

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1140

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE IDAHO, AMENDING TITLE 5, BY CREATING A NEW CHAPTER 32, AND ADDING NEW SECTIONS 5.32.010 AND 5.32.020 WHICH SECTIONS REQUIRE ALL CONTRACTORS ENGAGING IN PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION TO HAVE A PUBLICS WORKS LICENSE; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. Title 5 of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby amended with the addition of a new Chapter 5.32 and new sections 5.32.010 and 5.32.020 which sections shall read as follows:

5.32.010 PUBLIC WORKS LICENSES: Any general contractor, subcontractor or any person, who engages in any public works as defined by section 54-1901 Idaho Code, whether as a result of a direct contract with the City or simply undertaking any construction, repair or reconstruction of any work which is constructed with the intention of being transferred to the city, shall have a public works license as defined by title 54 of the Idaho Code.

5.32.020: Any person who is found to have violated this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished in accordance with the misdemeanor statutes of the State of Idaho.

Section 2. All ordinances in which are conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 3. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and shall constitute Ordinance 1140.

Section 4. This ordinance may be published by summary in accordance with the Statutes of the State of Idaho.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.
