

ORDINANCE NO. 729

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING SECTION 1 OF CHAPTER 2, TITLE 5 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE TO PROVIDE THAT A LICENSE SHALL BE REQUIRED TO RUN, OPERATE OR MAINTAIN A ROOM OR PLACE WHERE SHUFFLEBOARD IS PLAYED BY THE PUBLIC; AND AMENDING SECTION 2 OF CHAPTER 2, TITLE 5 PROVIDING THAT AN ANNUAL LICENSE FEE SHALL BE REQUIRED OF PERSONS WHO DESIRE TO RUN OR OPERATE A POOLROOM, CARDROOM, BILLIARD HALL, BOWLING ALLEY OR PLACE OR ROOM WHERE SHUFFLEBOARD IS PLAYED; AND AMENDING SECTION 4 OF CHAPTER 2, TITLE 5 PROVIDING THAT THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR EACH POOL TABLE IS \$10.00: FOR EACH CARD TABLE, \$10.00; FOR EACH BILLIARD TABLE, \$6.00: FOR ONE BOWLING ALLEY \$10.00 AND \$5.00 FOR EACH ADDITIONAL ALLEY, FOR EACH SHUFFLEBOARD, \$8.00. THAT NO LICENSE SHALL BE ISSUED FOR A LONGER OR SHORTER PERIOD THAN ONE YEAR: AND ADDING SECTION 5 OF CHAPTER 2, TITLE 5, PROVIDING THAT THE PROVISIONS IN THIS ORDINANCE AS AMENDED SHALL APPLY AS OF JANUARY 1, 1969, AND THAT THE LICENSE FEES FOR 1969 SHALL BE DUE MARCH 31, 1969 AND FOR EACH YEAR FOLLOWING THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY.

Be It Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, State of Idaho:

That Sections 5-2-1, 5-2-2 and 5-2-4 of the City Code of the City of Payette be and the same are hereby amended to read as follows:

5-2-1 LICENSE REQUIRED: It shall be unlawful for any person to run, operate, or maintain any room or place within the Corporate Limits where the games of pool, cards, shuffleboard, billiards or bowling are played by the public, or for any person to permit or allow any of the games of pool, cards, shuffleboard, billiards, or bowling to be played in such room or other place, without having first procured a license from the Clerk.

5-2-2 APPLICATION FOR LICENSE: Any person who shall desire to procure a license for running or operating a poolroom, cardroom, billiard hall, or bowling alley, or place or room where shuffleboard is played, shall file an application therefor in writing with the Clerk at least five (5) days before the meeting at which said application is acted upon; at the time of filing said application, the ~~quarterly~~ yearly license fee hereinafter provided for shall be deposited with the Clerk; if the application is favorably acted upon by the Mayor and Council, the Clerk shall be instructed to issue the license to the applicant, but if refused, the license fee deposited as above required shall be returned to the applicant.

5-2-4 LICENSE FEE: The license fee shall be as follows:

(A) For each and every pool table, the sum of ~~Two-Dollars-(\$2.00)-per-quarter~~ Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year.

(B) For each and every card table the sum of ~~fifteen-dollars-(\$15.00)-per-quarter~~ Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per year.

(C) For each and every billiard table the sum of ~~one-and-fifty-cents-(\$1.50)-per-quarter~~ Six Dollars (\$6.00) per year.

(D) For one (1) Bowling alley the sum of ~~two-dollars-and-fifty-cents-(\$2.50)-per-quarter~~ Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per year, and for each additional alley the sum of ~~one-dollar-and-twenty-five-cents-(\$1.25)-per-quarter~~ Five Dollars (\$5.00) per year.

(E) For each shuffleboard the sum of Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year.

No license shall be issued for a longer or shorter period than one (1) quarter year, except the unexpired term of the ~~quarter-year~~ year in which the same are applied for; provided further, that the license herein provided for shall not be construed to license or in any manner allow any gambling, but is only a license fee to be paid when the games herein mentioned are run or operated as

a means of recreation or pleasure.

5-2-5 APPLICATION OF PROVISIONS: The foregoing provisions in this chapter as amended shall apply as of January 1, 1969; that the license fees for the year 1969 shall be due on or before the 31st day of March, 1969 and that the license fees for each of the years following shall be due on the 1st day of January.
