

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1057

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING SECTION 13.04.260 SUBPARTS C. AND D. BY CHANGING THE MAXIMUM AMOUNTS OF WATER ALLOWED TO BE USED FOR THE MINIMUM MONTHLY FEE; INCREASING THE MINIMUM FEE FOR WATER USED IN EXCESS OF TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND GALLONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; REPEALER;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. Subsections C. and D. of Section 13.04.260 of the City Code of Payette, Idaho are hereby amended to read as follows:

13.04.260 C. For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of two thousand (2,000) gallons and not to exceed sixty two hundred and fifty thousand (250,000) gallons, the charge shall be one dollar ten cents for each one thousand gallons or fraction thereof.

13.04.260 D. For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of sixty two hundred fifty thousand (250,000) gallons, the charge shall be sixty-five seventy-two and one-half cents (\$.725) for each one thousand gallons or fractions thereof.

Section 2. Any ordinances which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 3. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall constitute Ordinance Number 1057.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect July 1, 1993 upon passage and publication as required by law.
