

ORDINANCE NO. 474

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT WHENEVER THE TERMS, "CITY MARSHALL", "MARSHALL" OR "DAY MARSHALL" ARE USED IN THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE THAT THE SAME SHALL MEAN CHIEF OF POLICE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. Whenever the term "City Marshall", "Marshall" or "Day Marshall" is used in any ordinance it shall mean the duly appointed and qualified "Chief of Police".
