

ORDINANCE NO. 908

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13.08.010 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, TO PROVIDE THAT AN INDUSTRIAL WASTE WATER MONITORING STATION IS TO BE MAINTAINED BY THE USER.

Be It Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, that Section 13.08.010 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette be amended as follows:


13.08.010 Definitions. Unless the context specifically indicates otherwise, the meaning of terms used in this chapter shall be as follows:

1. "BOD" (denoting biochemical oxygen demand) means the quantity of oxygen utilized in the biochemical oxidation of organic matter under standard laboratory procedure in five days at twenty degrees centigrade, expressed in milligrams per liter.
2. "Building drain" means that part of the lowest horizontal piping of a drainage system which receives the discharge from soil, waste and other drainage pipes inside the walls of the building and conveys it to the building sewers, beginning five feet (1.5 meters) outside the inner face of the building walls.
3. "Building sewer" means the extension from the building drain to the public sewer or other place of disposal.
4. "Combined sewer" means a sewer receiving both surface runoff and sewage.
5. "EPA" means the United States Environmental Protection Agency".
6. "Garbage" means solid wastes from the domestic and commercial preparation, cooking and dispensing of food, and from the handling, storage and sale of produce.
7. "Industrial wastes" means the liquid wastes from any nongovernmental user of publicly owned treatment works identified in the Standard Industrial Classification Manual, 1972, Office of Management and Budget, as amended and supplemented under the following divisions:
 - a. Division A--Agriculture, forestry and fishing;
 - b. Division B--Mining;
 - c. Division D--Manufacturing;
 - d. Division E--Transportation, communications, electric, gas and sanitary services;
 - e. Division I--Services.A user in the divisions listed may be excluded if it is determined that it will introduce primarily segregated domestic wastes or wastes from sanitary conveniences.
8. "Industrial users" means any user of the city's treatment works who is identified in subsection 7 of Section 13.08.010.
9. "Industrial waste water monitoring station" means the monitoring station required by the U.S.E.P.A. and the city to determine the contribution of the industry to the public sewer system. Monitoring equipment shall include composite refrigerated sampler, recording pH meter and recording flow meter. The city shall provide plans and specifications for the construction of the station; cost of the construction of the station shall be at the industry's expense. Maintenance and upkeep of the state station shall be at the city's industry's expense.
10. "Natural outlet" means any outlet into a watercourse, pond, ditch, lake or other body of surface or groundwater.
11. "pH" means the logarithm of the reciprocal of the weight of hydrogen ions in grams per liter of solution.
12. "Properly shredded garbage" means the wastes from the preparation, cooking and dispensing of food that have been shredded to such a degree that all particles will be carried freely under the flow conditions normally prevailing in public sewers, with no particle greater than one-half inch (1.27 centimeters) in any dimension.


13. "Public sewer" means a sewer over which all owners of abutting properties have equal rights and which is controlled by public authority.
14. "Sanitary sewer" means a sewer which carries sewage and to which storm, surface and ground waters are not intentionally admitted.
15. "Sewage" means a combination of the water-carried wastes from residences, business buildings, institutions and industrial establishments, together with such ground, surface and storm water as may be present.
16. "Sewage treatment plant" means any arrangement of devices and structures used for treating sewage.
17. "Sewage works" means all facilities for collecting, pumping, treatment and disposing of sewage.
18. "Sewer" means a pipe or conduit for carrying sewage.
19. "Sewer inspector" means a superintendent.
20. "Shall" is mandatory; "may" is permissive.
21. "Slug" means any discharge of water, sewage or industrial waste which in concentration of any given constituent or in quantity of flow exceeds for any period of duration longer than fifteen minutes more than five times the average twenty-four-hour concentration of flows during normal operation.
22. "Storm drain" (sometimes termed "storm sewer") means a sewer which carries storm and surface waters and drainage, but excludes sewage and industrial wastes, other than unpolluted cooling water.
23. "Superintendent" means the superintendent of sewage works and/or of water pollution control of the city or his authorized deputy, agent or representative.
24. "Suspended solids" means solids that either float on the surface of, or are in suspension in water, sewage or other liquids, and which are removable by laboratory filtering.
25. "TC" means a measurement of the total carbon content of the wastewater.
26. "TOC" means a measurement of the total organic carbon content of the wastewater.
27. "Watercourse" means a channel in which a flow of water occurs, either continuously or intermittently.

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Independent Enterprise, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Payette, Idaho.
