

ORDINANCE NO. 1002

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, PROHIBITING U-TURNS AND CROSSING TRAFFIC IN CERTAIN AREAS OF THE CITY; ESTABLISHING THE ACT AS AN INFRACTION; SEVERABILITY; REPEALER; EFFECTIVE DATE;

BE IT ORDAINED By the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1: a. It shall be unlawful to execute a U-Turn on the following designated streets which lie within the City limits of Payette: Main Street; ~~Highway 30~~; Highway 95; Center Avenue; Highway 52; Seventh Avenue North.

b. While operating a motor vehicle within 100 yards of a school, it shall be unlawful to cross an oncoming traffic lane to discharge passengers.

c. A violation of either Section a. or b. shall be an infraction.

Section 2: This section shall be designated as Section 10.20.100. in the Payette Municipal Code.

Section 3: If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remaining portion of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: Any portions of any existing Ordnances which are in direct conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.

BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS APPROVAL, PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 16th day of APRIL, 1990.
