

ORDINANCE NO. 976

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ANNEXING CERTAIN HERE-
INDESCRIBED REAL PROPERTY; DESCRIBING SAID PROPERTY; ESTABLISHING
AN EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALER; REQUIRING FILING.

BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That the following described real property is
hereby annexed into and made a part of the corporate city limits
of the City of Payette, Payette County, Idaho:

In ASSESSOR'S RIVERSIDE PLAT, as per Plat in Book
1, Page 10, Plat Records, Payette County, Idaho:

All that portion of Block 4 lying and being West
of the right-of-way of the Highway as conveyed to
the State of Idaho by Deed recorded November 4,
1950, Fee #77724, in Book 26, Page 314, Deed
Records of Payette County, Idaho;

ALSO,

All that portion of Block 5 lying and being West
of the right-of-way of the Highway as conveyed to
the State of Idaho by Deed recorded November 4,
1950, Fee #77723, in Book 26, Page 313, Deed
Records of Payette County, Idaho,
SAVE AND EXCEPTING the following portion thereof:
Beginning at the point of intersection of the
South line of said Block 5 with the Westerly
right-of-way line of the Highway;
thence S. 89°53' W. along the South line of said
Block 5 to a point which bears S. 89°53' W. 220
feet from the NW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec.
28, Twp. 9 N., R. 5 W., B.M.;
thence N. 0°04 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' E. 62 feet;
thence S. 89°53' W 25 feet;
thence N. 0°04 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' E. 181.0 feet;
thence N. 89°53' E. to the Westerly right-of-way
line of the Highway;
thence in a Southerly direction along said West-
erly right-of-way line to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: The above described real property shall be used as a recreational area.


SECTION 3: After passage, the City Clerk shall file this Ordinance as required by Section 50-223, Idaho Code.

SECTION 4: Any portions of any existing Ordinances which are in direct conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.

SECTION 5: If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable, or unconstitutional, for any reason, the remaining portion of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS APPROVAL, PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 12 day of August, 1987.
