

ORDINANCE 1012

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING SECTION 6.08.060 C.; ESTABLISHING A MINIMUM FINE; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; REPEALER; EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING FOR PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY:

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 1: That Section 6.08.060 C of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows;

C. Any owner, possessor or person who violates this section or who keeps any dog which violates the provisions of this section, or fails to construct or maintain an enclosure or a restraining system sufficient to restrain a dog at all times, or sufficient to keep others from releasing their dogs, shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars for the first occurrence, fifty dollars for the second occurrence and one hundred dollars for each occurrence thereafter.

Section 2: The purpose of the amendment is to make a minimum mandatory fine of twenty-five dollars for the first occurrence, fifty dollars for the second occurrence and one hundred dollars for each occurrence thereafter.

Section 3: In any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remaining portion of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: Any portions of any existing Ordinances which are in direct conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.

BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER IT APPROVAL, PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
