As directed by U.S. Department of Labor Training and Employment Guidance Letter 27-14, the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 requires the Governor to develop a policy for designation of local workforce development areas in consultation with the State Workforce Development Council, chief elected officials and consideration of public comments.

Reference: WIOA Section 106(b); TEGL 27-14

Definitions

Initial Designation – The period of initial designation applies to program years 2015 and 2016 for the two existing local areas under WIA.

Subsequent Designation – The period of subsequent designation applies to program years 2017 and beyond.

Performed Successfully - Met or exceeded the negotiated levels of performance for the last two consecutive program years.

Sustained Fiscal Integrity – The Secretary of Labor has not made a formal determination that either the grant recipient or the administrative entity of the area mis-expended funds due to willful disregard of the requirements of the provision involved, gross negligence, or failure to comply with accepted standards of administration for the two-year period preceding the determination.

Status of Local Areas under WIA

In 2005, Governor Kempthorne desired to consolidate the existing six local workforce development areas into a single state area. Due to regulatory constraints, Governor Kempthorne instead created two local areas: the East-Central District local area and the Balance of State local area. These two local areas have operated as a consortium and single, statewide planning region with the Workforce Development Council serving as the local board.

Initial Designation under WIOA--WIOA Sec. 106(b)(2)

The East-Central District local area and the Balance of Idaho local area met the eligibility requirements for initial designation as local areas under WIOA by having performed successfully and sustained fiscal integrity. The Governor's Workforce Development Council will recommend for the Governor's approval the initial designation of these two local areas through June 30, 2017.

Subsequent Designation under WIOA--WIOA Sec. 106(b)(3)

After July 1, 2017, the two existing local areas will be eligible for subsequent designation if each performed successfully, sustained fiscal integrity and meet the requirements for regional planning as outlined in WIOA Sec. 106(c)(1). It is not necessary for the two local areas in existence under WIA as of 2014 to submit letters for application.

Designation on Recommendation of State Workforce Development Council -- WIOA Section 106(b)(4)

After the initial designation period and upon the Council's recommendation to the Governor, the Governor may approve a request from any unit of general local government for a geographic area to be designated as a local area. Designation will be made at the discretion of the Governor.

Applicants will be required to:

- Submit an application for designation prior to December 31st for consideration for the subsequent program year;
- Demonstrate labor market area through commute patterns;
- Include letters of commitment from local elected officials and employers;
- Identify available and appropriate education and training institutions;
- Identify an entity that can serve as a WIOA-compliant local workforce development board*;

- Identify federal and non-federal resources to fund the activities of the local board; and,
- Demonstrate that the creation of the new local area will not divert federal resources from existing local areas.

***A concurrent application for certification of a local workforce board should be submitted according to the Idaho Policy for Appointment/Certification of Local Workforce Development Boards.**

Redesignation Assistance under WIOA--WIOA Section 106(b)(6)

At the request of all of the local areas in a planning region, funds will be made available to facilitate activities required for redesignation of the existing local areas into a single local area.

Appeals - WIOA Section 106(b)(5)

Denial of Local Area Designation

A unit of general local government that requests but is not granted designation as a local Workforce Investment area under section 106 (b) (2) or (3) may submit an appeal to the State Workforce Development Council.

All such appeals shall be in writing and be filed within twenty (20) calendar days of the date the denial letter was mailed by the Governor or the Governor's designee. The appeal must include all factual and legal arguments as to why the appeal should be granted. The appeal shall be filed with the Chair of the Governor's Workforce Development Council, Idaho Department of Labor, Workforce Development Division, 317 West Main Street, Boise, Idaho 83735. The Chair of the Council, or the Chair's designee, shall promptly acknowledge receipt of the appeal.

The existing designated workforce areas will continue while the appeal is in progress and will be modified should the initial denial of designation be overturned.

(a) Appeal to the State Workforce Development Council

The appeal shall be deemed timely filed if it is received by the Chair of the Workforce Development Council within the 20-day period, unless the appeal is filed by mail, in which case the official postmark affixed by the U. S. Postal Service shall be deemed to be the date of filing. Any appeal that is filed late shall be summarily dismissed.

The Chair of the Council will select a hearing officer. The appeal shall be heard by the hearing officer not more than thirty (30) days after the appeal was filed. With the consent of the appealing party, the hearing may be held after the 30-day period, but in no case shall the hearing be conducted more than sixty (60) days after the appeal was filed.

The hearing officer shall inform the appellant of the date, time and place of the hearing by written notice mailed at least ten (10) calendar days in advance. The appellant shall have the right to present testimony and documentary evidence, to offer evidence in rebuttal, to present oral argument and to be represented by legal counsel. All testimony received by the hearing officer shall be under oath or affirmation. If the appellant retains legal counsel, federal WIOA funds cannot be used for remuneration.

An appellant must establish that it is entitled to designation as a local area according to this policy.

Within fifteen (15) days of the hearing, the hearing officer shall issue a recommended decision, which shall include findings of fact, recommendations and the basis therefore. That decision shall be mailed to the appealing party. The hearing officer shall file a copy of the recommended decision with the Chair of the Council.

The recommended decision of the hearing officer shall be placed on the agenda of the next Council meeting for disposition; however, if no Council meeting is scheduled within forty-five (45) days of the date the decision was issued, a special meeting of the Council, or a Committee designated by the Chair, shall be conducted within that 45-day period to accept, reject or modify the hearing officer's recommended decision.

In its deliberations, the Council shall consider only the evidence presented to the hearing officer. The Council shall not receive or consider any evidence not presented to the hearing officer. The decision of the Council shall be reduced to writing

and be mailed to the Governor and the appealing party. The decision must set out in summary fashion the Council's findings and conclusions. The Council may adopt, in whole or in part, the findings of fact, recommendations and rationale of the hearing officer.

(b) Appeal to USDOL

If a timely appeal of the decision does not result in the requested designation, the unit of general local government or grant recipient may further appeal the designation decision to the U.S. Secretary of Labor within thirty (30) days after receipt of the Council's written decision. The appeal to the Secretary must be consistent with the requirements of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act. The Secretary, after receiving a request for review and upon determining that the entity has met the burden of establishing that it was not accorded procedural rights under the appeal process established in the state plan, or that the area meets the requirements of Section 106(b) paragraph (2) or (3) and 20 CFR 679.250, as appropriate, may require that the area be designated as a local area. As part of this determination, the Secretary may consider comments submitted by the Council in response to the appeal.

Appeals made to the Secretary must be filed no later than 30 days after receipt of written notification of the denial from the Council, and must be submitted by certified mail, return receipt requested, to:

The Secretary will notify the Governor and the appellant in writing of the Secretary's decision within 45 days after receipt of the appeal. In making this determination the Secretary may consider any comments submitted by the Governor in response to the appeals.

ORDINANCE 1393

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 17.34.050 AND 17.34.060 IN CHAPTER 17.34 OF TITLE 17, PROVIDING AN EXEMPTION TO OFF STREET PARKING AND LOADING ZONE REQUIREMENTS IN THE C-1 DOWNTOWN COMMERCIAL ZONE; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. Section 17.34 of Title 17, Chapter 17.34.050 of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby amended to read:

17.34.050: BUILDINGS AND USE RESTRICTIONS GENERALLY:

- A. No window or door while in an open position or during opening shall project into any street or alley.
- ~~B. For each five thousand (5,000) square feet of floor space, one off street loading zone of at least three hundred (300) square feet shall be provided on the property.~~
- ~~C. For all business or commercial use permitted in C-1 commercial district built after the effective date of this title, the number of off street parking areas required are delineated in chapter 17.72 of this title~~

17.34.060: OFF STREET PARKING AND LOADING ZONE REQUIREMENTS:

- A. The off street parking **and loading zone** requirements for the C-1 commercial district are referred to in chapter 17.72 of this title.
- B. For each five thousand (5,000) square feet of floor space, one off street loading zone of at least three hundred (300) square feet shall be provided on the property.
- C. For all ~~business commercial~~ non-residential use permitted and located on a lot in the C-1 commercial district built or use intensified after the effective date of this title, where there is not area available on the lot to meet the number of off street parking areas or off street loading zone as required ~~are and~~ delineated in chapter 17.72 of this title., shall be exempt from the requirement of providing off street parking. The exemption shall be applied to the land use on the lot requiring the fewest number of spaces. Only one (1) exemption shall be allowed per lot.
- D. The city council may enact an in lieu parking space construction fee when it is not possible to provide some or all of the required off-street parking. The funds shall be retained by the city and shall be used exclusively for the purpose of acquiring and developing public off-street parking facilities. The in lieu fee is set by resolution, when enacted.

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.

ORDINANCE 1392

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ADDING TO THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 17.56.012 IN CHAPTER 17.56 OF TITLE 17, ALLOWING EXISTING NONCONFORMING SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL USE IN A COMMERCIAL ZONE; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 17. Section 17.56 of Title 17, Chapter 17.56.012 of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding a new chapter 17.56.012 as follows:

**Chapter 17.56
NONCONFORMING USES**

17.56.012: EXISTING NONCONFORMING SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL USE:

Any single family structure, located in any district that was in use as a single family residence at the time of adoption or amendment to this chapter, and which has continued as a residential use, shall not be considered to be a nonconforming use but shall be considered a special use until such time that the residential use is replaced with another approved use. A single family residential structure, granted special use status, shall have the same privileges as a permitted residential structure and may be replaced/remodeled if a building permit has been obtained, and as long as the setbacks can be met or a variance is granted. Upon a change in use, to commercial or industrial, the residential structure shall not be changed back to a residential use unless a conditional use permit has been approved through following the public hearing process. A change in use shall not be considered to have occurred until the structure has actually been converted to a nonresidential use.

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.
