

ORDINANCE NO. 1096

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING SECTION 2.40.020 3B OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE TO STATE THAT MOTORS SHALL BE STARTED TWICE WEEKLY; AMENDING SECTION 2.40.050 BY ADDING AND DELETING CERTAIN SELECTION CRITERIA; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ALLOWING FOR PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. Section 2.40.020 3B of Title 2 of the Payette Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. Motors shall be started at least ~~once each day~~ twice weekly and run until thoroughly warm. The use of a choke shall be minimum and the motor allowed to run at full idle for several moments before shutting down.

Section 2. Section 2.40.050 of Title 2 of the Payette Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.40.050 Selection criteria. Appointment of new men personnel into the fire department shall be made with the object of improving the operation, efficiency and general excellency of the manpower. In the selection of men personnel, consideration shall be given to the following rules:

A. The age of the applicant shall not be less than nineteen years ~~or more than thirty-four years.~~ , the applicant shall have graduated from high school or have earned a G.E.D., and shall have no felony convictions.

~~B. ---Waist measure exceeding chest measure shall be sufficient cause for rejection.~~

EB. Members shall reside within the city impact area.

BC. All new men personnel shall serve a probation period of at least six months before permanent appointment into the department.

ED. No person shall be permitted to become or remain a member of the department who is physically unable to meet the physical requirements, ~~crippled or~~ is otherwise disabled from performing the duties of the department , or fails or refuses periodic drug testing.

FE. All appointments of new men personnel into the fire department must meet the approval of the mayor and council.

Section 3. Any ordinances which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 4. If any portion of this ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the ordinance shall constitute ordinance number 1096.

Section 5. This ordinance may be published by summary in accordance with the statutes of the state of Idaho.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
