

ORDINANCE NO. 803

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING CHAPTER 1 OF TITLE 7 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, TO PROVIDE FOR THREE (3) SEPARATE FIRE ZONES WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 7-1-2: FIRE ZONE 1:

The properties described in Section 7-1-1 shall be classified as being within Fire Zone 1 as defined in the Edition of the Uniform Building Code, adopted, or hereafter adopted, by the City of Payette.

Section 7-1-3: FIRE ZONE 2:

All properties within the City of Payette, Idaho, and now zoned, or hereafter zoned 'C' Commercial, 'D' Commercial, 'E' Commercial or 'F' Unclassified District and outside Fire Zone 1, shall be classified as being within Fire Zone 2 as defined in the Edition of the Uniform Building Code adopted, or hereafter adopted, by the City of Payette.

Section 7-1-4: FIRE ZONE 3:

All properties within the City of Payette, Idaho, and now zoned, or hereafter zoned, 'A' Residential or 'B' Residential District, and outside of Fire Zone 1, shall be classified as being within Fire Zone 3, as defined in the Edition of the Uniform Building Code, adopted, or hereafter adopted, by the City of Payette.

Section 7-1-5: OCCUPANCY EXCEPTION TO FIRE ZONES 1 AND 2:

All buildings and structures located within Fire Zones 1 or 2 that have a present occupancy rating of I or J as defined in the Uniform Building Code adopted, or hereafter adopted, by the City of Payette, shall only be subject to the restrictive provisions applicable to Fire Zone 3, and not to those provisions applicable to Fire Zones 1 or 2.

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Independent Enterprise, a newspaper of general circulation in the City and County of Payette, Idaho.
