

ORDINANCE NO. 660

AN ORDINANCE REVISING AND AMENDING TITLE 5 CHAPTER 5 SECTION 10 TO PROVIDE THAT THE CITY CLERK MAY ISSUE BARTENDERS LICENSES ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Chapter 5 Section 5 Chapter 10 is amended to read as follows:

BARTENDERS: It shall be unlawful for any person to act as a bartender in any premises licensed under the provisions of this Chapter unless such person shall hold a permit therefor issued by the City Clerk. Applications for permits shall be made on forms furnished by the Clerk and shall be accompanied by a permit fee of one dollar (\$1.00). No person shall receive a permit as a bartender unless he shall have been approved by the Chief of Police, at which time the permit may be issued by the City Clerk. In the event of a refusal to grant said permit, the decision of the Chief of Police is reviewable by the Council, at which time said Council may overrule the decision of the Chief of Police or approve said decision.
