

ORDINANCE 1047

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE IDAHO, PROHIBITING THE RIDING OR PRESENCE OF CERTAIN ANIMALS WITHIN THE DOWNTOWN AREA OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALER; SEVERABILITY:

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. Section 6.04.010 of Title 6 is hereby amended with the addition of a new subsection 6.04.010 A. Said subsection shall read as follows:

6.04.010 A: No person shall, without first obtaining a permit from the City Clerk, ride any horse, mule, llama or cattle, or suffer, permit or allow any horse, mule, llama or cattle to come upon any city park, or upon any street, alley, or private property which lies within the City Limits of Payette, Idaho, and which is more particularly described as lying South of Third Avenue North, North of Highway Business 95, East of Sixth Street and West of Tenth Street.

6.04.010 B: The City Clerk is authorized to receive applications for permits, charge a fee therefore and issue permits, either individually or to groups, for parade purposes or for other purposes which benefit the general public.

6.04.010 C: Any animal found in an area described in Section 6.04.010 A, whose owner has not obtained the required permit, shall be subject to seizure as set out in Section 6.04.010 and the owner, possessor or rider thereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished in accordance with the Misdemeanor laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after it's passage and publication as provided by law.

Section 3. This ordinance may be published by summary as provided by law.

Section 4. If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and shall constitute Ordinance 1047.

Section 5. All ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.
