AGENDA ITEMS

- A. Strategic Plan: Mayor stated this session is for Galena Consulting to present findings of the Strategic Plan survey to Council. Ms. Wescott said she received 350 surveys back and it was one of the best feedbacks they have received. She talked about Payette's Vision and Mission statements and the community relayed same thoughts as Council. Ms. Wescott went over power point. (See Attached) Massey stated they have received positive feedback and pride in our community. All survey data will be released to the public. Dale stated it was encouraging to look at the graphs and a community so willing to be involved. Ms. Wescott stated you have an opportunity to move from tactical to opportunity. This opens conversation to the community. Jensen stated the majority responding stated they love our city services. Ms. Wescott has come up with ideas to keep the community informed and what we provide. Wickersham stated don't let comments get to you, they just don't understand it. Ms. Wescott went over development objectives to achieve the goals. (See Attached). She handed out a work sheet to Council and discussed expectations and goals from SREDA. She talked about Industrial revenue bonds, money that is set out to do this sort of thing. She stated your zoning code is there for a reason, permits are required for a reason. The Mayor will make the call to SREDA by September 30th. Discussed timelines for Planning & Zoning meetings and deadlines. Ms. Wescott stated we do have to meet our legal obligations. Massey thinks we need to involve our community and identify the five top frustrations. Mayor stated we can use the Impact Advisory Committee. Discussed improving customer service within the whole City, One City, One Team. Put agenda item of Strategic Plan on every Council meeting.

Budget Work Session – September 1st at 4:00 pm


Ms. Wescott needs to come and give update on Impact Fees with Council on September 19th at 6:00. She does not need to attend executive session for other comments.
