

ORDINANCE NO. 979

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE AMENDING SECTION 15.04.010 BY ADOPTING THE CURRENT VERSIONS AND UPDATED VERSIONS OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, HOUSING CODE, ABATEMENT OF DANGEROUS BUILDING CODE, AND OTHER UNIFORM CODES WHICH HAVE HERETOFORE BEEN ADOPTED; SEVERABILITY; REPEALER; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 1: That 15.04.010 is amended as follows:

Those certain documents, three copies of which are in the office of the City Clerk, being worded and designated:

a. The Uniform Building Code, the current Edition, and all future editions as they may become available, published by the International Conference of Building Officials;

b. The Uniform Housing Code, the current Edition, and all future editions as they may become available, published by the International Conference of Building Officials;

c. The Uniform Code for Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, the current Edition, and all future editions as they may become available published by the International Conference of Building Officials;

d. The Uniform Mechanical Code, the current Edition, and all future editions as they may become available, published by the International Conference of Building Officials and the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials.

e. American Standard Specifications for Making Buildings and Facilities Accessible to, and Usable by, the Physically Handicapped, ANSI All7.1, the current Edition, and all future editions as they may become available, published by the American National Standards Institute;

f. The ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code and the ASME Power Piping Code ANSI B31.1, the current Edition, and all future editions as they may become available, published by the American Society of Mechanical Engineers;

g. The Uniform Fire Code, the current Edition and all future editions as they may become available, and the Life Safety Code, published by the National Fire Protection Association;

h. National Fire Protection Association Code numbers 501A and 501D, the current Edition and all future editions as they may become available, published by the National Fire Protection Assoc-

iation; and

i. The National Fire Protection Association Code number 54 (ANSI Z223.1) and the National Fire Protection Association number 59-A, the current Edition and all future editions as they may become available both published by the National Fire Association, except that these codes shall not be applicable to gases produced as a byproduct internal to the process of manufacture, are adopted by the city to provide for the regulations set forth therein and to provide for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor, and are made a part of this chapter by reference in the same manner as though fully set forth in this chapter, notwithstanding any existing conflicting sections contained in the municipal code which by this adoption, are repealed, excepting such portions are amended, deleted or modified by this chapter.


Section 2: Any portions of any existing Ordinances which are in direct conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 3: If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remaining portion of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS APPROVAL, PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
