ORDINANCE NO. 427

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 330 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, PASSED AND APPROVED ON THE 20TH DAY OF JULY, 1920, AND PROHIBITING THE RIDING OF BICYCLES ON THE SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, WITH CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUING OF PERMITS TO NEWSBOYS IN THE ACTUAL PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1.- That ordinance No. 330 of the city of Payette, Idaho, is hereby repealed.

Section 2.- It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle on any sidewalk or parking between the sidewalk and ~~parking~~ within the corporate limits of the city of Payette, Idaho, except cripples, police officers in the actual discharge of their duties, and regular employees of the post office in Payette, Idaho, in the discharge of their duties in the delivery and distribution of mail in the city of Payette, and provided, however, that the City Clerk of the city of Payette, Idaho, shall have the power at his discretion to issue a permit in writing to any newsboy delivering a daily newspaper within the city of Payette, Idaho, to ride the sidewalks within the city of Payette, Idaho, while in the actual discharge of his duties delivering newspapers. Provided further that such permit shall not give the holder thereof any right to ride bicycles on any sidewalk within the business section of the city of Payette, Idaho, and that such permit shall be subject to revocation at any time or without cause, and that the holder of such permit shall carry the same with him at all times and shall produce the same for inspection to any peace officer upon demand, and that refusal to do so shall work an immediate revocation thereof.

Section 3.- Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in the sum of not less than \$3.00 nor more than \$100.00.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
