

ORDINANCE NO. 1091

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING SECTION 2.28.020 OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION I. WHICH ADDS NEW DUTIES TO THOSE OF THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY OR HIS DESIGNEE WHICH DUTIES ALLOW THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY OR HIS DESIGNEE TO DETECT, PREVENT AND CORRECT FIRE HAZARDS; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ALLOWING FOR PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. Section 2.28.020 of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of a new subsection I.

I. To inspect, look for, identify and seek out conditions within the City which constitute a fire hazard; to take all means necessary to abate those conditions including but not limited to giving warnings, sending notices requiring abatement of any hazard, issuing cease and desist orders, issuing uniform citations, or pursuing civil abatement actions in the name of the City.

Section 2. Any ordinances which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 3. If any portion of this ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the ordinance shall constitute ordinance number 1091.

Section 4. This ordinance may be published by summary in accordance with the statutes of the state of Idaho.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
