A. Meeting minutes of July 25, 2013

**OLD BUSINESS**

**A. Planning & Zoning Appointment**

Mayor stated he would like to appoint and approve the nomination for Jodi Henderson to the vacant spot on the Planning and Zoning Commission.

A motion was made by Heleker and seconded by Nelson to appoint Jodi Henderson to the Planning & Zoning Commission.

After a unanimous voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**A. Library Strategic Plan**

John Held, member of the board of trustees of the Payette City Library, addressed the Council stating that 5 years ago the commission had made a strategic plan to expand the library and they have exceeded that as you can now see. The information for the next five year strategic plan is provided in the council's packet, a discussion followed.

**B. 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue South Water Line Award**

Doug Argo stated the Warrington Construction was the lowest bid; in the council packet further explains information.

A motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Heleker to award the bid to Warrington Construction of a price not to exceed \$113,786.00 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue South Water Line project.

**C. Adopt Tentative Budget**

Jennifer Kelley presented a Power Point to City Council explaining and reviewing the tentative budget for Fiscal Year 2014, a discussion followed.

A motion was made by Hanigan and seconded by Nelson to approve the tentative budget for Fiscal Year 2014.

**D. Special Events Permit – A & W Cruise Night**

Stan Clements is standing in for Jim Boyer who is out of town. Stan stated that this event will be on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> of September and the event activities haven't changed from previous

years of applications approved. Stan asked, as a favor of Jim Boyer, to please waive the application fee for the special event permit.

A motion was made by Heleker and seconded by Mussell to approve the special events permit, to waive the \$200 fee, as well as donate \$500 to the event; contingent upon City administration receiving the proper liability insurance.

After a unanimous voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED.

E. Revolving Loan Fund – Downtown Improvements

A motion was made by Heleker and seconded by Hanigan to approve the Downtown Improvements Policy, to change the date of the policy to August, 2013, and to include that the improvements must be visible from the street, which does not include the parking lot.

After a unanimous voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED.

F. Payette Senior Center – Raffle Request

Marion Kershner stated to the council that she would like to thank the City and Tiffany at City Hall for the donation of \$200 to the Senior Citizens. Miriam explained to the City Council of her raffle event; the drawing will be on Wednesday August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at the Senior Citizen Center. Mayor Williams mentioned that anyone can go down there during the week for lunch, it is a \$5.00 donation and you can guarantee you won't go away hungry.

G. Building Permit Fees – Price Reduced

A motion was made by Mussell and seconded by Hanigan to reduce the building permit multiplier to 45% for new construction to be in effect from September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013 through August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2014.

H. James Mundell complaint

James Mundell addressed the Council stating that the City has an overuse of herbicides. He saw a huge tank spraying weeds down the road from his property and asked the street worker what they were spraying; the response was Round-up and 2,4-D. Mr. Mundell stated that 2,4-D is anything but safe and then provided information to the Council of its dangers. Mundell stated that he feels that it's a waste of money to tax payers to dump thousands of gallons of weed killer randomly down the street, which eventually goes into the storm drain which to his understanding goes into the watershed. His wife has a de-generating kidney disease and that is why he brings this issue up to the Council. The smell of chemicals hurts her kidneys to the point of crying. Round-up is not bio-degrade-able and it takes a lot of time

to break down. Mundell stated that he feels that there should be notice of the weed spraying being done or even have neighbors opt-out of having their weeds sprayed at the curb. Mayor Williams commented that he wished everyone's alley looked as good as Mr. Mundell's; he would recommend to have the city develop something or possibly have property owners post a sign on their property to ask not to spray at the property. Councilor Sands asked if a notice would suffice being on the water bill; Mundell stated that would be fine to have that kind of notice, every resident has a water bill, it's the resident's responsibility to read the notice. Jamie Couch explained to Mr. Mundell that if we mail out on the water bill of the notice spraying weeds, that would be okay, as long as it doesn't rain; if it rains then the street department has to spray again. Jamie let him know that they don't use the big truck with the large tank on the back to spray, which is a water truck. Jamie informed Mundell that the street department uses 60 gallons of weed killer for the whole year, for the whole town. Jamie informed Mr. Mundell that 2, 4-D does have a smell, he also wanted to inform him that the mosquito abatement company sprays for mosquitos around town and has no idea what they spray up in the air. Jamie said if he had a notice to not spray at Mundell's property, the street department won't do it; but if the neighbor across from you in the alley wants their property sprayed, the chemical would still be around Mr. Mundell's property.

I. Employee Incentive Program

Mayor Williams stated this hasn't been discussed in the department head meeting yet; which is scheduled for tomorrow morning; this item will be moved to the next regular meeting.

J. Action on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue South

Mayor Williams informed the Council that there is a letter from LouAnn Freeburg dated July 12<sup>th</sup>, 2013 along with an email from Barbara Choate dated June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2013, which have been passed out to the Council and reviewed.

A motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Hanigan to take LHTAC recommendation to close 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue South to through-traffic and install bollards that are appropriate at the intersection.

My family own 51 acres in Payette. The northern boundary of our property is Sixth Ave. South. The Eastern boundary is Highway 52. The Western boundary is Highway 95. We own approximately 25% of the property on Sixth Avenue South between Hwy 95 and Hwy 52.

**We want to once again, express our strong opposition to closing the connection between Sixth Ave. South and Highway 52.**

- 1] Closing the connection to Highway 52 would devalue our property. Having property that is accessible to two highways is a valuable asset to this property.
- 2] Sixth Avenue South is the only city street serving the entire 51 acres of this property.
- 3] Sixth Avenue South is the only east/west street connecting Hwy 95 and Hwy 52 from Second Avenue South to North East Tenth which is over a mile away.
- 4] By making Sixth Avenue South a cul de sac, increases the distance one would have to drive to reach Hwy 95 from the developed areas of Wayne and Hughes Drives.

5] By making Sixth Ave. South a cul de sac would add additional traffic to other streets in Payette.

6] By closing the eastern end of Sixth Ave. S., you would be forcing all traffic in and out of our property to use Hwy 95, thus more congestion in an already "troubled" intersection.

7] The figures used regarding accidents at the "Y" are not accurate and perhaps suggest fraud. If the report includes a larger area than the Sixth Ave. S. "Y" where it connects to Hwy 52, then the numbers concluded are not accurate. They are for a much larger area than the "Y" in discussion. How could this have been missed by intelligent people running Payette? Kind of makes you wonder what is really going on about this street.

8] Most cities try to make traffic easier for the residents by providing multiple and alternate routes for traffic. Closing this portion of Sixth Ave. So. to east/west traffic is counter to this concept.

9] Attempts have been made to "fix" two of the historically troubled intersections [ 7<sup>th</sup> Ave N. and 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave S. ]. What are the criteria to decide to fix some streets and to close others? A street is a street, and all the people in the town should be treated equally.

10] Our 51 acres of property with Sixth Ave. S. as the only city street adjacent should be looked at as future development with additional cars and people. It would short sighted to do any kind of planning without considering that the 51 acres will be developed with cars and people needing access to get in and out.

For all of the above reasons and more, we want to express our strong opposition to the closure of Sixth Ave. S. as it connects with Hwy 52.

Alan,

I am unable to attend the public hearing Monday July 1 regarding the future of the access to and from Highway 52 via 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue South. I would appreciate it if you could share the following comments on my behalf.

I feel the access should be closed for 2 primary reasons:

1. Cost to upgrade
2. Safety

The cost to clarify/establish ownership of the property and to upgrade the access is conservatively estimated at \$1.2 million dollars. \$1.2 million of unbudgeted project costs that would not generate any additional revenue for the city. The access is not a primary access to a commercial area or thoroughfare. Admittedly it is a "short cut" and a convenience for the people that live on the hill. A very expensive convenience especially when you consider that the cost is not only in the upgrade but in the safety of the people that use the short cut and every person driving Highway 52.

The traffic study previously presented at a work session shows 8 crashes in 4 years. That may not sound like very many but it involved 17 vehicles and 27 people with damages to property and people totaling \$443,000. Even with the costly improvements the intersection would not be safe because of the limited site and speed of traffic on Highway 52. Highway 52 is a State highway and not under the specific jurisdiction of the City of Payette. City officials can suggest – even beg – for lower speed limits, speed bumps, warning signs, etc but the State does not have comply with the request.

If there were no alternate route to Highway 95 I would feel differently. Because there is an alternate route that includes a traffic light for safe access from Highway 52 to Highway 95, I feel it is in the best interest of the City to

- forego the opportunity of investing \$1.2+ million dollars on a non-revenue producing project
- reduce the liability of knowingly continuing a dangerous traffic pattern and
- transition the access to and from Highway 52 via 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue South into a dead end.

**7:30 PM – Work Session**

A. FY2014 Budget: Mayor Williams gave a recap of the tentative budget. The levy rate is at .0119813. If we are comparing apples to apples we need to keep in mind that the library bond is included in that rate. Without the bond the rate would be .0117219. If you recall the council stated at previous meeting most would be happy if staff got the rate between .012 and some wanted .011 and staff got us to that point. This work session is to see if any new ideas from the council have come up. Councilor Heleker stated he has a concern of our unencumbered funds. They are becoming endangered if we keep using them. Councilor Nelson asked if the budget included one or two officers. It was stated that the budget included two and one would only be hired if we did not receive the grant. It was clarified that we would be adding an additional officer to the department. We currently have 12 officers and this would bring us to 13 officers and 14 if we hit the grant. Councilor Hanigan stated she noticed that the snow blower has been taken out. Mayor Williams feels that in two years this item would probably pay for itself. Mr. Couch stated he would try again next year. Councilor Mussell stated he is always for cutting the budget and notice that the phone system for \$40,000 was still in the budget. He stated the phone system works just fine and maybe could wait on this. The Council was informed that the phone system cost to tax payers will only be \$5,000. Mayor Williams had asked staff to come up with where we will be on unencumbered funds and was stated that all department will be within or over their 40% on operating expenses. The street department has improved, but is still pretty weak. Discussed the payment from the Urban Renewal District and this year's payments could possibly be used to lower the rate. Councilor Hanigan states if there is a way without jeopardizing our savings she is in favor of it. Councilor Heleker stated the goal of the Urban Renewal is to get the city paid off first. Mayor Williams stated that staff is looking for direction. Councilor Heleker stated he doesn't want to jeopardize services or our savings. We don't want to be in a position to have to do a bond. Councilor Sands stated he needs to see what the public wants.

A. Declaration of Sole Source Purchase for WWTP Equipment:

Discussion followed that there are limited suppliers for this piece of equipment and a sole source needs to be declared. It will be published in the paper for 2 weeks. This needs council approval to move forward. This camera will video tape sewer lines and is a budgeted item for this year. Mr. Schwartz stated this is the camera he wants and does include training and should last between 15-20 years. His department has never had a camera system before. They will be able to collect a tremendous amount of information on their system.

A motion was made by Mussell and seconded by Sands to approve the declaration of Metroquip as the sole source provider for the Rover X parts & service for the WWTP equipment, not to exceed \$89,499.00

After a unanimous voice vote by the Council, the motion CARRIED.

## ORDINANCE 1378

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, REPEALING SECTION 13.04.252 OF TITLE 13, AMENDING SECTIONS 3.12.080 AND 3.12.090; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

**Section 1.** Section 13.04.252 of Title 13, Chapter 13.04 of the Payette Municipal Code is repealed as follows:

### **~~13.04.252: DELINQUENT CHARGES A LIEN ON PROPERTY:~~**

~~All delinquent charges or fees, as provided by section 13.04.250 of this chapter, not paid after the final determination of the delinquent account shall be imposed as a lien against and upon the property or premises against which such charge or fee is levied or assessed, and the clerk shall, at the time of certifying the city taxes, certify such delinquencies together with all penalties to the tax collector of Payette County and, when so certified, the same shall be a lien upon the property. All monies collected by the clerk under the provisions of this section shall be paid over to the city treasurer in the same manner as is required for the payment of other city monies.~~

**Section 2.** Section 3.12.080 of Title 3, Chapter 3.12 of the Payette Municipal Code is amended as follows:

### **3.12.080: DISPOSITION OF WATER CHARGES:**

All water charges provided for in chapter 13.04 of this code shall be placed in the utility fund. ~~and paid into the general fund; provided, however, that such amounts as the council from time to time determines to be necessary to fulfill the obligations of the city shall be paid into the sewer fund for payment into the sewer revenue bond redemption fund of 1958.~~

**Section 3.** Section 3.12.090 of Title 3, Chapter 3.12 of the Payette Municipal Code is amended as follows:

### **3.12.090: FIRE PROTECTION; HOUSEHOLD CHARGE ESTABLISHED:**

All residents of the city shall pay and discharge their share of city fire protection and bonded indebtedness. The amount shall be computed upon a per household basis and shall be paid at the rate of a fee set by resolution per household per month. Those residents who are receiving city water services shall continue to pay their share through their monthly water bills and those residents who are paying for sewer services only, shall have that amount added to their monthly sewer bill. Any resident who is not receiving either sewer or water services shall be billed ~~monthly~~ **annually** by the city clerk.

**Section 4.** This ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

**Section 6.** Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

**Section 7.** If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.





Attached is Change Order No. 1 to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue South Waterline project which was recently awarded to Warrington Construction. This proposed change order reduces the cost of the project by \$15,780. This is accomplished by using directional drilling and installing a welded 8-inch HDPE (high density polyethylene) water pipe without a casing under the canal as well as for the remainder of the project. The original design and bid included a 24-inch steel casing under the canal and ductile iron water pipe.

HDPE pipe is a well-proven material, and in many ways it is superior to PVC water pipe. It is tough and is much less brittle than PVC. Both Jake Hust and I are comfortable with HDPE pipe being used in the City's water system for this particular circumstance. However, City code does not presently allow HDPE pipe to be used as a water line.

We recommend that the City Counsel allow the use of welded HDPE water pipe in this circumstance as a test case for this directional drilling application which crosses under the canal.

## ENGINEERING STATUS REPORT

AUGUST 19, 2013

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### A. Water

Warrington Construction has proposed a cost-saving change order for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue South waterline project. The proposed change would require utilizing a type of pipe which is not presently allowed by City Code. The proposed change is to use directional drilling technology to install a welded HDPE (high density polyethelene) pipe instead of the ductile iron pipe. This proposal would save the City \$15,780, which would be deducted from the original bid price of \$113, 786.00 for the complete project. The work would be completed in one single phase rather than two phases. The project would still start this fiscal year and end in the next fiscal year, so the project will still fit within budget constraints for both years.

### B. Sewer

Randy Schwartz and I have had two conference calls with EPA regarding our NPDES permit for the treatment plant. We have another conference call scheduled for August 20. So far, we have not received much information as to which way our permit will be written as the permit writing team had not proceeded very far in their analyses. We expect to hear more substantive information during this next conference call.
