

ORDINANCE NO. 927

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8.08.110 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, TO INCREASE FEES FOR THE COLLECTION OF REFUSE AT RESIDENCES.


Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Council that Section 8.08.110 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette be amended as follows:

8.08.110 Collection--Fees. Fees and rates for the collection of refuse at residences shall be three and 50/100 dollars per month per dwelling unit, payable by the owner of the premises. The fees for all other premises from which refuse is collected shall be set by negotiation and contract between the city and the owner or occupant. No charge will be made during the time the premises are vacant and no refuse is collected therefrom; provided, such period of time is not less than thirty days; and provided further, that notice of such vacancy shall be given to the clerk prior to such vacancy.

The fees established in this section shall be subject to modification, upon application to the council by the owner or occupant, in all cases where fees so established shall be unjust or oppressive.


That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after October 1, 1981.
