

ORDINANCE 1231

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING ARTICLE 17.08.360 TO CLARIFY THE MEANING OF HOUSEHOLD PETS; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

SECTION 1. There is hereby an amendment to Title 17 to clarify the meaning of Household Pets, which shall read as follows:

17.08.360 Household Pets: "Household pets" are limited to dogs and cats that are kept within the property boundary of the household plus fish, small animals like hamsters that are caged and kept within the residence and caged birds like a parrot or parakeet that are kept within the residence. Requests to harbor any other kind of pet shall be taken to the Planning and Zoning Commission before being introduced into the City.

SECTION 2. Any ordinances which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

SECTION 3. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in effect and shall constitute Ordinance 1231.


SECTION 4. Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and may be punished in accordance with the misdemeanor laws of the State of Idaho.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
