

ORDINANCE 1076

AN ORDINANCE OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING TITLE TWO OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING NEW CHAPTERS WHICH ARE DESIGNATED AS CHAPTER 2.22 AND CHAPTER 2.34 WHICH CHAPTERS CREATE A PUBLIC SAFETY DIRECTOR AND PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR; THE CHAPTERS DESIGNATE THEIR DUTIES AND ESTABLISH A RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT; REPEALER; SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1: There is hereby created a new Chapter 2.22 of the Payette Municipal Code which Chapter shall read as follows:

Chapter 2.22

DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY

2.22.010 Office created--Appointment--Term of Office.

There is hereby created the office of Director of Public Safety. Such office shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the City Council. The Director of Public Safety shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor and City Council.

2.22.020 Residency requirements. At the time of his appointment, the Director of Public Safety need not be a resident of the City of Payette, but shall become a resident within 60 days from the time of appointment and, during the term of office shall remain a resident of the city and shall reside therein.

2.22.030 Duties. The Public Safety Director shall be the supervisor to the Chief of Police, to the Fire Chief and to the fire and police departments. The Director, subject to the approval of the Mayor and City Council, shall have the responsibility to oversee the daily operations of the Departments and shall have authority to dismiss, suspend and discipline all employees under his supervision or control. The Director shall carry out all lawful directives of the Mayor or of the City Council.

Section 2: There is hereby created a new Chapter 2.33 of the Payette Municipal Code which Chapter shall read as follows:

Chapter 2.33

DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS

2.33.010 Office created--Appointment--Term of Office.

There is hereby created the office of Director of Public Works. Such office shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the City Council. The Director of Public Works shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor and City Council.

2.33.020 Residency requirements. At the time of his appointment, the Public Works Director need not be a resident of the City of Payette, but shall become a resident within 60 days from the time of appointment and, during the term of office shall remain a resident of the city and shall reside therein.

2.33.030 Duties. The Public Works Director shall be the supervisor over the water and sewer, parks and recreation and street departments and over the department heads of those departments. The Director, subject to the approval of the Mayor and City Council, shall have the responsibility to oversee the daily operations of the Departments and shall have authority to dismiss, suspend and discipline all employees under his supervision or control. The Director shall carry out all lawful directives of the Mayor or of the City Council.

Section 3. Any ordinances which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 4. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall constitute Ordinance Number 1076.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.

Section 6. This Ordinance may be published by summary as provided by law.
