

ORDINANCE NO. 414.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 403,  
WHICH IS AN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 9 OF ORDINANCE NO.  
396; FIXING THE AMOUNT OF LICENSE FEE OF RETAILERS  
OF BEER:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE,  
IDAHO:

Section 1:-- That subsection 2 of Ordinance No. 403 as passed  
by the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, and approved  
by the Mayor of said city on the 17th day of June, 1935, be, and  
the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2.-- That Section 9 of Ordinance No. 396 as passed  
by the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, and approved by  
the Mayor of the City of Payette, Idaho, on the 7th day of August,  
1933, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Section 9.-- License fees for the retail sale of beer as  
defined in this ordinance are hereby fixed as follows:

(a) Where such retailer sells draft beer and bottled  
beer, or draft beer only, \$ 100.00 a year.

(b) Where such retailer sells only bottled beer, \$ 100.00  
a year.'

All licenses issued under the term of this ordinance shall  
expire on the 31st day of December of the year for which they are  
issued. All retail beer dealers having purchased a 1936 license  
for the retail sale of beer under the terms of Ordinance No. 396,  
as amended by Ordinance No. 403, shall be given credit for the  
amount paid for such license, on the fee for licenses provided  
to be purchased by them hereunder for the year 1936."
