

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1061

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING TITLE 13 CHAPTER 4 AND CHAPTER 8; AMENDING SECTION 13.04.280 BY INCREASING THE WATER CONNECTION AND TAP FEES; AMENDING SECTION 13.08.031 BY INCREASING THE SEWER INSPECTION AND PERMIT FEE; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; REPEALER; PENALTY;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. Section 13.04.280 is hereby amended to read as follows: Connection fee--Tap pipe charges. A fee of ~~two~~ three hundred-fifty (350.00) dollars shall be charged and collected by the city clerk for each and every connection to the city water mains and lines. In addition to this connection fee, there shall be a charge of ~~two~~ three hundred fifty (350.00) dollars for labor and service materials provided in putting in each tap pipe to connect the same with the curb box and up to a one inch (1") meter, or the current cost of materials and service and the actual cost of repairing the street after the installation of the tap pipe.

Section 3. 13.08.031 Classes of Permits. There shall be two classes of building sewer permits; one for residential and commercial service, and one for service to establishments producing industrial wastes. In either case, the owner or his agent shall make application on a special form furnished by the city. The permit application shall be supplemented by any plans, specifications, or other information considered pertinent in the judgement of the city. A permit and inspection fee of ~~two~~ three hundred fifty (350.00) dollars for a residential or commercial building sewer permit and ~~two~~ three hundred fifty (350.00) dollars for an industrial building sewer permit shall be paid to the city at the time the application is filed.

Section 4. Any Ordinances which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall constitute Ordinance Number 1061.

Section 6. This Ordinance may be published by summary in accordance with the Statutes of the State of Idaho.

Section 7. Any violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor punishable in accordance with the general misdemeanor statutes of the State of Idaho.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
