

ORDINANCE NO. 862

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 17, 18, 19 and 20 of CHAPTER 3 of TITLE 3 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, TO PROVIDE FOR A CHANGE IN WATER RATES TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASE IN THE UTILITY FUND DEPOSIT AND TO PROVIDE FOR A CONNECTION FEE FOR WATER USERS.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho that Sections 17, 18, 19, and 20 of Chapter 3 of Title 3 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette, Idaho, be amended as follows:

3-3-17: CHARGES PAYABLE TO CLERK: All charges for the furnishing of water for use at any specific premises will be due and payable at the office of the Clerk on the first day of each month, and in the event any charges or rates are not paid within ten (10) days from the time they are due and payable, the water shall be shut off from said premises, and shall not be turned on again until such charges or rates for furnishing water at said premises are paid, together with the sum of ~~fifteen~~ twenty-five dollars ~~(\$15.00)~~ (\$25.00) for a utility fund deposit, if said deposit has not previously been made, or if the same has been refunded; in addition the expense of turning the water on again, as may be determined by the City Council, must also be paid. Until such time that said payments are made, the person who applied for the use of water at the said premises to which water service was terminated because of non-payment will not be entitled to any water service at any other place or premises within the City.

3-3-18: WATER RATES: The monthly charges for City Water shall be made and collected at the following rates for each meter service; however, in the event there is more than one dwelling unit, as defined in Section 11-1-4 (8) of this Code, connected to a water meter, then the charges shall be made and collected for each dwelling unit by determining the average use per dwelling unit.

(A) The minimum monthly charge for each meter service within the City Limits shall be ~~Two Dollars and Fifty cents (\$2.50)~~ Three Dollars (\$3.00) for each business and commercial unit, and for each dwelling unit where there is more than one dwelling unit connected to a single water meter and Three and 50/100 Dollars (\$3.50) for each dwelling unit which is not connected to a water meter which is connected to any other dwelling unit, and outside the City Limits shall be Four Dollars and 80/100 (\$4.80). This minimum charge shall entitle the user to the delivery of two thousand (2,000) gallons of water during each such month.

(B) For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of two thousand (2,000) gallons and not to exceed five sixty thousand (5,000) ~~(60,000)~~ gallons, the charge shall be sixty eighty-five cents (60¢) ~~(85¢)~~ for each one thousand (1,000) gallons, or fraction thereof.

(C) For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of five sixty thousand (5,000) ~~(60,000)~~ gallons and not to exceed forty thousand (40,000) ~~(40,000)~~ gallons, the charge shall be forty cents (40¢) for each one thousand (1,000) gallons, or fraction thereof.

~~(D) -- For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of forty thousand (40,000) gallons and not to exceed one hundred thousand (100,000) gallons, the charge shall be thirteen cents (13¢) for each one thousand (1,000) gallons or fraction thereof.~~

~~(E) -- For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of One Hundred Thousand (100,000) gallons, the charge shall be eleven cents (11¢) for each one thousand (1,000) gallons or fraction thereof.~~
