

ORDINANCE NO. 675

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7, TITLE 10, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, BY ADDING A NEW SECTION DESIGNATED AS 10-7-23 PROVIDING FOR MARKING OF PARKING SPACES, AND A NEW SECTION DESIGNATED 10-7-24 LIMITING THE TIME FOR PARKING VEHICLES UPON CERTAIN STREETS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; REPEALING CHAPTER 15, TITLE 10, OF SAID CODE, RELATING TO PARKING METERS, AND ENACTING A NEW SECTION DESIGNATED AS 10-15-1 RELATING TO DISPOSITION OF THE PARKING METER SPECIAL AND TRUST FUND; AND PRESCRIBING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Chapter 7, Title 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette be, and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto section 10-7-23 which reads as follows:

"10-7-23. Designated Parking Space. Whenever parking spaces or lanes have been designated and marked upon any of the streets of the City by the City of Payette, no car or motor vehicle shall be parked so that any portion thereof shall protrude beyond any line designating such parking space or lane."

Section 2. That Chapter 7, Title 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto section 10-7-24 which reads as follows:

"10-7-24. (A). Purpose. It is the purpose of this section to alleviate traffic congestion and to alleviate parking congestion caused by numerous operators of motor vehicles who park their vehicles for unreasonably long periods of time in the most congested streets of the City and thus to impede traffic.

"(B). Parking Time Limited. It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle for more than two hours continuously at any one place between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M. and 6:00 o'clock P.M., on any day except on Sundays and legal holidays upon 1st Avenue North between the alley one-half block West of 8th Street and the alley one-half block East of 8th Street, Center Avenue between 7th Street and 9th Street, 1st Avenue South between 8th Street and the alley one-half block East of 8th Street, and 8th Street between 3rd Avenue North and 2nd Avenue South.

"(C). Penalties for Violation. Any person convicted of a violation of subsection (B) of this section shall be fined \$1.00. Upon a third or subsequent conviction of a violation of said subsection within any ninety day period the fine shall be \$5.00.

"(D). It shall be unlawful for the operator of any motor vehicle to move such motor vehicle within the area designated in subsection (B) hereof for the purpose of evading the time limit prescribed herein."

Section 3. That Chapter 15, Title 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette, be and the same is hereby repealed, and a new section designated 10-15-1 be and the same is hereby enacted, reading as follows:

"10-15-1. Parking Meter Special and Trust Fund. The unexpended balance in the Parking Meter Special and Trust Fund after payment of current and outstanding obligations as heretofore provided by ordinance of the City of Payette, including the appropriation heretofore made and the budget for 1963, shall be used for parking studies and for the acquisition, establishment, improvement, maintenance, and operation of public off-street parking facilities as the Council shall from time to time direct."

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective upon and after August 10, 1963.
