AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 6 OF GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 191 PROVIDING FOR A PURCHASING COMMITTEE; AND SECTION 7 OF GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 237 PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC BUILDING COMMITTEE; AND SECTION 202 OF GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 6 OF ARTICLE II ORDINANCE 118 PROVIDING THAT CITY CLERK IS TO BUY ALL SUPPLIES; AND SECTION 206, 207 AND 208 OF GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTIONS 2 OF ORDINANCE 222 AND SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF ORDINANCE 251 PROVIDING THAT CITY CLERK IS TAX COLLECTOR; AND SECTION 209 GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 2 ORDINANCE 224 AND ORDINANCE 448 ALL FIXING SALARY OF CITY CLERK AS POLICE JUDGE; AND SECTION 213 OF GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 288 FIXING SALARY OF CITY TREASURER; AND SECTIONS 215, 216, 217, 218 AND 219 OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTIONS 2, 3, 4, 5 AND 6 OF ARTICLE 4 ORDINANCE 118 RELATING TO DUTIES OF ROAD OVERSEER IN COLLECTING ROAD POLL TAX; AND SECTION 224 OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE 224 PROVIDING FOR FIXING THE SALARY OF POLICE OFFICERS; AND SECTION 226 OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 313 FIXING SALARY OF CITY ENGINEER; AND ORDINANCE 328 FIXING SALARY OF CITY ATTORNEY; AND ORDINANCES 241 AND 303 RELATING TO THE ORGANIZATION OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT; AND ORDINANCE 430 REQUIRING A LICENSE FROM PLUMBERS AND ELECTRICIANS; AND SECTION 244 OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE 290 PROHIBITING CERTAIN PERSONS FROM FREQUENTING POOL HALLS AND BOWLING ALLEYS; AND ORDINANCES 415, 426, 444 AND 445 ALL PROVIDING LICENSE FOR PIN BALL MACHINES; AND ORDINANCE 432 LICENSING PICKETING; AND SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, 4 AND 6 OF ORDINANCE 422 PROVIDING A LICENSE FOR JUNK YARDS AND AUTOMOBILE WRECKING YARDS; AND ORDINANCE 454 COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE "BLACKOUT" ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

That Section 6 of General Ordinances City of Payette, 1920, being Section 2 of Ordinance 191; Section 7 of General Ordinances City of Payette, 1920, being Section 1 of Ordinance 237; Section 202 of General Ordinances City of Payette, 1920, being Section 6 of Article II Ordinance 118; and Sections 206, 207 and 208 of General Ordinances City of Payette, 1920, being Section 2 of Ordinance 222 and Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance 251; and Section 209 General Ordinances City of Payette, 1920, being Section 2 Ordinance 224; and Ordinance 448; and Section 213 of General Ordinances City of Payette, 1920, being Section 2 Ordinance 288; and Sections 215, 216, 217, 218 and 219 of General Ordinances City of Payette, 1920, being Sections 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Article IV Ordinance 118; and Sections 224 of General Ordinance City of Payette, 1920, being Section 5 of Ordinance 224; and Section 226 of General Ordinance City of Payette, 1920, being Section 1 of Ordinance 313; and Ordinance 405; and Ordinance 328; and Ordinances 241 and 303; and Ordinance 430; and Section 244 of General Ordinances City of Payette, 1920, being Section 5 of Ordinance 290; and Ordinances 415, 426, 444 and 445; and Ordinance 432; and Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6 of Ordinance 422; and Ordinance 454, each of said ordinances relating to the subject matter

expressed in the title, be and the same are hereby repealed.
