

ORDINANCE NO. 388

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT CERTAIN ALLEY RUNNING IN AN EASTERLY AND WESTERLY DIRECTION THROUGH BLOCKS ONE (1) AND TWO (2) OF PAYETTE HEIGHTS ADDITION TO PAYETTE, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING THAT THE VACATED PORTION SHALL PASS TO AND BECOME A PART OF THE ABUTTING LOTS.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section I: That the following described portions of that certain Alley running in an Easterly and Westerly direction through Block 1 of Payette Height's Addition to Payette, Idaho, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 142.5 feet North of the Southeast Corner of Block 1 of Payette Height's Addition to Payette, Idaho; thence West 315 feet more or less to the West side line of said Block 1; thence North 15 feet; thence East 315 feet more or less to the East side line of said Block 1; thence South 15 feet more or less to the place of beginning.

be, and the same is hereby vacated.

Section II: That the following described portions of that certain alley running in an Easterly and Westerly direction through Block 2 of Payette Height's Addition to Payette, Idaho, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point located 142.5 feet North of the Southeast Corner of said Block 2; thence West 289 feet; thence North 15 feet; thence East 289 feet; thence South 15 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

be, and the same is hereby vacated.

Section III: That the portion of said alley so vacated by Section I hereof revert to and become a part of the abutting Lots in said Block 1, on the North and South side thereof respectively.

SECTION IV: That the portion of said alley so vacated by Section II hereof revert to and become a part of the abutting lots in said block 2 hereof, on the North and South sides thereof respectively.

SECTION V: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
