

ORDINANCE NO. 952

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 13.04.100, 13.04.120 AND 13.04.260 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, TO PROVIDE FOR A FEE FOR PROVIDING WATER SERVICE AND THE DISCONTINUANCE OF WATER SERVICE, AND TO PROVIDE FOR A DEVELOPMENT FEE.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho that Sections 100, 120 and 260 of Chapter 4 of Title 13 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette, Idaho be amended as follows: ;

13.04.100 Use - Application Procedure. Application for the use of water must be made at the office of the city clerk on printed forms furnished for the purpose. Every such application must be made by the owner or tenant of the property to be benefited, stating the lot and block on which it is to be used, accompanied by a fee of Five (\$5.00) dollars, and he must agree to conform to the rules and regulations established from time to time as a condition for the use of water.

13.04.120 Temporary Discontinuance of Service. Should it be desired to discontinue the use of water supplying the premises for a period of not less than one month, notice in writing must be given to the city clerk and payment in full made at his office, accompanied by a payment of Five (\$5.00) dollars for such service. ~~The water shall then be turned off and turned on again on application without charges, but no remission of rent shall be made until after said notice is given.~~

13.04.260 Water charges--Designated. A. The monthly charges for water shall be made and collected at the following rates for each meter service; however, in the event there is more than one dwelling unit, as defined in Section 17.08.110, connected to a water meter, then the charges shall be made and collected for each dwelling unit by determining the average use per dwelling unit.

B. The minimum monthly charge for each meter service within the city limits shall be three dollars for each business and commercial unit, and for each dwelling unit where there is more than one dwelling unit connected to a single water meter; three dollars fifty cents for each dwelling unit which is not connected to a water meter which is connected to any other dwelling unit; and, outside the city limits, four dollars eighty cents. This minimum charge shall entitle the user to the delivery of two thousand gallons of water during each such month.


C. For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of two thousand gallons and not to exceed sixty thousand gallons, the charge shall be eighty-five cents for each one thousand gallons or fraction thereof.

D. For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of sixty thousand gallons, the charge shall be forty cents for each one thousand gallons or fraction thereof.


E. In addition to the above charges for amounts of water used in any month the following shall be added to each monthly billing as a delinquent fee. For all amounts of water used in any month from zero (0) to two thousand (2,000) gallons, the development charges shall be one (\$1.00) dollar. For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of two thousand (2,000) gallons and not to exceed twenty thousand (20,000) gallons, the development charge shall be three (\$3.00) dollars. For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of twenty thousand (20,000) gallons and not to exceed sixty thousand (60,000) gallons, the development charge shall be four (\$4.00) dollars. For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of sixty (60,000) gallons the development charge shall be fifteen (\$15.00) dollars.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
