

ORDINANCE NO. 1100

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, CREATING A NEW SECTION 18.16.070 OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE PROHIBITING TRAPPING OF ANIMALS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF PAYETTE, IDAHO; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ALLOWING FOR PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. There is hereby created a new code section which shall be designated 18.16.070, and which shall read as follows:

18.16.070. It shall be unlawful to trap animals within the city limits of Payette, Payette County, Idaho. Trapping is defined as the ensnarement, capture, entrapment, killing or taking of animals for the purpose of removing, using, obtaining or selling animal pelts.

Section 2. Any person who violates this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable in accordance with the misdemeanor statutes of the State of Idaho.

Section 3. Any ordinances which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 4. If any portion of this ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the ordinance shall constitute ordinance number 1100.

Section 5. This ordinance may be published by summary in accordance with the statutes of the state of Idaho.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
