ORDINANCE NO. ~~642~~

AN ORDINANCE MAKING AN ANNUAL APPROPRIATION AND LEVY FOR GENERAL, STREET LIGHTING, LIBRARY, FIRE DEPARTMENT, BAND, RECREATION, PARKING METERS AND OFF-STREET PARKING, SEWER SYSTEM AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT, STORM SEWERS, AND THE PAYMENT ON THE OUTSTANDING BONDED INDEBTEDNESS AND INTEREST OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

SECTION 1. That the sum of \$185,700.00, together with fines, forfeitures, and other money not otherwise appropriated, is hereby appropriated for the General Expenses of the City of Payette, Idaho, for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of May, 1960.

SECTION 2. That the sum of \$14,000.00 is hereby appropriated for the purpose of lighting the Streets and Avenue and Thoroughfares of the City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the Street Lighting Fund.

SECTION 3. That there is hereby appropriated for the Fiscal Year commencing with the first day of May, 1960, the sum of \$8,500.00 for the purpose of maintaining a Public Library, and the sum shall constitute the Library Fund.

SECTION 4. That the sum of \$2,520.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of May, 1960, for the purpose of paying interest on all outstanding general obligation bonds of the City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the Bond Interest Fund.

SECTION 5. That the sum of \$7,000.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1960, for the redemption of the outstanding General Obligation Bonds of the City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the Bond Sinking Fund.

SECTION 6. That the sum of \$17,200.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1960, for the purpose of maintaining the Fire Department, and the same shall constitute the Fire Department Fund.

SECTION 7. That the sum of \$1,200.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1960, for the purpose of maintaining a Band, and the same shall constitute the Band Fund.

SECTION 8. That the sum of \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1960, for the purpose of providing a Recreation program, and the same shall constitute the Recreation Fund.

SECTION 9. That the sum of \$14,000.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing with the First day of May, 1960, for the purpose of maintaining and operating Parking Meters and acquisition of off-Street Parking facilities for the City of Payette, and the same shall constitute the Parking Meter Fund.

SECTION 10. That the sum of \$43,000.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing with the First day of May, 1960, for the purpose of paying interest on bonds and maintenance of the sewer system and sewage disposal plant for the City of Payette and the same shall constitute the Sewer Fund.

SECTION 11. That the sum of \$10,080.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1960, for the purposes of constructing and maintaining storm sewers for the City of Payette, and the same shall constitute the Storm Sewer Fund.

SECTION 12. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year, commencing with the first day of May, 1960, the sum of twenty-five (25) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation, of all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, and the funds realized from such levy, together with all fines, licenses, forfeitures, and money not otherwise appropriated, shall be for and constitute the General Funds of the City of Payette, Idaho.

SECTION 13. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1960, against all the taxable property within the <sup>3.6</sup> corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of four (4) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property and the funds realized from such levy shall be and the same shall constitute the Street Lighting Fund.

SECTION 14. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1960, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of three (3) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property and the funds realized from such levy shall be and the same shall constitute the Library Fund of the City of Payette, Idaho.

13 SECTION 15. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1960, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of one and two tenths (1.2) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property and the funds realized from such levy shall be and the same shall constitute the Bond Interest Fund of the City of Payette, Idaho.

SECTION 16. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1960, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of two mills (2) on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property and the funds realized from such levy shall be and the same shall constitute the Fire Department Fund, of the City of Payette, Idaho.

SECTION 17. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1960, against all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of three (3) mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property and the funds realized from such levy shall be and the same shall constitute the Recreation Fund, of the City of Payette, Idaho. <sup>1/2 mill</sup>

SECTION 18. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first day of May, 1960, against all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of four and eight tenths mills (4.8) on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be and the same shall constitute the Storm Sewer Fund of the City of Payette, Idaho.
