

ORDINANCE No. 333

AN ORDINANCE granting to the Oregon Short Line Railroad Company a franchise to operate and maintain its present trackage as now located on Sixth Street, between Center Avenue and the Payette River, together with a franchise to rearrange its present trackage and construct, operate and maintain additional trackage on said Sixth Street, between the South Line of Center Avenue and the North Line of Third Avenue<sup>South,</sup> all within the City of Payette, Idaho.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. That a franchise be, and the same hereby is, granted to the Oregon Short Line Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, to operate and maintain its present trackage as now located on Sixth Street, between Center Avenue and the Payette River, as shown in red upon the attached print, which is hereby made a part of this ordinance, together with franchise to rearrange said present trackage and to construct, operate and maintain on Sixth Street, between the south Line of Center Avenue and the North Line of Third Avenue<sup>South,</sup> all within the City of Payette, such trackage as shown in yellow upon the said attached print, and the right to store cars for any and all purposes incidental to the maintenance and operation of said Railroad at said point.

Section 2. Provided, however, that the Railroad Company hereby and herewith agrees that cars shall not be spotted on or opposite First Avenue, Second Avenue and Third Avenue South.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force ten days after its passage and approval.
