

**ORDINANCE 1283**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING SECTIONS 13.04.260, Table A2.1 ADJUSTMENT FACTORS, OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE TO REPEAL 1.5" AND 3" WATER METER SERVICE; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

**Section 1.** Section 13.04.260, Table A2.1 "Adjustment Factors" of the Payette Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

| <b>WATER METER SIZE</b> | <b>ORIFICE AREA</b> | <b>ADJUSTMENT FACTOR</b> |
|-------------------------|---------------------|--------------------------|
| 3/4 inch                | .44 sq. in.         | 1.0                      |
| 1 inch                  | .79 sq. in.         | 1.8                      |
| 1 1/2 inch              | 1.77 sq. in.        | 4                        |
| 2 inch                  | 3.14 sq. in.        | 7                        |
| 3 inch                  | 7.07 sq. in.        | 16                       |
| 4 inch                  | 12.57 sq. in.       | 28                       |
| 6 inch                  | 28.26 sq. in.       | 64                       |

**Section 2.** This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

**Section 4.** Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

**Section 5.** If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.



### **BACKGROUND & JUSTIFICATION:**

Ordinance 1283 is merely a housekeeping ordinance. The City does not offer 1.5" or 3" water meters. It would not prove cost efficient for us to begin to offer those services, as we would have to acquire parts and tools in order to service those sizes. The water department does not currently service any 1.5" or 3" meters, nor do they anticipate a future need for them in the City.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

None.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Council suspend the rules and pass Ordinance 1283 on its first reading.

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE 1283

Ordinance 1283 is an ordinance of the City Of Payette, Idaho, adopted August 6, 2007. The ordinance may be descriptively known as the Payette City Ordinance which eliminates 1.5 inch and 3 inch water meter service. The Ordinance amends Section 13.04.260 Table A2.1 of the Payette City Code, the effect of which is to eliminate 1.5 inch and 3 inch water meter service. The Ordinance provides a severability clause, provides for publication by summary, sets an effective date, and establishes a repealer.
