

ORDINANCE NO. 775

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING SECTION 6-4-1 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE TO PERMIT THE USE OF AIR GUNS IN THE PROTECTION OF PERSONS OR PROPERTY; AND REPEALING SECTION 6-4-2 WHICH PROHIBITS THE USE OF A SLINGSHOT IN THE CITY LIMITS AND REPEALING SECTION 6-4-3 WHICH PROHIBITS THE USE OF AN AIR GUN OR SPRING GUN WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.

Be It Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, State of Idaho:

That Section 6-4-1, Section 6-4-2 and Section 6-4-3 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette be hereby amended and repealed as follows:

6-4-1 FIREARMS: It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any fire-arm or airgun within the City limits except in the necessary defense of life, person or property, or when rendered necessary when making an arrest.

6-4-2 FLIPPERS: ~~It shall be unlawful for any person to carry, or use for amusement or otherwise, or have in his possession, the device or weapon commonly known as a flipper (it being an India rubber strap or a spring used to throw small rocks or other hard substances), or the device commonly known as a sling shot.~~

6-4-3 AIR-GUNS: ~~It shall be unlawful for any person to carry, use for amusement or otherwise, or have in his possession within the City limits the device or weapon commonly known as an air gun or spring gun.~~
