

ORDINANCE 1037

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE IDAHO, ADDING A NEW SECTION TO THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE WHICH SHALL BE DESIGNATED AS SECTION 3.12.090; REQUIRING ALL RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE TO SHARE IN THE COST OF FIRE PROTECTION AND BONDED INDEBTEDNESS; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALER; SEVERABILITY:

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. There is hereby created a new section of the Payette Municipal Code which shall read as follows:

3.12.090 All residents of the city shall pay and discharge their share of city fire protection and bonded indebtedness. The amount shall be computed upon a per household basis and shall be paid at the rate of FIVE dollars and 25/100 DOLLARS (\$5.25) per household per month. Those residents who are receiving city water services shall continue to pay their share through their monthly water bills and those residents who are paying for sewer services only, shall have that amount added to their monthly sewer bill. Any resident who is not receiving either sewer or water services shall be billed annually by the city clerk.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after it's passage and publication as provided by law.

Section 3. All ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 4. If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remainder or the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and shall constitute Ordinance 1037.
