

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1199

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING SECTION 13.08.033 OF THE PAYETTE CITY CODE WHICH REQUIRES THE DEVELOPER OF A DUPLEX, TRIPLEX OR QUADPLEX TO INSTALL INDIVIDUAL SEWER HOOKUPS TO EACH UNIT; REQUIRING FOUR INCH DIAMETER PIPE; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER; CREATING A PENALTY;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. Section 13.08.033 of the Payette City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

13.08.033 Separate Sewer Lines For Each Building Or Building Unit; A separate and independent sewer line shall be provided for every building in both residential and commercially zoned areas, and to each individual unit in any duplex, triplex or quadplex. Industrial wastes shall enter the public sewer at as many points as are required by the industrial facility. Each point of entry shall have an industrial monitor station at that point. Service lines shall be at least four inches (4") in diameter.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.

Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 4. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall constitute Ordinance Number 1199.

Section 5. Any violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor punishable in accordance with the misdemeanor statutes of the State of Idaho. In the event any pipe or service line is installed in violation of this ordinance, in addition to any criminal penalties the City may require the owner, installer, developer or other responsible person to remove the pipe at the owners expense.
