

ORDINANCE NO. 893

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER ONE OF TITLE 8 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR AN OWNER OR OCCUPANT OF PREMISES TO PERMIT THE ACCUMULATION OF GARBAGE, AND REQUIRE FRONT LOADING CONTAINERS AND REAR LOADING CONTAINERS AT MULTIPLE FAMILY DWELLINGS.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, that Chapter 1 of Title 8 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette, Idaho be amended as follows:

8-1-5: REFUSE ACCUMULATION UNLAWFUL: It shall be unlawful for an owner or occupant of any premises to allow, permit, or to suffer to accumulate in or about any public or private premises any garbage or tin cans, except in covered containers of an approved type hereinafter set forth, or any other rubbish so as to cause such premises to be or remain in such condition as to create a nuisance or offensive odor or atmosphere or rodent harborage.


8-1-7: GARBAGE CONTAINERS: Containers at one-family and two-family dwellings shall be constructed of metal or other approved material in such manner as to be strong, not easily corrodible, rodent and fly-proof, shall have two (2) handles (except that cans having a capacity of ten (10) gallons or less may have bails instead of handles), shall have a capacity of not more than thirty-two (32) gallons, shall have tight covers and such containers shall be kept in a sanitary condition. Containers at multiple family dwellings shall have at least a one-half cubic yard capacity for each dwelling unit, unless a smaller capacity is approved by the Collector. The containers shall be constructed of 12 or 14 gauge steel and have lids covering the same. Front loading containers shall have wheels or skids, steel channels to enable loading with a hydraulic lift, and shall have a capacity from two to ten cubic yards. Rear loading containers shall have four wheels, steel bars to enable loading with a hydraulic lift and shall have a capacity from one to three cubic yards. All such containers shall be subject to the approval of the Collector.

8-1-8: USE OF CONTAINERS: All garbage shall be ~~drained~~ free of liquids and well wrapped with paper before it is placed in the container. No free liquids shall be placed in the container. No such container when filled shall weigh more than one hundred (100) pounds, except for the rear loading and front loading containers described in Section 8-1-7. Lids of such containers shall not be removed except when necessary to place garbage and rubbish in such containers or to take the same therefrom and shall be immediately replaced by the person removing the same.

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Independent Enterprise a newspaper of general circulation in the City and County of Payette, Idaho.
