

ORDINANCE NO. 550

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7-204 OF REVISED CODE OF PAYETTE, 1946 PROVIDING FOR REGISTRATION FEE OF BICYCLES, TRANSFER OF TITLE OF BICYCLES AND RESPONSIBILITY OF CITY CLERK FOR FEES COLLECTED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 7-204 of Revised Code of Payette, 1946, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"7204. REGISTRATION FEE-TRANSFER OF TITLE--CLERK RESPONSIBLE FOR FEES.--Every bicycle owner shall pay a fee of fifty cents for each bicycle registered and to which a number plate is issued. In case of a sale or transfer of a bicycle from one individual to another the registration of such bicycle together with the number plate originally assigned thereto shall be transferred to the new purchaser, or transferee, and the number plate originally assigned to such bicycle must remain attached thereto until the end of the current registration year. The City Clerk shall be responsible under his official bond for all moneys collected under and pursuant to this Chapter and shall account to and deliver all such moneys in his possession to the Treasurer of the City of Payette, on the first day of each and every month."

Section 2. This ordinance will be effective commencing with January 1, 1950.
