

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING Real property to the City of Payette, Idaho, and zoning the same "A" Residential.

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, that the following described real property be annexed to the City of Payette, Idaho and zoned "A" Residential.

In the County of Payette, Idaho:

A parcel of land situated in the SE¹/₄NE¹/₄ of Sec. 3, Twp. 8 N., R. 5., W.B.M, more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the Northeast corner of Govt. Lot 1 of said Sec. 3;

Thence S. 0° 23' 32" W. (formerly South), along the East boundary of said Govt Lot 1, a distance of 1052.76 feet to a point which is the Southeast corner of said Govt Lot 1 and the Northeast corner of said SE¹/₄NW¹/₄;

Thence N. 89° 48' 38" W., along the South boundary of said Govt Lot 1 and the North boundary of said SE¹/₄NE¹/₄, a distance of 1018.02 feet to the centerline of Hughes Drive and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Thence S. 28° 42' 48" East, along the centerline of Hughes Drive, a distance of 125.00 feet;

Thence N. 89° 48' 38" W. along a line parallel with the North boundary of said SE¹/₄NE¹/₄, a distance of 31.98 feet;

Thence N. 28° 42' 48" W., along the boundary of Hughes Drive, a distance of 100 feet to a point on the North boundary of said SE¹/₄NE¹/₄;

Thence S. 89° 48' 38" E., along the North boundary of said SE¹/₄NE¹/₄, a distance of 31.98 feet to the centerline of Hughes Drive and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication in the Independent Enterprise, a newspaper of general circulation in the City and County of Payette, Idaho.
