6:10 PM – Budget 2015-2016

Bert Osborn conducted public hearing.

Ms. Cordova presented a power point presentation on the FY 16 Budget. There is a slight increase in real estate and revenues from the state. The big expense in the proposed budget, is the increase in workman comp and health insurance. There has been no salary adjustments over past year, but we are providing training and development to our employees. We are trying to maintain our current programs, and there is not much in capital outlay. Property taxes make up 59% of our revenue and local revenue are 16%. Of the tax supported funds, the police department is almost half and the fire department is 20%. Our priorities are in the strategic planning and our goal is to foster economic self-sufficiency, downtown revitalization. This year's proposed budget has money for downtown revitalization. We cannot provide tax incentives, but can provide benefits. You have great bunch of employees that care about the City. Council is supportive of public safety departments. The police has tech projects and two police cars. In the fire we don't have upgrade to equipment, but we are adding 1 full-time fire fighter, budget for 28 paid call. We are funding the rescue program with a used rescue rig and have ear marked money for new truck. Park department is status quo. Boat ramp project has been completed over last two budget years. This year there is three new drinking fountains and forestry has funding for trees. Street department is just everyday maintenance. The big thing is used dump truck to replace 1983 Ford with 256,804 miles. We do have an adopt a truck program for our citizens. Library in this budget year, books are at \$21,000, children's program has \$5,000 and only big project is re-labeling and ADA counter. They do have an additional full-time employee in proposed budget. The pool's revenues have increased, and we are open year round now. We have more people using the pool and which means more maintenance. They are asking for a robot pool cleaner and new lane lines and looking to put one more adult full-time, which will be funded out of reserves this year. The enterprise funds which include water, sewer and sanitation are not tax supported. The water department is replacing meters with radio read meters and replacing an old used dump truck. Sewer is looking for new jet truck, we have some in reserve and the cost is around \$400,000. There will be more testing with NPDES permit. In the sanitation fund, the Council did approve a 2% increase effective October 1, 2015. The water fund will be updating their SCADA system, doing well rehab, radio read meters and reservoir tank mixer and testing. Airport's big project is the runway extension project, we have received grant funding over last three years. It does have a required match that can be in-kind or match. We have \$92,000 match in proposed budget. This project has been planned since 2000 and has grant money. The special funds are same as last year. Liability insurance would be more if employees didn't do programs. Health insurance is up 18%, vision is up 3.9%, no change to dental, and workman's comp is up 29%. Idaho's economy is

looking up. The City will ensure long term financial stability. We have the urban renewal that will help bring business to our city. Unencumbered funds are getting low in several departments.

Bruce DeGraff, 1122 2nd Ave South addressed the Council. Has never attended a meeting. His wife fixes balanced meals and he fixes balanced budgets. It seems wrong and unethical on hitting a taxpayer with more taxes. The city needs to be more aggressive and have each department look for deviancies. Why do we have nine parks for a population of 7,000? He doesn't understand why we keep and maintain all those parks. Why do we maintain one we don't own, the Hanigan Park? He would like to see a city that demonstrates that they are for the people. He would like to see men and women that deliver the product. He told a story about Alexander the Great. He would like the Council to be great and find the deficiencies. He asked what population have ever stepped foot at the airport. Mayor Williams stated we always hear every year all the services we provide and how much the public enjoys. Some of these amenities have had to expand. He asked Mr. DeGraff if he had any thoughts on what services we might cut. Mr. DeGraff stated do we really need ten parks that seems excessive to him. He stated his neighbor that has a supervisor next door to him and sees the city's effort to have beautiful yards, and we have to make a choice do I eat or have a nice yard. Mayor Williams stated most resident's water with irrigation and not city water. We like our parks, and if did away with one we would hear about it. Mr. DeGraff stated there will always be someone that will not be happy with the decision. The Council needs to come together for the good of the whole, doesn't work for me, but works for the whole. Asked how we get growth if we keep raising taxes. The City has a population 65% who are over 65 years of age. He has seen subdivisions that are not full, asked what are we doing that we are not attracting development.

Frasier Peterson, 2705 Killebrew Drive, addressed the Commission. He is Chairman of the Airport Commission. He stated just because you don't use something the city provides doesn't mean it is not valuable. The library and pool are examples of that. He was asked what the airport for the average person that doesn't fly does for them. Mr. Peterson stated a lot, we have people flying in every week. We have been trying for 15 years to add another 500 feet to the runway. This adds to safety factor and bigger planes being able to land at the airport. He thanked staff on helping with grant. The feeling has changed with the county commissioners and they seem very supportive. We have made great changes to the airport. We were the only ones around that sold mo-gas. Every hangar is full and becoming self-sustaining. Once you lose an air strip you will never get it back. Sands asked what the 500 feet will bring us if all the hangars are full. Mr. Peterson stated we have a 3,000' runway and you cannot land on 250' displacement that the golf course took, so we only have a 2,750' strip. The extra will allow more twin engines to land, more fuel sales and we can be competitive. It will increase the dynamics. Mayor Williams stated all the hangars are full, will the new runway bring more hangars, Mr. Peterson stated yes. He knows of people that came to Payette due to our airport. Having fuel at our airport is huge. Jensen commented when have big project and you can get ¾ of it paid by another party that is great, kudos for getting grant money. Mr. Peterson stated when Bill Statham from the Idaho Aeronautics was here, he had an opportunity to provide us more money and it could have gone to any other airport in Idaho, but he gave it to us. He thanked the city for turning dust bowl in a beautiful parking lot.

Sonja Strong, 1323 North 6th Street, addressed the Council. She asked about the power point and the 15%. She also wanted to know if there is going to be another public hearing. Mayor Williams stated they set the tentative budget and they can lower it, but not raise it. Ms. Strong asked about parks, some are not parks, some are just land the City owns. What can we do to unload and not have the liability for that so we are not paying for that? She stated when you look on the internet, most recent salaries are from 2012. She was astonished to see what some of the employees are making. Ms. Cordova is making a large salary and if she worked for county she would make about 1/3 less. Mr. Strong is fine with police officers are making. She is concerned about how high

some of the salaries are. When look at what the average person makes, it is considerably lower than the rest of town. She doesn't feel we need to be adding more to it. The Council needs to be bringing down increases in pay and department budgets. She does appreciate several amenities we offer, but does see places we can tightening our belt.

Scott McDonald, 1012 1st Avenue South addressed the Council. He stated his kids are wanting to leave. He has only been here for two years. Asked if there is a program to get more businesses here. If keeps getting drained, his kids are taking about going someplace else. We need to make choices to keep kids here. People are barely making it now, and people will get to the point of making the decision to leave. People are being taxed heavy. The Library is excellent and he supports the library and supports some of the parks, but they are empty. The City should focus on the ones that are used the most, is that something we should tweak a little bit. Will his kids want to buy a house and raise a family here, came from Utah where it is very urban. This is very quiet here. Growth is going to happen and how do we manage it. Mayor Williams stated part of the proposed budget are funds for downtown revitalization. The Mayor stated he has five kids, some went away and some came back, need to let them flap their wings. Dale stated since parks have come up several times she wanted to inform him that families have gave them to the City. We are pen for suggestions from our citizens. Jensen concerns are if the kids don't like the town or don't have a future that is the feeling he is getting. Wickersham stated that is true of all small towns. Sands stated jobs have slowly vanished and it is not the city's job to fill the downtown businesses. Have to have the jobs and they will fill. The only thing we can do is keep the taxes low so the businesses will come. Mr. McDonald stated growth is going to happen, but need to control it. Sands stated we provide police, fire, street, water and sewer and the others are amenities we have. We can't fix all of it, but we can fix some of it.

Amy Brown, 320 S. 20th Street, addressed the Council. She is president of the Friends of the Library. As a city you are only required to provide basics, but what keeps people in a town is all the other amenities. They could live anywhere and what choices them to stay in Payette. What are we offer are the amenities, that is what has kept them here. It is one of the best libraries in the valley. We live in a town that children receive free lunches, we are a low income town, the library is essential. We have children that come and use the internet and get books, they can't afford to go to movies, and our library now provides movies. The library is absolutely necessary to make our town a better place.

Ms. Cordova addressed questions. Mayor Williams state the 15% includes SEREDA, Snake River Transit, marketing and downtown revitalization, salary and benefits are also included. Jensen address a question to Mr. DeGraff, we are balancing budget by balancing the levy. Mr. DeGraff stated doesn't want to live in a community that can't balance their budget. He balances his budget and doesn't know why the city can't do the same. He stated that Mr. Peterson enlightened him about the airport. If we are spending this much on salaries, how much do we get in return for marketing? Dale encouraged him to attend meetings and by getting feedback from citizens, it makes a better community. Wickersham stated there are committees that citizens can get involved with.

C. Building Permit Fee Discussion: Discussion followed that now is the time to let it go back to the way it was or approve another extension of the discount. Nelson stated the building inspector fees are quiet low and do we risk the chance of losing him. The building inspector stated he would review his contract at the end of this year. Sands asked Ms. Cordova if the discount was in the budget and she stated yes. Mayor Williams stated fiscal year 2012 we had gross revenue of \$23,000. Fiscal year 2013 went down to \$20,000 and 2014 we had \$30,000. Economy is coming back a bit. Fiscal year 2015 we are at \$22,000 in July. It has probably helped having it lowered. Jensen stated we lowered the fee to become competitive with other cities. Sands suggested we make motion to maintain the discounted fee to December 31, 2015, and then have the building inspector give us an update.

A motion was made by Jensen and seconded by Nelson to approve the extension of the discount of 45% of our building fees to December 31, 2015.

DEPARTMENT REPORT

- A. Police Department – July 2015: Chief Clark discussed his July report. The department has been very busy. They have had an opportunity to talk to schools on safety. Brent Arms had a citizen's night out and they participated. He is still conducting interviews for one more position on department. He has made an offer to someone, but is still early on. He informed the Council about the Miracle Field being burglarized and vandalized. They arrested 3 juveniles in connection with that. His department is getting ready for Cruise Night, and they will handle on their own this year with the County's help

AGENDA ITEMS

1. Budget 2015-2016: The Mayor stated the numbers we have are pretty much the same as we had before. He asked Council members if they have questions for department heads and what direction does this body wants to do. He asked for ideas and thoughts. Jensen stated he doesn't want to say cut, but what he heard from the public hearing was to keep levy rate the same. People state they have to balance their budgets and the council should do the same. He would like to go through line items and see what we can do. Ms. Cordova stated where we are on the budget is the same if it wasn't for the airport project we would be at or below our levy rate from last year. The Mayor stated he looks at the departments, and we have committees that have been through all that and thinks they are the advisors to come back to Council with recommendations. We have \$10,000 for marketing, is that some place to cut, and we have \$10,000 for downtown redevelopment. We have extra in our budget for legal fees and possible cases. Our strategic plan is \$60,000, is that something we don't have to do right now. We have \$15,000 for Snake River Transit and fountains in the parks. Ms. Haley stated she put out a survey to see what patrons would like to see in front of library. The Mayor stated the extra items in the budget are cop cars, snow blower, sign machine and fountains. If you just want to take levy rate we will have to give up the grant for the airport. He thinks we need the strategic plan to know where we want to go. Heleker asked if that was what it would cost. That is the comp and strategic plan. Ms. Cordova stated in 2005 when we did comp plan we spent \$42,000. The strategic plan would be around \$10,000. The Mayor stated we set money aside for a fire truck and maybe should set money away for plans. Ms. Cordova stated on capital improvement reserves we haven't been putting money in that fund for future expenses. Heleker stated there use to be a different attitude in years past, reserves were a little high and we have continued to draw from them. He asked how do we live today, and let's plan for tomorrow. Nelson stated if we always shoot to keep levy we will never make it happen. Everything goes up. Sands disagrees, values goes up so revenues go up, should focus on what it will cost to run the city. He likes going through pages to justify. What are we getting for our money? Do we need to spend the money on the airport runway? He likes the idea of comp plan. Don't take the hit down the road, save now for projects. We need to stop thinking about levy, he is not interested in taking back taxes and will not vote for budget if it is in there. He didn't get enough info for sign maker and wasn't sold that there is a benefit for the city. No one convinced him. Heleker agrees with Sands about levy, it is important to community that we can justify to the taxpayer for it being raised. Jensen stated if we have more things that are taxed, we have an increased budget. Look at the departments that are asking for an increase. Nelson stated in talking to golf course

people they don't see a lot of traffic at airport. Dale talked about fountains, and how can we move the money around. Dale stated it has to be balanced, but have to look at the whole picture. Wickersham concern is health insurance, we can't keep having \$85,000 increase every year, and we have to make adjustments. He had to as a business owner. Mayor stated that is what Ms. Cordova has been working on. Several years ago the council removed their dependents and then we asked employees to pay a percentage. We don't have revenues to give to each department to ask how they want to spend the money. We don't have the figures for revenues. We gave estimates and ask each department what their expenses are. Jensen stated we can generate more revenue by growth. Nelson stated we support things that other cities benefit from. How many dollars did the property values bring in revenue? Sands stated we all know we have empty buildings downtown, it is not getting better by increased value, and rent goes up. If we get taxes to high how many will we lose? Ms. Cordova stated we do use the December values to get initial budget going for department heads, those are the figures you just talked about. Yes we had increased value, additional dollars estimated are \$67,000 more. We have had some challenges this year, health insurance went up, workman's comp (next year lower), those are big things effecting budget. We did look at fuel costs, back to 2009 and reviewed each month. Sands said we have to go back to 2006 and 2007 to get accurate figures. Just like the pool, all of it is political. We need because we don't have it and then we need it because we have it. He told department heads if they can't sell it to him, he can't approve. Ms. Cordova looked at the bills to see if they had put too much in budget, and it looks like they are in line. Sands stated gas is lower and budget should be lower. Library needs another person, pool and fire needs another person, we can't keep cops because we don't pay enough. Budgets shouldn't be the same as the year before, not trying to be the negative egg in the basket. Ms. Cordova wants the council to know that we have gone through each line item, there are things to look at and that is the capital items. If we cut back on fuel, then you cut back on services. Jensen stated we are using the tax payer's money and we need to be fiscally aware of what we are spending. Nelson stated maybe we have too many amenities, doesn't seem to be bringing a lot of businesses in. The airport brings in a few people, but do we want to do that. Mayor stated about soccer fields, they bring no money to us, could sell and put to better use. Sands stated we don't pay enough to police officers, benefits are what brings them here. Sands asked if everyone else is paying their share on the transit system. Dale is not comfortable for transit system or the museum. When we quit assisting things they find away to make it work and find accountability. Ms. Cordova stated fuel in the parks have doubled from five years ago. Putting a bathroom at the soccer fields is irresponsible and wasn't to be used as that. Ms. Cordova would like to visit health insurance with Council. Because of all the affordable care acts requirements, we have always been considered a small group and now due to council on policy we are considered a large group by some carriers. Wickersham asked what if we dropped the council insurance and raise council pay. It was stated we can't do that for two years. Ms. Cordova stated starting January 1st, anything 100 or less will be considered a small group. We already know what our rates will be for next year. The rates are now on each and every employee and dependents. Sands stated we only are going to keep employees if you have a good benefit package. If we lower benefits we are doing the employee an injustice. Ms. Cordova stated right now we are on the preferred PPO, insurances are going to metal plans. We buy down the deductibles and in the future we will not have the money to do the buy downs. The one we are looking at is the closest to what we have now. Sands stated if we don't keep benefits, our employees will go somewhere else. That is our one hold that we have is our benefits. Doesn't want anyone out there looking for a job. Dale asked what difference it would be to drop the mayor and councils from the health insurance, would that help. Wickersham would take out the \$10,000 for advertisement. Ms. Cordova

stated she thinks we are there, right at last year's levy rate. Sands asked about foregone and new construction and library bond. Ed Franek stated he came to the city for the benefits. Randy Fales would rather have the benefits. Chief Castenada stated most employees all have families and benefits are important. Mayor asked Ms. Cordova about the preliminary figures, we could be at same levy rate. Ms. Cordova stated with the bond we should be really close. Sands asked if we took \$10,000 for marketing out, and he is not convinced we need snow plow or sign maker. He is also not convinced about the system for water department for \$15,000 and of airport runway and thinks we should cut the Snake River Transit in half. Give another 1% to employees and keep insurance to what they have. A 1% wage increase would be around \$47,000. He doesn't want the employee to pay any more. It was stated the snow blower would come out of unencumbered funds. Jamie Couch stated he is just trying to make it better for people, everyone is talking about beautification and sign maker would help with that. Sands there is no support from the airport and the museum. Heleker stated just looking at airport and marketing, is \$102,000. He would fight more to keep the museum. Yes we are paying more to the museum and it is 90% about Payette. We need to put the message out that other people need to step up. Sands stated on the transit bus, everyone is not paying their part. Wickersham stated we will walk away from the grant of \$375,000, he doesn't think we will spend all that money, a lot will be in-kind. You don't know how good your health insurance is until you use it. Heleker stated we need to really value spending \$92,000 at airport and how much impact has that will have on the city. Ms. Cordova stated we have a waiting list for hangars and the fuel is self sufficient. Sands stated he is not convinced we are doing enough business for the expense and what are we getting for it. The county doesn't want to participate in it at all. Nelson has always looked at the airport as a recreational airport. It is pretty reasonable to build out there. Heleker stated we have a nice airport, but doesn't see the need for the runway extension. Dale stated this project has been planned for awhile and when seen how much will cost to move ground, state offered to do a 75%/25%, she is concerned if we will ever get more funding in the future. We can do in-kind and might not have to spend the money. Nelson stated do we spend \$92,000 to benefit just a few or spend \$10,000 that affects a lot of people. Heleker stated they thought our airport was fine when they moved here. The Mayor stated when they start selling fuel for oil and gas development, will we regret it in the future. Sands stated it looks like it is operational right now. Dale is worried about hurting our reputation. Jensen if we start taking out all the amenities that most people don't use, there are a lot. Dale asked what does that do for us in the future for getting grants. Sands stated if you think there is no upkeep down the road you are wrong. Nelson stated the citizens approved the library bond. Ms. Cordova stated if she takes out the foregone funds, one time or leave in budget and levy will be at or close to last year. She would like to bring something to meeting on Tuesday that will not be long. What she is hearing is cut Snake River Transit by half, health insurance to be equivalent to what we have now. Sands stated if policy has more deductible, the next hit will be on the buy down. Ms. Cordova stated in the next couple years there will be no money for buy down. Jensen stated we will be considered a Cadillac plan unless we change it now. Mayor asked do we do that and give a 2% increase to employees. Heleker would rather see the airport extension go away to give employees another 1% than cutting a lot of items from budget. Ms. Cordova asked when the council would to meet again and was decided Tuesday at noon. Dale stated she is concerned about museum and thinks there are several options that can be looked at. Dale is very uncomfortable handing over the money due to sales pitch from last year that Ms. Curtis wasn't being paid and then the board came back and paid her. County has been warning them that they would have to take extra steps to keep doors open. It would be three years before state would take some of inventory and would like to see the money be under control of the city and not the museum. They had

several red flags from their reports. Heleker wants to go on record to not cut it. Wickersham would also like to see some justification on how they are spending the money. Sands stated maybe it should be used strictly for utilities. Dale has been trying to get photos or documents at the library. What if that money is set aside for matting and framing at library as part of Payette history, to be displayed that benefits citizens. Heleker doesn't want to get in the business of micro managing.

ORDINANCE 1393

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 17.34.050 AND 17.34.060 IN CHAPTER 17.34 OF TITLE 17, PROVIDING AN EXEMPTION TO OFF STREET PARKING AND LOADING ZONE REQUIREMENTS IN THE C-1 DOWNTOWN COMMERCIAL ZONE; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. Section 17.34 of Title 17, Chapter 17.34.050 of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby amended to read:

17.34.050: BUILDINGS AND USE RESTRICTIONS GENERALLY:

- A. No window or door while in an open position or during opening shall project into any street or alley.
- ~~B. For each five thousand (5,000) square feet of floor space, one off street loading zone of at least three hundred (300) square feet shall be provided on the property.~~
- ~~C. For all business or commercial use permitted in C-1 commercial district built after the effective date of this title, the number of off street parking areas required are delineated in chapter 17.72 of this title~~

17.34.060: OFF STREET PARKING AND LOADING ZONE REQUIREMENTS:

- A. The off street parking **and loading zone** requirements for the C-1 commercial district are referred to in chapter 17.72 of this title.
- B. For each five thousand (5,000) square feet of floor space, one off street loading zone of at least three hundred (300) square feet shall be provided on the property.
- C. For all ~~business-commercial~~ non-residential use permitted and located on a lot in the C-1 commercial district built or use intensified after the effective date of this title, where there is not area available on the lot to meet the number of off street parking areas or off street loading zone as required ~~are and~~ delineated in chapter 17.72 of this title., shall be exempt from the requirement of providing off street parking. The exemption shall be applied to the land use on the lot requiring the fewest number of spaces. Only one (1) exemption shall be allowed per lot.
- D. The city council may enact an in lieu parking space construction fee when it is not possible to provide some or all of the required off-street parking. The funds shall be retained by the city and shall be used exclusively for the purpose of acquiring and developing public off-street parking facilities. The in lieu fee is set by resolution, when enacted.

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.
