ORDINANCE NO. *505*

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 427 TO PROVIDE THAT MESSENGERS EMPLOYED BY ANY DULY QUALIFIED TELEPHONE OR TELEGRAPH COMPANY, DELIVERING OR CARRYING MESSAGES WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE MAY BE GRANTED A PERMIT TO RIDE UPON THE SIDEWALKS WHILE SO ENGAGED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance 427 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle upon any sidewalk or parking between the sidewalk and curbing within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, except cripples, police officers in the actual discharge of their duties, and regular employees of the Post Office in Payette, Idaho, in the discharge of their duties in the delivery and distribution of mail in the City of Payette, and provided further, that the City Clerk of the City of Payette, Idaho, shall have the power at his discretion to issue a permit in writing to any newsboy delivering a daily newspaper within the City of Payette, Idaho, or to messengers, employed by any duly qualified telephone or telegraph company, delivering or carrying messages within the City of Payette, Idaho, to ride the sidewalks within said City of Payette, Idaho, while in the actual discharge of his duties delivering papers or carrying or delivering messages. Provided, further, that such permits shall not give the holder thereof the right to ride bicycles on any sidewalk within the business section of the City of Payette, Idaho, and that such permit shall be subject to revocation at any time without cause. The holder of such permit shall carry the same at all times and shall produce the same for inspection to any peace officer upon demand, and refusal to do so shall work an immediate revocation thereof.
