

ORDINANCE NO. 453

BY PUBLIC AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 429, PASSED AND APPROVED AUGUST 23, 1937, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH PERMITS SHALL BE ISSUED WITHOUT FEE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1- That section 3 of Ordinance No. 428, passed and approved the 23rd day of August, 1937, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3- PERMIT REQUIRED. No wall, structure, building or part thereof within the City of Payette, shall hereafter be built, enlarged, or altered, until a plan of the proposed work together with a statement of the materials to be used, shall have been submitted to the Building Inspector or other designated official, who shall, if in accordance with the provisions herein contained, issue a permit for the proposed construction.

Structures hereafter erected without permit, or not in conformity with this ordinance, shall be removed.


No building shall be moved until a permit has been obtained from the designated official; and such official shall not issue such permit if in his judgment the proposed new location of the building would seriously increase the fire hazard of the surrounding buildings.

Each building permit shall recite this section.

No fee shall be charged for any building permit or for any permit to move a building within the City of Payette, Idaho."

Section 2- This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
