ORDINANCE NO. 481

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 116 GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 11 OF ORDINANCE 110, FIXING THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATING CERTAIN CRIMINAL PROVISIONS; AND AMENDING SECTION 126 GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 22, FIXING THE PENALTY FOR VAGARANCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 116 of the General Ordinances City of Payette, 1920, being Section 11 of Ordinance 110, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

116. Penalty for Violations. In all cases where a fine shall be imposed on any person for a violation of this ordinance, and the fine is not paid by such person, he may be imprisoned in the city jail one day for each and every One Dollar and Fifty Cents of said fine.

Section 2. That Section 126 General Ordinances City of Payette, 1920, being Section 2 of Ordinance 22, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

126. Duty of Chief of Police. It shall be the duty of the Chief of Police, either on his own knowledge, information or belief, or upon sworn complaint of any citizen, to arrest any person who is a vagarant, as defined in the preceeding section, and to bring him before the Police Judge of the City of Payette, and thereafter such proceeding shall be had, as in trial upon other charges for violation of ordinances. If on such trial it shall be made to appear that such person is a vagarant as defined in the preceeding section, such person shall be punished by fine in any sum not less than Five Dollars and not more than One Hundred Dollars and costs of prosecution and in the event that any part of such fine and costs is not paid he may be committed to the city jail one day for each One Dollar and Fifty Cents of such fine and costs remaining unpaid.
