AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, PAYETTE CITY, IDAHO, ADOPTING A NEW CHAPTER 17.90 "OIL & GAS OPERATIONS" UNDER TITLE 17, ZONING, OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER CLAUSE; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY; ALLOWING FOR PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE UPON PASSAGE, APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION ACCORDING TO LAW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Adoption of New Chapter 17.90 to Title 17, Zoning.

The City of Payette Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to add the following new Chapter 17.90 under Title 17, Zoning:

17.90.010. Purpose.

This Ordinance is a zoning and public nuisance ordinance enacted to protect and promote the health, safety and general welfare of present and future residents of the City while at the same time providing for the responsible and economically viable extraction of oil and gas minerals. This Ordinance is a police power, public nuisance and land use regulation designed to establish separate land use, environmental, traffic, cultural, historical

and archeological, emergency service and preparedness, health and safety, and other standards to protect from any possible adverse public nuisance effects and impacts resulting from oil and gas exploration, drilling, extraction or transportation in the City.

The purpose of this ordinance is to provide, through zoning provisions, for the reasonable development of land for Oil and Gas operation while providing adequate health, safety and general welfare protections of the residents of the City of Payette. Oil and Gas exploration, drilling and extraction operations involve activities that are economically important and will impact the City of Payette. Accordingly, it is necessary and appropriate to adopt reasonable requirements for Oil and Gas resource development so that these resources can be obtained in a manner that is economically remunerative, and that minimizes the potential impact on the residents of the City of Payette.

Local governments are preempted from regulating the same features Oil and Gas Well operations or accomplishing the same purposes regulated under Idaho Statute 47-317. Local zoning regulates surface land use as authorized under the Local Land Use Planning Act (I.C. 67-65).

17.90.020. Definitions.

For the purposes of this Chapter, all terms used that are defined in the IDAPA regulations and are not defined in this Chapter are defined as provided in the IDAPA regulations as of the effective date of this Chapter. The following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

Administrative: A regulatory review and/or action performed by an employee or contractor of the City of Payette and not deemed a legislative or quasi-judicial action.

Applicant: Any person, Owner, Operator, partnership, company, corporation and its subcontractors and agents who has an

interest in real estate for the purpose of exploring or drilling for, producing, or transporting Oil or Gas.

Department: The Idaho Department of Lands.

Development: Any work which actively promotes bringing in production.

Drilling Pad: The area of surface operations surrounding a proposed or existing well or wells and accessory structures and equipment necessary for drilling, completion, recompletion, work over, development and production activities.

Geophysical or Seismic Operations: Any geophysical method performed on the surface of the land utilizing certain instruments operating under the laws of physics respecting vibration or sound to determine conditions below the surface of the earth which may contain oil or gas and is inclusive of but not limited to the preliminary line survey, the acquisition of necessary permits, the selection and marking of shot-hole locations, necessary clearing of vegetation, shot-hole drilling, implantation of charge, placement of geophones, detonation and backfill of shot-holes, and vibroseis.

Oil and Gas: Crude oil, natural gas, methane gas, propane, butane and/or any other constituents or similar substances that are produced by drilling an oil or gas well.

Oil and Gas Well: A hole drilled into the earth for the purpose of exploring for or extracting oil, gas, or other hydrocarbon substances.

Oil or Gas Facility or Facilities: A new well or wells and the surrounding Well Site and well pad, constructed and operated to explore for or produce crude oil and/or gas and includes auxiliary and associated equipment and facilities, such as derricks, separators; dehydrators; pumping units; tank batteries; tanks; metering stations and equipment; any equipment for the reworking of an existing well bore; workover rigs; compressor stations and associated engines, motors, facilities and equipment; water or fluid injection systems and associated

facilities and equipment; storage or construction storage yards; gathering systems and associated facilities and equipment, collection lines, drip stations, vent stations, pigging facilities, chemical injection station, transfer pump stations and valve boxes; any other structure, building or facility, temporary or permanent, mobile or stationary, associated with or used in connection of a new Oil or Gas Well or the installation, construction or operation of the Oil or Gas Well, and the roads used for ingress and egress to and from a new Oil or Gas Well or surrounding Well Site.

100-year Floodplain: The land in the floodplain within the City subject to a one (1) percent or greater chance of flooding in any given year, as designated by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, or on the Flood Insurance Rate Maps.

Roadway: Any street, avenue, boulevard, road land, parkway, place, viaduct, easement for access, or other way which is an existing state, City, or municipal roadway; or a street or way shown in a plat heretofore approved pursuant to law or approved by official action; or a street or way in a plat duly filed and recorded within the right-of-way boundaries whether improved or unimproved and may be comprised of pavement, shoulder, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, parking areas, and lawns.

- a. "Arterial Route" - A general term including expressways, major and minor arterial streets; and interstate, state or City highways having regional continuity.
- b. "Collector Street" - A street that provides for traffic movement within neighborhoods of the City and between major streets and local street and for direct access to abutting property.
- c. "Local Street" - A street that provides direct access to residential, commercial, industrial, or other abutting land for local traffic movements and connects to collector and/or arterial streets.

1. "Marginal Access Street" - A minor street parallel and adjacent to an arterial route and intercepts local streets and controls access to an arterial route.
2. "Cul-de-sac Street" - A short local street having one end permanently terminated in a vehicular turnaround.
3. "Loop Street" - A minor street with both terminal points on the same street of origin.
4. "Alley" - A public service way used to provide secondary vehicular access to properties otherwise abutting upon a street.

Road Repair Agreement: A written agreement between the owner/operator and the City obligating the operator to repair damage, excluding ordinary wear and tear, if any, to public streets, including but not limited to bridges, caused by the operator or its employees, agents, contractors, subcontractors or representatives in the performance of drilling or production of any wells authorized by the city or City.

Well: An oil and gas well or an injection well, including but not limited to directional drilling wells (for example, any well hole drilled into the ground).

Well Site: See Oil or Gas Facility or Facilities

17.90.030: Zoning Classifications

Subject to the provisions of this ordinance, an oil or gas well site shall be considered a permitted use by right within any Zoning District(s), subject to the standards listed herein.

17.90.040. Permit Requirement:

A. No oil or gas well site, or an addition to an existing oil or gas well site, shall be constructed or located within the City unless an administrative zoning permit under this ordinance has been issued by the City to the applicant

approving the construction or preparation of the site for oil or gas development.

B. Each application shall be submitted with the fee established pursuant to resolution of the City as adopted. Such fee shall be reasonable related to the cost of administering this Chapter of Payette City Code.

C. Any modification to an existing and/or permitted oil or gas well site that materially alters the size, location, number of wells or accessory equipment or structures, shall require a modification of the permit under this ordinance. Like-kind replacements shall not require a permit modification.

D. Wells that were permitted and constructed prior to the adoption of this ordinance shall not be required to meet the requirements of this ordinance. Any modification to an existing or permitted oil or gas well site that occurs after the effective date of this ordinance and materially alters the size, type, location, number of wells and other accessory equipment or structures, shall require compliance with this ordinance.

E. Upon receiving notice from the Department that an application has been submitted, the City will notify all property owners within three hundred (300) feet of the affected tax parcel that an application for a new Oil and Gas operation has been filed with the City Planning & Zoning Department. The notice is for informational purposes only and will not solicit any public comments on the application.

F. If an applicant does not conduct said business for a period of one (1) year, the administrative zoning permit shall be null and void. The City Council has the discretion to provide one (1) six-month extension upon request by the applicant. Permits issued under this ordinance shall not be transferable to any other applicant, except by a majority vote of the City Council, and the filing of an application by the applicant to whom such license is, or may be, transferred or assigned.

G. A separate Geophysical Operations permit shall be required for exploration for oil or gas. Exploration of oil or gas means geologic or geophysical activities, including, but not limited to surveying and seismic exploration, related to the search for oil, gas, or other sub-surface hydrocarbons.

17.90.050. Permit Application:

A. The applicant shall provide to the City at the time of permit application:

1. A narrative describing an overview of the project including the number of acres to be disturbed for development, the number of wells to be drilled including Department permit number(s) for all wells, if available, at the time of submittal and provided when issued later, and the location, number and description of equipment and structures to the extent known.

2. The address of the oil or gas well site and a legal description of the parcel as determined by the City and information needed to gain access to the well site in the event of an emergency.

3. The contact information of the individual or individuals responsible for the operation and activities at the oil or gas well site shall be provided to the City and all applicable Emergency Responders as determined by the City. Such information shall include a phone number where such individual or individuals can be contacted twenty-four hours per day, three-hundred sixty-five days a year. Annually, or upon any change of relevant circumstances, the applicant shall update such information and provide it to the City and all applicable Emergency Responders as determined by the City.

4. A scaled site plan of the oil or gas well site showing the drilling pad, planned access roads, the approximate location of derricks, drilling rigs, equipment and structures and all permanent improvements to the site and any post construction surface disturbance in relation to natural resources. Included in this map shall be an area within the development site for vehicles to locate while gaining access to the oil or gas well site.

5. A narrative and map describing the planned access routes to the well sites on public roads including the transportation and delivery of equipment, machinery, water, chemicals and other materials used in the siting, drilling, construction, maintenance and operation of the oil or gas well site.

6. The applicant will make the operation's Preparedness, Prevention and Contingency Plan available to the City and all Emergency Responders at least 30 days prior to drilling of an oil or gas well and at least annually

thereafter while drilling activities are taking place at the oil or gas well site.

7. An appropriate site orientation for all applicable Emergency Responders as determined by the City. The cost and expense of the orientation shall be the sole responsibility of the applicant. If multiple wells/well pads are in the same area (covered by the same emergency response agencies), evidence from the appropriate emergency response agencies that a site orientation was offered in the last 12 months shall be accepted.

8. A narrative describing the environmental impacts of the proposed project on the site and surrounding land and measures proposed to protect or mitigate such impacts shall be provided to the City.

17.90.060. Issuance of Permit.

A. Within five (5) business days after receipt of a permit application, the City will determine whether the application is complete and advise the applicant accordingly.

B. If the application is complete and fulfills the requirements of this ordinance, the City Planning and Zoning Administrator shall issue a permit within 21 days following the date the complete application was submitted.

C. If the application is incomplete or does not fulfill the requirements of this ordinance, the City will notify the applicant of the missing and/or inadequate material and, upon receiving said material, shall issue the permit within twenty-one (21) days following the date the complete application was submitted.

D. As a condition of permit approval, applicant shall provide all permits and plans from the Department and all other appropriate regulatory agencies within 30 days of receipt of such permits and plans.

17.90.070. Site Design and Installation:

A. General Requirement

All drilling and other operations conducted at an Oil or Gas Facility or construction of structures associated with, or serving an Oil or Gas Facility, for which a permit is required, shall strictly comply with the requirements of this Ordinance applicable to such Oil or Gas Facility or Facilities, including, but not limited to those set forth in this Article, and shall be conducted at all times in accordance with the Best Management Practices of a reasonable and prudent Operator.

B. Setbacks

1. No Oil or Gas Facility shall be permitted within a 100 year floodplain as mapped and designated by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).
2. Setbacks shall not apply to roads used solely for the purpose of accessing Oil or Gas Facilities.
3. Setbacks shall be measured from the center of roads and from the seasonal high water mark of watercourses, or the outer boundary of the affected Surface Water Feature.
4. No Oil or Gas Facility shall be permitted within the following distances of the following geographic features and structures:

- a. inhabited dwelling - 650 feet;
- b. structure used as a place of assembly, school or institution - 1000 feet;
- c. non-residential structure - 200 feet;
- d. any state, federal or city publicly dedicated road or highway - 200 feet;
- e. surface water features - 300 feet;
- f. existing water well permitted by the State Engineer and used by less than five (5) households - 200 feet;
- g. existing water well permitted by the State Engineer used by five (5) or more people -1000 feet;
- h. within a designated cultural, historic or archeological resource as recommended according to the applicable surface management agency [e.g. SHPO].

The City Council has the discretion to permit deviation from the prescribed setbacks based on the Operator's demonstrated ability to protect and/or mitigate the impacts on the foregoing features, and with the written agreement of the Surface Property Owner or tenant, or, where applicable, the Adjacent Surface Property Owner or tenant, and/or the appropriate surface management agency.

C. Access.

- 1. Vehicular access to a natural gas well, oil well or well pad solely via a local street is discouraged unless it can be proven that the only viable vehicular access to the well site is via the local route. The use of collector streets is preferred.

2. Payette City Roadway Standards and Development Procedures pertaining to minimum traffic sight distances for all access points shall be adhered to.

3. Access directly to State roads from a well site may require an Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) Approach Permit. Prior to initiating any work at a drill site, the City shall be provided a copy of any required Approach Permit.

4. Access directly to City local streets shall require a Payette City Road Repair Agreement prior to initiating any work at a well site. Operator shall comply with any generally applicable bonding and permitting requirements for City roads that are to be used by vehicles for site construction, drilling activities and site operations.

D. Height.

1. There shall be an exception to the height restrictions contained in this section for the temporary placement of drilling rigs, drying tanks, pad drilling and other accessory uses necessary for the actual drilling or redrilling of an oil or gas well. The duration of such exemption shall not exceed the actual time period of drilling or redrilling of an oil or gas well or pad drilling.
2. If applicable, application will meet standards as defined in Ordinance 938 of the City of Payette, Payette Municipal Airport Hazard Zoning Ordinance.

E. Screening and Fencing.

1. Security fencing shall not be required at oil or gas well sites during the initial drilling, or redrilling operations.

2. Upon completion of drilling or redrilling security fencing consisting of a permanent chain link fence or approved alternate shall be promptly installed at the oil or gas well site to secure well heads, storage tanks, water or liquid impoundment areas, and other mechanical and production equipment and structures on the oil or gas well site.

3. Security fencing shall be at least 6 feet in height equipped with lockable gates at every access point and having openings no less than 12 feet wide. Additional lockable gates used to access oil and gas well sites by foot may be allowed, as necessary. All locked access gates shall have Knox Box access through the City Fire Department.

4. Warning signs shall be placed on the fencing surrounding the oil or gas well site providing notice of the potential dangers and the contact information in case of an emergency. During drilling and hydraulic fracturing, clearly visible warning signage must be posted on the pad site.

5. In construction of oil or gas well sites, the natural surroundings should be considered and attempts made to preserve existing trees and other native vegetation. Existing trees and respective root systems should not be disturbed whenever possible. Re-forestation/re-vegetation of the well site will be

provided by the owner/operator as required by rules governing Oil and Gas Conservation.

F. Lighting.

Lighting at the oil or gas well site, either temporary or permanent, shall be directed downward and inward toward the activity, to the extent practicable, so as to minimize the glare on public roads and adjacent properties.

G. Noise.

The City recognizes that oil and gas development is accompanied by inherent noise. However, the operator shall consider, to the extent possible, mitigation of noise resulting from the oil or gas well development.

1. All construction, maintenance, and operations of any Oil or Gas Facility shall be conducted in a manner to minimize the noise created to the greatest extent possible.
2. Noise will be measured on the "A" scale, using an industry approved protocol. Sound measurement instruments will be either a Type I or Type II, SPL instrument that meet or exceed established ANSI standards.
3. Oil and gas operations at any Well Site, production facility, or gas facility shall comply with the following maximum permissible noise levels measures at six hundred and fifty (650) feet from the source or at the receptor, unless another standard has been established in a surface use agreement.
4. Noise standards for continuous operations shall apply to all oil or gas operations that operate on a continual (>8 hours/day), long-term basis (>3 weeks)

in duration. In the hours between 7:00 a.m. and the next 7:00 p.m. the noise levels permitted below may be increased ten (10) db(A) for a period not to exceed fifteen (15) minutes in any one (1) hour period.

5. Noise standards for temporary operations shall apply to all operations involving pipeline or gas facility installation or maintenance, the use of a drilling rig, completion rig, workover rig, or stimulation.

6. The exhaust from all engines, motors, coolers and other mechanized equipment, including compressor station fans, shall be vented in a direction away from the closest existing building units or platted subdivision lots.

H. Dust Control

Operator shall control fugitive dust arising from operations. Operator shall dust proof work area by sprinkling with water or a water/calcium chloride mixture where necessary.

I. Weed/Debris Control

The site shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition, free from weeds, debris and rubbish of every character to

the satisfaction of the City Code Enforcement Officer. The well pad should remain vegetation free.

J. Work hours

Site development, other than drilling shall be conducted only between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday. Truck deliveries of equipment and materials associated with drilling and well servicing, site preparation and other related work conducted on the site shall be limited to the above same work hour restrictions except in cases of an emergency. The operator may request an exception to this section for good cause shown.

K. Temporary housing for well site workers is not permitted at any time on the well site. One on-site office is permitted, but is not to be used for sleeping accommodations.

17.90.080. Water Quality Testing

As a condition of permit approval, applicant must provide to County, prior to any drilling activity, documentation of baseline water testing on a minimum of two down-gradient domestic wells for the protection of public health and safety. The applicant shall notify land owners who have registered their domestic wells with the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) and whose property lies within 300 feet of the proposed well drilling site by regular United States mail and by physical posting on the applicant's drill site fourteen (14) days in advance of intent to engage in baseline well testing. Tests shall be completed for all items listed.

- a. Field parameters.
 - 1. Water temperature
 - 2. PH
 - 3. Specific conductivity.
- b. Specific conductivity and total dissolved solids.
- c. Major ions.
 - 1. Chloride
 - 2. Fluoride
 - 3. Sulfate
 - 4. Nitrate
 - 5. Silica
 - 6. Alkalinity
 - 7. Calcium
 - 8. Sodium
 - 9. Potassium
 - 10. Magnesium
- d. Trace elements.
 - 1. Aluminum
 - 2. Arsenic
 - 3. Barium
 - 4. Boron
 - 5. Iron
 - 6. Manganese
 - 7. Selenium
 - 8. Uranium
- e. Radiochemical.
 - 1. Gross alpha/gross beta radioactivity, in addition to uranium listed above.
- f. Organics.
 - 1. BTEX (benzene, ethylbenzene, toluene, and xylene
 - 2. Methane; carbon isotopic composition for samples with sufficient methane.

Baseline water testing shall be completed every twenty-four (24) months while the well is in production. Copies of baseline water quality test results shall be provided by the Applicant free of charge to owners of the wells tested within thirty days of receipt of written request of the well owner. All domestic well owners, as identified by the Idaho Department of Water Resources, within the surrounding 160-acre section shall be notified prior to drilling.

17.90.090. Geophysical Operations

A. Permit required.

It shall be unlawful for any person to conduct any exploration activities within the City regarding oil, gas, and/or other materials by the use of energy source operations, including without limitation weight drops, explosives, and/or vibrating machines, thumper trucks or any other vehicles or equipment that causes vibrations, without first obtaining a permit from the City. To the extent an applicant seeks to conduct Geophysical Operations on City property, including but not limited to City roads, highways, and real estate, the City Council has the express right to grant or deny any application under this Ordinance.

B. Permit application; fee procedure.

Application for a permit hereunder shall be made with the City. Such application shall contain the following information: (1) name of the applicant; (2) address of the applicant; (3) type of explosives or other geophysical methods of mineral exploration to be used, and the purposes therefore; (4) a map designating a testing area and showing the location of all points of

use and the energy source to be used at each point; (5) a traffic control plan for any operations or testing that will impede traffic on a public right-of way; and (6) the applicant's insurance information, including the name of applicant's insurance carrier, the types and amount of insurance covering its proposed operations, the name and telephone number of an individual to contact in case of a claim for personal injury or property damage, and the procedure for obtaining a copy of applicant's certificate of insurance; (7) a copy of a signed and approved Permit for Geophysical Operations issued by the State of Idaho.

A non-refundable permit fee as set by resolution of the City Council for processing the application and preparing the permit shall accompany each such application. On receipt of such application, the City shall prepare a report showing all City facilities or infrastructure that may be affected by the proposed exploration activity located in the testing area shown in such application. Such report and the application shall then be submitted to the City Council with the recommendations of City Staff. No permit shall be issued except upon approval of the City Council.

C. Term.

An approved Geophysical Operations permit shall expire thirty (30) days after completion of all activities. All permits issued under this section shall be for a time period not to exceed ninety (90) days from the date of issuance of the permit.

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form as

permitted by the State of Idaho.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor punishable by fine and/or imprisonment up to but not exceeding the maximum penalties set forth in Idaho Code § 18-113 and §50-302.

Actions and Findings of Council _____

Annexation brings property that is within the City's Impact Area into the City limits. Current City and County policies allow urban development only inside the City limits. In addition, the City cannot provide "urban" services like sewer and water to properties outside the City limits.

The City of Payette annexes property under a two-step procedure. First, the Planning & Zoning Commission must hold a Public Hearing and determine whether or not to recommend the annexation application to the City Council. 

ROLL CALL

Members Present: Mayor Jeff Williams; Mark Heleker, Nancy Dale, Ray Wickersham, Lee Nelson, Craig Jensen and Jeff Sands

Members Absent: None.

Staff Present: Steve Castenada, Fire Chief; Clint Benson, Building Inspector; Mark Clark, Chief of Police; Bert Osborn, City Attorney; Mary Cordova, City Administrator; Brenda Stowe, Administrative Services Clerk.

Mayor Williams and Councilor Jensen talked sometime ago about some of the things builders say about how we can expedite our services or make it easier, this is not topick on our Building Inspector but a communication effort so that we learn what the public may say versus what is actually happening, so its an open dialog with the Building Department too. A couple of things the Mayor has heard is the timely manner in which inspections are held, working with contractors when there is a violation or challenges after the last inspection instead of shutting the whole project down. Councilor Jensen said that he has heard what the Mayor had brought up, in regards to a re-inspection that closed the entire project down instead of just the affected area, they should be able to keep working on the project that doesn't have a violation until it is corrected and then have it re-inspected. The other things he has heard from the builders in the area is in regards to the Impact Fees, our surrounding neighbors do not have these, why do we feel the need to have them. Where do they go, are they ear-marked to a particular department, what is it they are paying for? He feels there is some miscommunication between builders the inspectors and or the City. The Mayor explained that he served as a member of a legislative task forcewith the Idaho Association of Realtors, he was still a Council memberthen, that legislative body cautioned cities about charging development fees, which we were, that was not the way to go about it. The Council at that time engaged our Planning & Zoning Commission, they had committee meetings, the Council had work sessions and they hired someone to come in and talk to the Council about the legalities, it involved months of meetings and public hearings to become legal with that process. The fees cover Fire and Police, however there could be additional fees implemented in the future as well, to Parks and Streets. The Council at that time felt that by charging for all would be too expensive (over \$2000.00), and they would only charge for the two which is about \$825.00. The theory there is new people who come into our community have impact on our police, fire, streets and parks that those new comers should pay their way. Impact Fees currently are in place for Fire Dept. and Police Dept. At the time of the Public Hearings it was decided to go with the smaller amount. Councilor Sands replied in perspective, we were going through quick expansion of development at the time and the Impact fees were put in place to get ahead of the curve and to offset expansion fees. We had no subdivisions at one time, and then a change of mode where we had several, everyone around us was booming too. Of course we've had five or six years of depressed market and we solved that somewhat by our reduction in building permit fees. We have offset to a point, but still looking down the road He feels that was a good choice made by the Council because down the road somewhere the markers get called in. He doesn't think it is anything that they can't adjust as a Council, we went too pretty great lengths, it was after months of study, and it was no quick act thing. The Mayor said from his other job he knows we have lower water fees, lower sewer bills, sewer hookup fees, and development fees. We are the only ones that have impact fees, but he still feels that for someone building a new house, Payette still has lower fees. Councilor Nelson said that Ontario is looking to get rid of impact fees. Councilor Wickersham wanted to know what our numbers are. Are we putting fees on top of other fees? Jensen is concerned our fees are prohibiting us from new business. Mary Cordova stated that the Council had a lot of foresight in

doing this with the theory "Growth must pay for itself". Why should existing homeowners pay for an additional road just because someone new wants to build? We were charging \$850.00 and calling it a development fee, about that time Ontario got in a pickle for charging fees without a legal process. We were doing the same thing. So the Council at that time said if we want to continue charge a fee we must continue to do so in a legal manner. We worked on it about a year to develop a Capital Improvement Plan. The County hired the same company we did to develop the same process, Ann Westcott, but when the economy began to slow down they dropped the idea. Mayor Williams replied because of his other job he is aware that our fees are lower and he is proud of that. Builders can know that it is cheaper and that one thing will stick in your mind. Councilor Dale stated that a developer can say why do we have to pay impact fees? When I don't have to pay an impact fee somewhere else? Councilor Wickersham thought that Councilor Jensen could have said yes, you are paying impact fees but you are still paying less than you would anywhere else. Building Inspector, Clint Benson replied that it is on the building permit that he has a 24 hour window to complete the inspection and he does do so unless he is sick. It is rare that if they call the day before that he doesn't do the inspection the next day. Sometimes if they call early enough he is able to do so the same day. Benson stated that in a framing inspection if he comes across something that structurally doesn't meet the code he'll write a correction list and leave a copy on the site that is one thing that may hold up construction. He does work with people and he understands that time is money. The Mayor did hear a great compliment about working with Mr. Benson; the builder did enjoy working with our City Inspector. Benson invites people to come to him; he would rather meet face to face to discuss a problem. There are a few builders that anytime a correction must be made it makes him the bad guy. If you are stopping somebody from working because they don't have a permit or ask them to make corrections they are not going to look at you like your best friend. Benson always tries to write notes in red ink to bring awareness to foreseeable issues in the field they may encounter, or changes to the plans that must be made with a date and his signature. Some of the problems he runs into is they don't read the plans or lose them. Another question is in helping them move things along we're not helping them move along by ignoring the codes. Jensen asked if there was a way to keep from stopping a whole project and keep people working? Benson replied that would put the City at risk, by allowing work to be completed that may not meet code. If there is a way to keep things moving he will, time is money, he does try to work with folks, but if there is not a building permit work has to stop. Ms. Cordova brought to the Council's attention that they set it that if there is no building permit, work is stopped and fees are doubled. Having a building permit is important. Heleker feels that most businesses are always jockeying for the best deal they can get just like any other business, yes, we can market it better, but overall he feels good about what we offer builders in our community. Mayor Williams said Building codes interpretations are up to the builder, if an individual is building and chooses to put themselves at risk by using a lower grade product, it is one thing, but a business putting the public at risk is something else. Our building inspector has to make sure public structures are done to code. Councilor Sands was in the building inspectors shoes for many years, the key to code is uniformity. We're paying these guys to enforce our code. If we can't support our help, there is something wrong; if the builders lose their plans or don't bother to read their plans then it's their fault not the building inspector. He commends Benson for doing his job. Sands reminded the council that the inspectors are not designers; they are being paid to make sure the build is to code.

- A. Building Permit Fee Discussion –Ms. Cordova explained that in August of 2013 our building permit fees were at 53% of the national average and the Council dropped them down to 45% to compete with our neighbors. At that time our building fees were less than our neighbors to encourage building in our city. We need to decide if we wish to continue with the discount and tell builders “Our building permits are on sale, come build in Payette” or do we want to raise it back to where it was. The Council wished to know where we are in comparison with our neighboring cities. Are we still lower than our neighbors?

A motion was made by Wickersham and seconded by Heleker to approve the extension of the discount of 45% of our building fees to August 31, 2015.

Doug Argo stated that we do not do aviation planning it is handled by the state. Councilor Heleker asked if the extension would impact Mr. Gray’s land, Cordova answered hopefully not. Councilor Nelson asked if the Golf Course had trimmed the trees that were affecting the runway, Ms. Cordova stated that the trees will be taken care of in the master plan. Cordova would like to get some of this out of the way before the end of this budget. Attorney Bert Osborn stated that to get the job the contractor would have to agree to his terms.

He stated that policy wording only addresses the Post test that the officers are currently doing twice a year. He would like to do the Post fitness test in the spring and the SWAT fitness test in the fall. There is a small increase in the fees that are included in the budget.

- D. Rose Advocate Fundraiser Request- Councilor Dale wished to make aware that October 6th is the annual fundraiser for Rose Advocates. Rose Advocates currently serves Adams, Gem, Payette, Valley and Washington Counties as well as part of Boise with the main office in Payette. The fundraiser is to be held in Weiser at the Vendome Event Center. Possible Guest Speaker Abbey Lee, if not her then Brian Lee, participants will receive a great dinner and opportunity to participate in a silent auction. Councilor Dale would like 2 or 3 couples to represent Payette and is asking the City Council's support by purchasing those tickets.

- F. Extension of Highway 95 Development Landscape Plan- Mr. Goodwin has asked the requirement of landscaping for his project on Hwy 95 be extended until after the C of O. Ms. Cordova reported that Mr. Goodwin has not yet submitted a landscaping plan. Because Mr. Goodwin is putting in multiple businesses it is thought that he wishes to put one plan all at once not in three or four different plans. The Council understands that, but they need to have a plan. If we are not uniform with this and consistent it can cause problems with other businesses. Jensen would like to work with the developers by giving a time frame and perhaps charging only one fee, instead of adding fees each time they change their plans. Ms. Cordova stated that we try to make things easier for the contractor, save him a few dollars, usually the contractor needs to submit landscape plans with the building plans. Benson said typically landscaping is complete prior to issuing a Certificate of Occupancy, if it isn't we have no way to make sure it gets done. Cordova stated that Mr. Goodwin wishes to landscape in the spring but he wants a Certificate of Occupancy in October. Mayor Williams said the Council needs a landscaping plan and landscape in front of the building.



- A. An application by the City of Payette to annex approximately 20 acres, North of 7th Ave N. East of canal and West of Sunset Rim Subdivision. The proposed zoning will be B-Residential:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, T 9 N, R 5 W, B.M., Payette County, Idaho, lying Southerly of the upper bank of the Lower Payette Ditch Company Canal.

AND

A portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, T 9 N, R 5 W, B.M., Payette County, Idaho, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 660 feet S of the NW corner of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$;

thence E and parallel to the N side line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 594 feet;

thence S and parallel to the W side line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 645 feet, more or less, to the S side line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$;

Ken Johnson – 1962 7th Avenue North; Payette, Idaho

Mr. Johnson stated that he has a problem with being annexed; also I don't have enough grade to hook up to sewer services. I am sitting way to low to be able to hook into city services. Also, the property in front of my house I have an easement to drive and do not have an easement to dig on the property. I would like you to consider not annexing me. Councilor Youngberg asked if he access the property through his front neighbor. Mr.

Johnson stated yes. Mr. Johnson stated that the sewer issue was one of his concerns when they put the sewer services in when he worked for the city for 24 years. Mr. Johnson also stated that he cannot receive city water either, or trash as he is too far back.

Barbara Little – 1950 7th Avenue North; Payette, Idaho

Ms. Little stated that many years ago she split her property and when they were hooking up the city services originally she asked for two services and the water department only shows one service. Ms. Little stated that her problem is tying into the city services with water and sewer. Ms. Little asked if she has to pay to hook up now? Councilor Hanigan asked if she has two houses. Ms. Little stated no. It is all one property. Councilor McElravy asked if Ms. Little uses her property for animals. Ms. Little stated yes, she has donkeys.

Mike Mercer – 1896 7th Avenue North; Payette, Idaho –

Mr. Mercer stated that he had 5 different items that were to be completed per a contract with the city before he was to be annexed. The items were not completed, so he wants to know if he has to be annexed. The items were to be water issue, water line to be fixed, grade to be fixed, driveway to be widened, and they broke off my sewer clean out and have yet to fix any of these items. Commissioner Hanigan asked how long ago they widened 7th Avenue North. Mr. Mercer stated 4 or 5 years ago.

B. Proposed Gas & Oil Ordinance

Clerk Cordova stated that this is the final version of the proposed ordinance. Clerk Cordova stated that since it is going into our zoning ordinance that is why we are holding a public hearing.

- C. An application by James Newman for a Conditional Use Permit to construct a 1,540 sq ft shop with a roof height of 22' at 521 North 10th St, Lots 15 & 16, Blk 2, Park Addition. The property is zoned B-Residential.

James Newman – 521 North 10th Street; Payette, Idaho –

Mr. Newman stated that he would like to build a wood working shop and boat storage on the alley side of his property. Mr. Newman stated that he has met all the setbacks for his property. Commissioner McElravy asked why the building would be so high. Mr. Newman stated that to put a camper in. Currently in that neighborhood there are at least 7 structures that exceed that height requirement. Mr. Newman stated that fire suppression will not be an issue as this is on the alley and the fire hydrant is on the corner. Commissioner Hanigan asked if there will be electricity and water/sewer. Mr. Newman stated that he would like to have a shower so he can clean up before he walks through his house, I would also have a walk in cooler, a fish cleaning station and boat storage. Commissioner Hanigan asked if he would have an issue exposing his property pins. Mr. Newman stated that he was able to expose one and everything matches up.

Prescott Wilkie – 130 North 20th Street; Payette, Idaho –

Mr. Wilkie stated that he is building a hobby workshop on his property. I have completed all the criteria. Mr. Wilkie stated that he will only have electricity and it will be a two car garage. Commissioner Hanigan asked if he will be removing the current structure. Mr. Wilkie stated that it will not be attached, maybe a breezeway, but it will replace the old shop he is tearing down.

Public Hearing Closed at 6:22pm.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

A. City of Payette – Annexation Application

Clerk Cordova stated that Mr. Johnson property will be hard to get the slope to go to the property for sewer and water, as well as Ms. Little. Clerk Cordova stated that when we did the 7th Avenue North right of way negotiation we purchased property from all these owners and they signed an agreement saying they will be annexed within two years. These agreements were signed in 2009 and in 2011. She approached the city council about annexation and they decided to wait. We then approached the City Council again in 2014, they said it was time to annex. Commissioner Youngberg asked how the city would handle a property like Mr. Johnson's and Ms. Little regarding flow issues. Clerk Cordova stated that there are properties in town that the homeowners had to pay to get the flow to the street. Mr. Johnson's property is a little different as he does not have an easement to dig on the neighbors property, he can only drive on the property.

Commissioner Youngberg stated that he has been annexed against his will; he owns property on 7th Avenue North as well. The thing that was explained to was I was using city services without paying for them, I didn't like it then, but I understand it now. Commissioner McElravy stated that the property is small and I have a concern with them being able to have animals. Clerk Cordova stated that they are B-Residential and are allowed to have certain animals and can always get a conditional use permit. Commissioner McElravy stated that she does feel that Mr. Johnson's and Ms. Little's properties should not be annexed.

Ladley moved and Youngberg seconded a motion to send a favorable recommendation to the City Council to annex the proposed property with the following items needing to be address: Mr. Mercers 5 issues, Mr. Johnson's issues for water and sewer need to be addressed and Ms. Little's issues for water and sewer being addressed by city administration or the City Council being addressed.

After a unanimous voice vote by the Commission, the motion CARRIED.

B. Gas & Oil Ordinance

Ladley moved and McElravy seconded a motion to send a favorable recommendation for the Gas and Oil Ordinance.

After a unanimous voice vote by the Commission, the motion CARRIED.

C. James Newman – CUP – 521 No 10th St

McElravy moved and Henderson seconded a motion to grant a CUP to James Newman at 521 No 10th St with the following stipulations: Structure shall be used exclusively now, and in the future, as a garage shed, incidental and accessory to the primary single family building on the lot, structure shall not exceed 1,540 square feet, nor exceed 22 feet in height, structure must be 4' from the house (primary structure), structure shall not be used at any time for any residential purpose and all State, Local, and Federal regulations shall be met.

After a unanimous voice vote by the Commission, the motion CARRIED.

D. Prescott Wilkie – CUP – 130 No 20th St

1. Youngberg moved and Ladley seconded a motion to grant a CUP to Prescott Wilkie at 130 North 20th Street with the following stipulations: Structure shall be used exclusively now, and in the future, as a garage shed, incidental and accessory to the primary single family building on the lot, structure shall not exceed 1,248 square feet, nor exceed 14 feet in height, structure must be 4' from the house (primary structure), structure shall not be used at any time for any residential purpose, all State, Local, and Federal regulations shall be met, and no business is to be conducted out of the garage, since this is in an A-Residential Zone

After a unanimous voice vote by the Commission, the motion CARRIED.



Re: Abatement Notice and Order – 409 N. 7th Street & 105 N. 9th Street

BACKGROUND & JUSTIFICATION:

On July 28, 2014, the Payette Building Official sent an Abatement Notice and Order to the owners of the two properties referenced above in accordance with Section 401 of the Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, adopted in Payette Municipal Code, Chapter 15.04.


The property owners did not appeal the Order, nor have either property owner taken steps to repair their property within the required time frame. By code, failure to comply with the Order, the building official may cite the property owner, or, the City may take appropriate action to abate the property.

FISCAL IMPACT:

If the Council should choose to take steps to repair or demolish the nuisance properties, a contractor could be hired to conduct the work. The cost of the work would be paid from City funds, and would eventually be recovered through a special assessment against the property.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Council determine whether to prosecute the property owners for non-compliance with the Abatement Order, or, instruct City staff to initiate any appropriate action to abate the properties as a public nuisance.

We have found the referenced building to meet the definition of a dangerous building as defined in Section 302 of the 1997 Abatement of Dangerous Buildings adopted by the City of Payette. The building has been damaged by fire to such an extent to cause serious structural deficiencies. The building is currently unsafe to occupy and has become a nuisance and danger to the public.

You are hereby ordered to either demolish or begin repair of the structure within sixty (60) days of this notice. If you choose to repair the structure all required permits shall be secured and work physically commenced within the sixty (60) day time frame. A structural analysis by a professional engineer licensed in the State of Idaho will be required as part of the building repair plans.

If the required demolition or repair work is not commenced within the time specified the City may cause the work to be done and charge the cost thereof against the property or its owner.

Any person having any record title or interest in the building may appeal this order provided the appeal is made in writing and filed with the Building Official within thirty (30) days of this order. Failure to appeal will constitute a waiver of all right to an administrative hearing and determination of the matter.



If the required demolition or repair work is not commenced within the time specified the City may cause the work to be done and charge the cost thereof against the property or its owner.



- A. Tree Inventory Update – Curt Van Patten stated that Ron Mahler and him have inventoried the trees in Kiwanis Park. Since doing inventory 5 trees have been removed. They have went to Centennial Park and GPS one tree. They need to go back to Kiwanis and GPS all the trees. By the end of the week 2 more trees will be gone leaving a total of 198 trees in the park.
